

# BOSTON RED SOX SPRING TRAINING GAME NOTES



**Boston Red Sox (7-10-2) vs. St. Louis Cardinals (9-7-2)**

**YESTERDAY'S NEWS:** The Red Sox earned a 2-1 win over the Braves last night in North Port...Ryan Weber started and threw 4.0 scoreless innings, allowing only 1 hit.

- Kevin Plawecki (1-for-3, BB) and Jonathan Lucroy (1-for-1, 2 BB) combined to reach base 5 times, while José Peraza went 2-for-3.

**START ME UP:** In 3 starts this spring, Ryan Weber has allowed 0 ER and issued 0 BB while holding opponents to a .182 AVG (9.0 IP, 6 H, 11 SO)...In his 14 Grapefruit League games since the start of 2018, he has posted a 0.99 ERA (3 ER/27.1 IP).

**SOX & CARDINALS:** Today marks the first of 2 spring training meetings between the Red Sox and Cardinals... They will also play Sunday, 3/15, in Jupiter.

- The Sox and Cardinals will meet in Interleague play during the regular season, with a 3-game series scheduled for Friday-Sunday, 6/26-28...They are tied in the all-time regular-season series, 8-8, but the Sox have won the last 4 meetings.

**JUNIOR MINTS:** Jackie Bradley Jr. has hit safely in each of his last 5 games...Overall in Grapefruit League play, he has hit .417 (10-for-24) with 2 HR.

- In 2019, Bradley was batting .144 at the end of play on 5/19, but in 109 games from 5/20 through the end of the season he hit .252 with 21 HR and an .846 OPS.
- Last season, Bradley led AL center fielders in assists (10) and double plays (3)...He earned MLB Network's 2019 Play of the Year for robbing Trey Mancini of a HR in the 11th inning on 5/8/19...The HR would have ended the game, but the Sox went on to win in 12 innings, 2-1.

**BARNES & NOBLE:** Matt Barnes is scheduled to pitch in relief today...In 2019, his average of 15.39 SO/9.0 IP led the AL and ranked 2nd in the majors behind Josh Hader (16.41)... He posted a 2.63 ERA (8 ER/27.1 IP) after the All-Star break.

- Barnes is the only AL pitcher to make at least 60 appearances and throw at least 60.0 innings in each of the last 4 seasons (2016-19)...The only NL pitcher to do that is Kenley Jansen.
- Barnes has increased his SO/9.0 IP rate from each season to the next...In 2018 and 2019 combined he averaged 14.71 SO/9.0 IP, the AL's 2nd-highest mark behind only Aroldis Chapman (14.79) (min. 100.0 IP).

**FENWAY (SOUTH) FAITHFUL:** The Red Sox have sold out each of their last 144 home Grapefruit League games, including their final 10 at City of Palms Park and all 134 at jetBlue Park since its opening in 2012 (9 in 2020)...The Sox have sold out 247 of their last 248 home Grapefruit League games.

- This is the 28th consecutive season the Sox have called Fort Myers, FL, their Spring Training home (1993-2020), breaking a tie with Winter Haven, FL (27 years, 1966-92), for their most years spent at a Spring Training city...The Sox are in their 9th spring at the Fenway South Spring Training and Player Development Complex (2012-20), having played at City of Palms Park from 1993-2011.

**MOST RECENT ROSTER MOVES:** On Sunday, the Red Sox reassigned 8 players to minor league camp and optioned 7 players to the minor leagues...They now have 47 players in major league camp, including 33 members of the 40-man roster and 14 non-roster invitees.

- On Thursday, the Red Sox signed RHP Collin McHugh to a 1-year contract for the 2020 season...To make room on the 40-man roster, the club designated RHP Hector Velázquez for assignment...Velázquez was claimed off waivers by the Orioles yesterday.

**AHEAD IN 2020:** The Red Sox' regular season will begin with a 7-game road trip through TOR (3/26-29) and BAL (3/30-4/1)...Their home opener is set for Thursday, 4/2 vs. CWS.

- The Sox' 2020 Interleague schedule will include 16 games vs. NL Central opponents: 3 vs. MIL, 3 vs. STL, 3 at CHC, 3 at PIT, and 4 against CIN (2 home, 2 road)...They will also play 4 games against ATL (2 home, 2 road)...The Sox will be making their first trip to Wrigley Field since 2012, and their first trip to PNC Park since 2014.

**GOLDEN GLOVES:** Nine players in Red Sox camp have been named a Gold Glove Award finalist at least once: OFs **Jackie Bradley Jr.** (2014, '16, '18, '19), **Kevin Pillar** (2015, '16, '17), **Andrew Benintendi** (2018, '19), and **J.D. Martinez** (2015); catchers **Jonathan Lucroy** (2014, '16) and **Christian Vázquez** (2019); SS **Xander Bogaerts** (2015); 1B **Mitch Moreland** (2016, '17, '18); and LHP **Chris Sale** (2017);

- Moreland (2016, 1B) and Bradley (2018, CF) are the only Red Sox in camp to win a Gold Glove Award.

**VETERAN PRESENCE:** Five players in Red Sox camp have 8+ years of MLB service time: Jonathan Lucroy (9 years, 136 days), Mitch Moreland (9.067), Chris Sale (9.061), J.D. Martinez (8.036), and Nathan Eovaldi (8.013).

- The oldest Red Sox player in camp is 34-year-old Mitch Moreland (born 9/6/85), while the youngest is 21-year-old Jonathan Araúz (born 8/3/98).
- Dustin Pedroia, who is on the 60-day injured list, is 36 years old; he has 13 years and 41 days of MLB service.

**FRESH FACES:** When the Red Sox opened spring training in 2019, Colten Brewer was the only player on the 40-man roster who was not in the organization the previous year.

- In 2020, the Sox have 13 players on their 40-man roster who were not in the organization last year, including 5 position players: INF Jonathan Araúz, INF José Peraza, OF Kevin Pillar, C Kevin Plawecki, and OF Alex Verdugo.
- 8 of the Red Sox' 40-man pitchers were not in the organization last year: RHP Austin Brice, LHP Matt Hall, RHP Chris Mazza, RHP Collin McHugh, LHP Josh Osich, LHP Martin Pérez, LHP Jeffrey Springs, and RHP Phillips Valdez.

**WHAT A RELIEF:** The Red Sox return each of their top 9 leaders in relief appearances from 2019...Last year, Red Sox relief pitchers led the majors with 10.50 SO/9.0 IP.

**HEART OF THE ORDER:** Last year marked the first time in franchise history the Red Sox featured 3 players who hit .300+ with 30+ HR: J.D. Martinez (.304/36), Xander Bogaerts (.309/33), and Rafael Devers (.311/32).

- Each of those 3 players also had 100+ RBI in 2019...The other 29 teams feature a total of 4 players who hit .300+ with 30+ HR and 100+ RBI last season (Nelson Cruz, Anthony Rendon, Nolan Arenado, and Cody Bellinger).

**DOWN ON THE FARM:** The Red Sox entered 2019 ranked 30th of 30 in *Baseball America's* organizational rankings, with 0 top-100 prospects...This year, the Sox are ranked 20th in the club rankings, with 3 top-100 prospects: 1B/3B Triston Casas (70), 3B/1B Bobby Dalbec (75), and INF Jeter Downs (86).

- 5 of the Sox' top 6 prospects as ranked by *Baseball America* were invited to Major League camp this year: 1B/3B Bobby Dalbec (No. 2), INF Jeter Downs (No. 3), RHP Bryan Mata (No. 4), OF Jaren Duran (No. 5), and LHP Darwinson Hernandez (No. 6).

**TEAM OF THE CENTURY:** In 18 seasons under their current ownership group (Henry-Werner, 2002-2019), the Red Sox have won more World Series titles (4) than any other team... In that time, the Sox also rank 2nd in regular season winning percentage (.557; 1,625-1,291).

- The Sox have won 90+ games in 12 of the last 18 seasons, including in 3 of the last 4.
