RED SOX NOTES (39-27)

THE RED SOX have lost each of their last 2 games...Allowed a franchise-record 8 HR (previous: 7 HR, 4 times).

- Also allowed season highs in runs (18), hits (20), and XBH (11)...Last allowed 18+ runs on 7/25/19 vs. NYY (19-3).
- Have allowed 5+ HR in back-to-back games for the 1st time in franchise history (5 on Friday, 8 today)...Did not allow 3+ HR in a game through their first 64 games...Allowed just 43 HR in their first 59 games prior to allowing 21 HR in the last 7 games.

XANDER BOGAERTS (1-for-3, R, HR, RBI, BB) hit a solo HR in the 2nd inning, his 1st plate appearance after missing the previous 2 games (left knee soreness).

- Has homered in 2 of his last 3 games...His HR today had an exit velocity of 110.2 mph, his 2nd hardest hit HR in the Statcast era (112.1 mph, 7/25/19 vs. NYY).
- During his season-best 9-game hitting streak, is batting .412 with 5 XBH, 8 RBI, and a 1.126 OPS (13-for-34, 8 R, 3 2B, 2 HR, 4 BB).

BOBBY DALBEC (1-for-3, R, HR, RBI, BB) hit a solo HR in the 7th inning...Is 5-for-15 (.333) with 4 XBH and 4 RBI in his last 4 games, after a 3-for-38 stretch (.079).

- Exit velocities of Dalbec's last 5 hits: 109.3 mph (single), 105.9 mph (double), 106.7 mph (HR), 100.9 mph (triple), and 108.1 mph (today's HR).

KIKÉ HERNÁNDEZ (1-for-4, 2B, 2 RBI) hit a 2-run double in the 5th inning...Is 7-for-26 (.269) with 4 2B and a .345 OBP in his last 7 games (2 R, 3 RBI, 2 BB, HBP).

MARTÍN PÉREZ (1.1 IP, 6 H, 5 R, BB) tossed the 3rd-shortest start of his career...Lasted 0.2 IP on 9/26/12 and 1.0 IP on 7/28/15, both with TEX.

MARWIN GONZALEZ (1.0 IP/0-for-1) made his 1st career pitching appearance, tossing the 8th and 9th innings...This season, Gonzalez has pitched and played 1B, 2B, 3B, SS, LF, and RF...The only other Red Sox to play each of those 7 positions in a season are Steve Lyons (1991) and Jack Rothrock (1928).

BLUE JAYS NOTES (33-30)

THE BLUE JAYS have won back-to-back games after losing 4 of their previous 5...Are 10-7 in their last 17 games following a season-long 6-game losing streak.

- Set season highs in runs (18), hits (20), HR (8), and XBH (11)...A franchise-record 7 Blue Jays hit at least 1 HR...Hit 5+ HR for the 4th time in 2021.
- Have hit 5+ HR in back-to-back games for the 3rd time in franchise history (also 8/12-14/20, 6/16-17/17)...Are the only team in the majors this season with 5+ HR in back-to-back games (previous: NYY 9/15-17/20, 3 games).
- Scored 4 runs in the 1st, 4th, and 5th innings, their 1st game with 4+ runs in 3 different innings since 8/26/16 vs. MIN (also 3 innings).

TEOSCAR HERNÁNDEZ (3-for-6, 2 R, 2B, 2 HR, 6 RBI) hit a pair of 3-run HR in his 11th career multi-HR game, 2nd of 2021 (also 5/12 at ATL)...Is the 1st Blue Jay with multiple 3-run HR in a game since Michael Saunders on 6/17/17 at BAL (2).

- Set a career high with 6 RBI...Is the 2nd Blue Jay with 6+ RBI in a game this year (Guerrero Jr., 4/27 vs. WSH, 7 RBI).

BO BICHETTE (4-for-5, 5 R, 2B, HR, 3 RBI, BB, SB) had a season-high 4 hits, including a 3-run HR in the 5th...Recorded his 8th SB of the season, tied for the team lead.

- Tied a franchise record with 5 runs scored (5th occurrence, previous: Josh Donaldson, 5/26/15 vs. CWS).

ROBBIE RAY (6.0 IP, 4 H, 3 R, 3 BB, 10 SO) recorded 10+ SO for the 2nd-straight start, 3rd time this season and 26th time in his career—4th most among active LHP...Is his first time with 10+ SO in back-to-back starts since 9/22-28/19.

- Has 86 SO over his last 10 starts, his most SO in a 10-game span since a career-high 87 from 6/30-9/15/17...The only Blue Jays with at least 86 SO in a 10-game span are Roger Clemens (25 times from 1997-98) and A.J. Burnett (2 times from 2006-08).

VLADIMIR GUERRERO JR. (3-for-5, 2 R, HR, 3 RBI) hit his MLB-leading 21st HR...Recorded 3+ hits for the 11th time this season, most in the majors...At the conclusion of today's game, led the majors in HR (21), RBI (55), OBP (.450), SLG (.688), OPS (1.137), and total bases (154), and led the AL in AVG (.344)

- Has homered in 3 consecutive games for the 2nd time in his career, both this season (also 5/13-16).

MARCUS SEMIEN (2-for-4, 2 R, HR, 2 RBI) singled and scored in the 1st inning and hit a solo HR in the 2nd...Has homered in back-to-back games for the 1st time since 8/15-16/20...14 of his 15 HR this season have been hit while playing second base, the most at the position in the majors this season.

CAVAN BIGGIO (2-for-4, 2 R, 2B, HR, RBI, BB) homered in back-to-back games for the 2nd time in his career (also 8/30-31/19).
