WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

- The Chicago White Sox have won five of their last nine games as they conclude a seven-game, six-day trip today in Boston.
- RHP Reynaldo López is scheduled to take the mound for the White Sox, who are looking for their second winning road trip of the season (3-2 from 3/29-4/4).
- The Sox are 3-3 on this trip, splitting a four-game series at Minnesota and also the first two games of this series ... the White Sox on Friday night recorded their fifth-ever 1-0 victory at Fenway Park (first since 7/21/89).
- Following today's game, the White Sox return home for seven games vs. Cleveland (6/11-14) and Detroit (6/15-17).
- The Sox went 2-1 on their last homestand vs. Milwaukee from 6/1-3 and 1-5 on the last trip to Detroit (1-2) and Cleveland (0-3) from 5/25-30.

TODAY'S STORYLINES

- RHP Reynaldo López owns a 1.85 ERA (7 ER/34.0) IP in five starts at home this season and a 4.86 mark (20 ER/37.0 IP) in seven road starts.
- Sox starting pitchers own a 3.06 ERA (16 ER/47.0 IP) over the last eight games (since 6/2) ... the bullpen owns a 2.56 ERA (24 ER/84.1 IP) over the last 26 (since 5/13).
- The White Sox are holding the opposition to a .161 (10-62) average with RISP over nine games in June.
- The Sox have lost five of their last six games at Fenway Park after winning six of their previous seven.
- José Abreu is a career .333/.407/.625 (25-72) hitter with nine doubles, four homers and 15 RBI in 18 games at Fenway Park.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

- The White Sox committed three errors, leading to a pair of unearned runs, in a 4-2 loss to the Red Sox.
- Chicago scored twice in the first inning, including an RBI double by José Abreu but Boston answered with one run each in the first and second and two in the fifth.
- The White Sox mounted a threat in the eighth, but Matt Barnes retired Kevan Smith on a flyout with two runners on base to end the inning.
- LHP Carlos Rodón suffered the loss in his season debut, allowing four runs (two earned) on six hits over 5.0 IP ... LHP Xavier Cedeño (1.0 IP), Chris Volstad (1.1) and Luis Avilán (0.2 IP) combined for 3.0 scoreless IP in relief.
- The White Sox were 1-7 with RISP, while Boston was 0-9.

SOX SERVE WEEK

- The White Sox will celebrate Sox Serve Week from this Monday-Saturday, their 10th annual community outreach and fundraising campaign benefitting Chicago White Sox Charities (CWSC).
- Sox Serve Week engages fans and the Chicagoland community through outreach events, including a visit to LaRabida Hospital and events with Special Olympic athletes, as well as special fundraising opportunities, such as auctions, Mystery Baseball sales and more.

HAWK'S FAREWELL

- Ken "Hawk" Harrelson, who is in his 33rd and final season in the White Sox television booth in 2018, will work primarily Sunday home games this season as well as select other contests.
- Harrelson played for the Red Sox from 1967-69 and worked in the their broadcast booth from 1975-81 ... he was a member of the 1967 "Impossible Dream" Red Sox team that lost to St. Louis in the World Series and was named American League Player of the Year in 1968 after leading the majors with 109 RBI and ranking third with 35 home runs.
- Harrelson will serve as a White Sox ambassador throughout the 2019 season, marking his eighth decade in baseball.

ON THE ROAD TO OMAHA

- Several recent White Sox draft choices are competing in the NCAA Super Regionals, with bids to the College World Series in Omaha at stake.
- Oregon State INF Nick Madrigal, the Sox first-round pick (No. 4 overall), went 1-4 with a walk and run scored last night as the No. 3 Beavers defeated Minnesota, 6-3, in Corvallis, Ore. to advance to the CWS.
- LHP Konnor Pilkington, the Sox third-round pick from Mississippi State, allowed two runs over 5.0 IP in a no decision at Vanderbilt ... Game 3 is tonight at 5:00 p.m. CT.
- RHP Davis Martin (14th round) and Texas Tech play Game 2 tonight vs. Duke in Lubbock, Texas ... with a win, the Red Raiders will advance to the CWS.
- Minnesota 3B Micah Coffey (30th round) went 1-3 with an RBI last night as the Gophers were eliminated by Oregon State.

WHITE SOX VS. BOSTON

- The season series is even at 1-1.
- The White Sox are batting .190/.250/.254 with a 1.06 ERA (2 ER/17.0 IP) and have been outscored by the Red Sox, 4-3.
- Chicago went 1-6 against the Red Sox in 2017, winning the opener before dropping the final six ... Boston's four-game sweep on 8/3-6/17 was its first against the White Sox at Fenway Park since 7/21-24/88.
- Chicago trails in the all-time series, 940-983, going 542-417 at home (54-59 at Guaranteed Rate Field) and 398-565 on the road (351-498 at Fenway Park).

SOX CONNECTIONS

- White Sox INF Yoán Moncada appeared in eight games with the Red Sox in 2016 after signing as an international free agent on 3/12/15.
- Red Sox LHP Chris Sale was selected by the White Sox in the first round of the 2010 draft and pitched for the club from 2010-17.

LOOKING FOR AN EDGE VS. THE EAST

- The White Sox are 184-226 vs. the American League East since 2007, with their only winning record during that span coming in 2016 (19-14).
- The Sox are 5-7 vs. the AL East this season (2-3 on the road) after going 13-20 in 2017.

NO REST FOR THE WEARY

- The White Sox are in the middle of a stretch from 6/5-24 where they play 21 games in 20 days from 6/5-24 (3-3 so far) ... they also are in the middle of a stretch from 5/25-6/10 where they play 13 of 16 games on the road.

WHITE SOX CHARITIES LEND A HAND

- In conjunction with Danny Farquhar's return to Guaranteed Rate Field on 6/1, Chicago White Sox Charities raised \$10,000, with all proceeds benefitting the Joe Niekro Foundation, an organization committed to supporting patients and families, research, treatment and awareness of brain aneurysms.
- Farquhar, 31, threw out a ceremonial first pitch on 6/1, surrounded by his wife, children and the RUSH University Medical Center team who helped care for him after he suffered a brain hemorrhage from a ruptured aneurysm during a home game on 4/20 vs. Houston.

QUALITY AND QUANTITY

- The White Sox have made a major-league leading 1,340 quality starts since the start of the 2003 season, two more than the second-place New York Mets (1,338) and 42 more than Oakland (1,298), the next-closest American League team.

STOP! THIEF!

- The White Sox lead the major leagues with 53 stolen bases this season and rank second with an 82.8 (53-64) success rate.
- The Sox are on pace to steal 138 bases, which would be 10 less than their combined total of 148 from 2016-17 ... they have not led the majors in steals since 1966 (153).

TRIPLE THE FUN

- The White Sox lead the American League and are tied for fourth in the majors this season with 19 triples ... the Sox led the AL with 37 triples last season, their highest total since 1999 (also 37).
- Yolmer Sánchez leads the major leagues with seven triples in 2018 after ranking sixth last season with eight.

NO RISP, NO REWARD

- The White Sox rank 12th in the American League with a .232 (109-469) average with RISP in 2018 ... the Sox are hitting .202 (26-129) with RISP in their last 19 road games (since 5/1).

AT THE HELM

- Rick Renteria is in his second season after being named the 40th manager in White Sox history on 10/3/16.
- Renteria was the only Latino manager in the major leagues in 2017 but has been joined by Boston's Alex Cora and Washington's Dave Martinez in 2018.

ON DECK: CLEVELAND INDIANS

- The White Sox open a seven-game homestand tomorrow night vs. the Cleveland Indians ... RHP Lucas Giolito (4-6, 7.08) is scheduled to start the opener of the four-game series.
- The Indians swept a three-game series from 5/28-30 at Progressive Field, outscoring the Sox, 25-10 ... the White Sox have lost nine of their last 10 games against Cleveland, including four in a row at Guaranteed Rate Field.

LÓPEZ AT A GLANCE

- The 24-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his 13th start of the season, eighth on the road and first career vs. Boston.
- Is making his fourth straight start on the road ... is 0-1 with a 4.86 ERA (9 ER/16.2 IP) in his last three.
- Went 3-0 with a 4.62 ERA (13 ER/25.1 IP) over his final four starts of 2017 ... made his White Sox debut on 8/11/17 vs. Kansas City, receiving a no decision after allowing two runs with six strikeouts over 6.0 IP.
- Was named the White Sox Minor League Pitcher of the Month for July 2017 after posting a 2.10 ERA (7 ER/30.0 IP) with 38 strikeouts and a .183 (20-109) opponents average over five starts.
- Was acquired from Washington with RHPs Dane Dunning and Lucas Giolito in exchange for OF Adam Eaton on 12/7/16 ... originally was signed by the Nationals as a non-drafted free agent on 6/21/12.

LAST START

- Received his seventh no decision of the season on 6/5-1 at Minnesota ... allowed a season-low one hit with four walks and four strikeouts over 7.0 IP ... allowed two runs or less while going at least 7.0 IP for the fourth time in 2018.
- Held the Twins hitless before allowing the lone hit in the fourth inning to Eduardo Escobar (a double).
- Departed with the White Sox leading, 2-0, after tossing 106 pitches (67 strikes) ... the Twins went on to win, 4-2, after scoring four runs in the eighth, including a go-ahead, three-run home run by Escobar off Nate Jones.

TWO OR LESS IS BEST

- Has allowed two earned runs or less in nine of his 12 starts this season, including four of his last six... the nine starts of two earned runs or less is tied for the sixth-most in the American League ... Houston's Justin Verlander and Tampa Bay's Blake Snell lead the American League with 12 such starts.
- Allowed two earned runs or less in five of his first six starts in 2018.
- Is 1-2 with six no decisions when allowing two earned runs or less ... the White Sox have scored a total of 20 runs of support in those outings (3.02 RSA; 20 RS/59.2 IP), going 2-7.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN

- Is making his 17th career start on the road ... has gone 4-6 with a 5.22 ERA (46 ER/79.1 IP), 64 strikeouts and a .271 (83-306) opponents average in his career.
- Owns a 0-3 record with a 4.86 ERA (20 ER/37.0 IP) in seven road starts this season, compared to 1-1 with a 1.85 ERA (7 ER/34.0 IP), 21 strikeouts and a .147 (17-116) opp. average in five starts a home.

HELP WANTED

- Owns a 3.17 run support average (25 RS/71.0 IP) in 2018, the sixth-lowest in the American League and the seventh-lowest in the MLB.
- Has received three runs of support or less in eight of his 12 starts, including zero runs four times.
- Received a 7.55 RSA (40 RS/47.2 IP) in eight starts last season.

MAKING HISTORY

- Is the first White Sox pitcher with 6.0-plus IP, two-or-fewer hits allowed, and one-or-fewer runs allowed in each of his first two starts of the season (source: Elias).
- Became the first White Sox starting pitcher since at least 1908 to lose a game in which he thre 7.0-plus IP while allowing two or less hits and one run which was unearned (source: Baseball Reference and STATS LLC) ... the last five pitchers to accomplish this feat:

2017 REVIEW

- Made eight starts with the White Sox in his first season with the organization ... went 1-2 with a 3.56 ERA (12 ER/3.0 IP) in five starts at home and 2-1 with a 6.75 mark (13 ER/17.1 IP) over three road starts.
- Five of his seven starts were quality ... went 2-2 with a 3.15 ERA (11 ER/30.1 IP) and 16 strikeouts in those outings.
- Worked a career-high tying 7.0 IP (four runs) in a win on 9/16 at Detroit ... allowed three runs in the second inning before limiting the Tigers to one run on five hits over his final 5.0 IP.
- Suffered his first loss with the White Sox on 8/17 at Texas, allowing six runs on five hits over 4.1 IP before exiting game with soreness on his right side.
- Was placed on the disabled list on 8/19 (retro to 8/18) with a back strain ... reinstated on 9/1, made the start that night vs. Tampa Bay (L; 3 ER/6.0 IP).
- Made 22 starts with Class AAA Charlotte, going 6-7 with a 3.79 ERA (51 ER/121.0 IP) and 131 strikeouts ... allowed two earned runs or less in seven of his final eight starts from 6/29-8/6 before being promoted.
- Entered the season ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 3 Prospect in the White Sox organization and No. 31 in baseball ... was rated by MLB.com as the No. 4 Prospect in the Sox system, No. 38 in baseball and the No. 9 right-handed pitching prospect.

PERSONAL NOTES

- His grandfather sold two cows in the Dominican Republic to buy him a used glove, a pair of cleats and an aluminum bat when he started playing baseball.

VS. AMERICAN LEAGUE EAST

- Is making his fourth career start against the American League East and second this season.
- Has gone 0-2 with a 4.91 ERA (8 ER/14.2 IP) in four career starts against the division.
- Received the no decision in his last start on 4/2 at Toronoto, allowing one run on two hits over 6.0 IP.

VS. BOSTON RED SOX

- Is scheduled to make his first career appearance vs. the Boston Red Sox.

TOMORROW'S STARTING PITCHER

- RHP Lucas Giolito (4-6, 7.08) is scheduled to make his 13th start of the season, sixth at home and second vs. Cleveland.
- Has walked 39 batters, the fourth-most in the majors ... the White Sox have scored one run or less in seven of his 12 starts, including zero runs five times.
- Earned the win in his last start on 6/5-2 at Minnesota after collecting his fifth quality start of the season, allowing two runs on six hits with two walks and one strikeout over 6.0 IP.
- Will make his second career start against Cleveland ... suffered the loss in his only start on 5/29 at Progressive Field (5 ER/6.0 IP).
