RED SOX NOTES (40-27)

THE RED SOX earned their 3rd walk-off win of the season, their 2nd of the series (also 4/6 vs. TB, 6/11 vs. TOR).

- 👉 This is the 10th time the Red Sox have earned multiple walk-off wins vs. TOR in a season (2 each time, previous: 2020).
- 👉 Snapped a 2-game losing streak, winning the series finale to earn the 4-game series split...Are 17-8 (.680) against AL East clubs this season.

RAFAEL DEVERS (2-for-4, RBI) hit a walk-off single off the left-center field wall with 1 out in the 9th...Was his 2nd career walk-off RBI (also 4/11/19 vs. TOR).

NATHAN EOVALDI (6.2 IP, 3 H, BB, 4 SO) tossed his 2nd scoreless start of the season (also 5/29 vs. MIA, 5.1 IP)...Was his 1st scoreless start of at least 6.2 innings since doing so in back-to-back starts to begin his Red Sox career in 2018 (7/29 vs. MIN-7.0 IP, 8/4 vs. NYY-8.0 IP).

- 👉 Retired each of his first 10 batters before allowing a single with 1 out in the 4th inning (Bo Bichette).
- 👉 Induced a 5-4-3 double play to his final batter faced (Randal Grichuk, 7th inning)...Eovaldi's 4-hardest thrown pitches came in the 6th inning, all fastballs of at least 98.8 mph.
- 👉 In his last 5 starts, is 3-1 with a 2.48 ERA (8 ER/29.0 IP).
- 👉 In 4 starts against AL East opponents this season, is 2-1 with a 1.08 ERA (3 ER/25.0 IP).

ALEX VERDUGO (2-for-4, R, 2B, RBI) hit an RBI double with 2 outs in the 3rd inning, giving the Red Sox a 1-0 lead...Singled to begin the 9th and scored the game-winning run on Rafael Devers' single.

- 👉 In 24 games beginning 5/15, is batting .314 with an .896 OPS (27-for-86, 13 R, 6 2B, 4 HR, 12 RBI, 8 BB).

MATT BARNES (1.0 IP, H, R, 3 SO) struck out his first 2 batters faced before allowing a game-tying solo HR to Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (0-1 pitch)...Struck out Teoscar Hernández to end the inning...Has struck out 50 of 103 batters faced this season (48.5%).

JOSH TAYLOR (1.1 IP, 3 SO) retired all 4 batters faced...Was his 18th consecutive scoreless appearance (beginning 4/30), extending a career-best streak.

- 👉 During the streak, which is the longest active of consecutive scoreless appearances, has thrown 14.0 IP with just 7 hits and 4 walks allowed, striking out 18... Has lowered his season ERA from 9.72 to 3.63 during the streak.
- 👉 Entered with 2 outs, a 1-0 lead, and a runner at third base in the 7th inning...Struck out Rowdy Tellez to strand the runner at third.

BLUE JAYS NOTES (33-31)

THE BLUE JAYS lost on a walk-off for the 2nd time in this series and 4th time this season (also 4/17 at KC, 5/30 at CLE, 6/11 at BOS)...Each of their last 3 losses at Fenway Park have been on a walk-off (also 9/5/20).

- 👉 Split the 4-game series...Are 9-8-4 in series play...Have lost 5 of their last 8 games, but are 10-8 in their last 18 following a season-long 6-game losing streak.
- 👉 Were held to 4 hits, tied for their 3rd-fewest in a game this season (4/18 at KC-2, 5/4 at OAK-3).

VLADIMIR GUERRERO JR. (2-for-4, R, HR, RBI) hit his MLB-leading 22nd home run in the 9th inning to tie the game, 1-1...Was his first career game-tying or go-ahead HR in the 9th inning or later.

- 👉 Homered in 4 consecutive games for the 1st time in his career...Is the first Blue Jay to do so since Randal Grichuk from 8/16-19/20.

ALEK MANOAH (6.0 IP, 4 H, R, BB, 5 SO) has allowed 1 or 0 ER and 4 hits or fewer over 5.0+ IP in 3 of his first 4 career starts.

- 👉 Is the 1st pitcher in Blue Jays history to pitch 3.0+ innings and allow 4 hits or fewer as a starter in each of their first 4 career games.
- 👉 Held Red Sox right-handed batters to 0-for-14 (BB, 4 SO), while left-handed batters went 4-for-7 (1 SO)...Struck out his last 3 batters faced.

BO BICHETTE (1-for-4, SB) singled in the 4th inning, the Blue Jays' first hit...Recorded his team-leading 9th stolen base of the year.

- 👉 Batted .419 (13-for-31) with 10 runs scored, 2 doubles, 2 HR, 5 RBI and 2 SB on the Blue Jays' 7-game road trip.
- 👉 Has a hit in each of his first 15 career games vs. BOS, batting .375 (24-for-64, 8 2B, 4 HR, 12 RBI)...The 15-game streak vs. BOS is the longest to start a career since Yuli Gurriel (16 games) from 2017-19 and ties Edgar Martinez from 1989-91 and Cy Seymour in 1901 as the 5th-longest all-time to start a career vs. BOS.

MARCUS SEMIEN (0-for-4) snapped his franchise-record road hitting streak at 26 games, the longest in MLB since Dexter Fowler in 2015 (27 games).
