

# BOSTON RED SOX SPRING TRAINING GAME NOTES

**STATE OF THE SOX:** The Red Sox have earned a win on each of the last 4 days (4-1), having won each of their last 3 games after going 1-1 on Saturday.

🔥 In those 4 wins, the Sox allowed a total of 11 runs, defeating TOR (5-2), MIN (7-6), ATL (2-1), and STL (3-2)...Also in those 4 wins, Sox starters surrendered only 2 runs on 9 hits in 14.0 IP (1.29 ERA).

**YESTERDAY'S NEWS:** The Red Sox earned a 3-2 win over the Cardinals yesterday at jetBlue Park, after STL scored 2 runs in the top of the 1st inning...The Sox got on the board in the 4th inning when Kevin Pillar and Christian Vázquez hit back-to-back doubles, then took the lead on a 2-run single by Jantzen Witte in the 6th.

🔥 Relievers Josh Taylor (1.0 IP), Matt Barnes (1.0 IP), Colten Brewer (2.2 IP), and Robinson Leyer (1.1 IP) issued 0 BB with 9 SO, 0 runs, and 3 hits allowed in 6.0 IP.

**FOUR OF A KIND:** In 11 Grapefruit League starts, Eduardo Rodriguez, Nathan Eovaldi, Martín Pérez, and Ryan Weber have combined to post a 0.88 ERA and a 0.95 WHIP.

🔥 Eovaldi and Weber have allowed 0 ER in 17.0 IP, striking out 23 batters and walking only 1.

**STEADY EDDIE:** Eduardo Rodriguez is scheduled to make his 3rd Grapefruit League start tonight...On 2/29 vs. NYY, he struck out 6 batters and walked none in 3.0 scoreless innings.

🔥 In 2019, Rodriguez finished 6th in AL Cy Young Award voting...He set career highs in wins (19), starts (34), innings (203.1), and strikeouts (213).

🔥 The Sox went 26-8 (.765) in Rodriguez's starts in 2019, including 9-0 when he threw 7.0+ innings.

🔥 In his final 17 starts of the season (beginning 7/1), Rodriguez went 11-2 with a 2.90 ERA.

**FENWAY (SOUTH) FAITHFUL:** The Red Sox sold 10,090 tickets to yesterday's game against the Cardinals...They have sold out each of their last 145 home Grapefruit League games, including their final 10 at City of Palms Park and all 135 at jetBlue Park since its opening in 2012 (10 in 2020)...The Sox have sold out 248 of their last 249 home Grapefruit League games.

🔥 This is the 28th season the Sox have called Fort Myers, FL, their Spring Training home (1993-2020), breaking a tie with Winter Haven, FL (27 years, 1966-92), for their most years spent at a Spring Training city...The Sox are in their 9th spring at the Fenway South Spring Training and Player Development Complex (2012-20), having played at City of Palms Park from 1993-2011.

**MOST RECENT ROSTER MOVES:** On Sunday, the Red Sox reassigned 8 players to minor league camp and optioned 7 players to the minor leagues...They now have 47 players in major league camp, including 33 members of the 40-man roster and 14 non-roster invitees.

🔥 On Thursday, the Red Sox signed RHP Collin McHugh to a 1-year contract for the 2020 season...To make room on the 40-man roster, the club designated RHP Hector Velázquez for assignment...Velázquez was claimed off waivers by the Orioles.

**WHAT A RELIEF:** The Red Sox return each of their top 9 leaders in relief appearances from 2019...Last year, Red Sox relief pitchers led the majors with 10.50 SO/9.0 IP.

**SOX & RAYS:** Tonight marks the 3rd of 5 spring training meetings between the Red Sox and Rays...These teams will also play on 3/13 and 3/19 at jetBlue Park in Fort Myers.

🔥 The Sox and Rays will begin their 19-game regular season series with a 3-game set at Fenway Park from 4/6-8, with additional games in Boston from 5/19-21 and 9/11-13, as well as 10 games in St. Petersburg from 6/9-11, 8/7-9, and 9/17-20.

🔥 The Sox lost their 2019 season series to the Rays, 12-7... BOS went 6-4 at Tropicana Field and 1-8 at Fenway Park.

**CENTER OF ATTENTION:** Jackie Bradley Jr. (.385 AVG) and Kevin Pillar (.370 AVG) have combined to hit .377 with a 1.006 OPS (20-for-53, 5 2B, 2 HR, 3 BB, 1 HBP).

🔥 Bradley has been named a Gold Glove Award finalist 4 times (2014, '16, '18, '19), winning the award in 2018... Pillar has been a finalist 3 times (2015, '16, '17).

🔥 In 2019, Bradley hit .252 with 21 HR and an .846 OPS from 5/20 through the end of the season (109 G)...Pillar set career highs in games (161), runs (83), triples (3), HR (21), RBI (88), XBH (61), and SLG (.432).

**BACK ME UP:** Kevin Plawecki has recorded a .609 OBP this spring, going 8-for-17 (.471) with 6 BB and only 2 SO... He has hit safely in each of his 8 games with an at-bat and reached base in all 9 of his games played.

🔥 The Sox signed Plawecki to a 1-year contract on 1/2/20...In 2019, he spent an entire season on an active ML roster for the first time in his career, appearing in 57 games with CLE (46 starts).

**THE BRICE YOU PAY:** Austin Brice, who is scheduled to pitch in relief tonight, has struck out 10 batters and walked only 1 in 5.2 scoreless innings over 4 relief outings, holding opponents to a .100 AVG (2-for-20).

🔥 Brice was acquired by the Red Sox on 1/10/20 from MIA, in exchange for minor league SS Angeudis Santos.

🔥 Brice would become the first player born in China to appear in a regular season game for the Red Sox...When he made his ML debut in 2016, he became the first player born in Hong Kong ever to play in the majors.

**VETERAN PRESENCE:** Five players in Red Sox camp have 8+ years of MLB service time: Jonathan Lucroy (9 years, 136 days), Mitch Moreland (9.067), Chris Sale (9.061), J.D. Martinez (8.036), and Nathan Eovaldi (8.013).

🔥 The oldest Red Sox player in camp is 34-year-old Mitch Moreland (born 9/6/85), while the youngest is 21-year-old Jonathan Araúz (born 8/3/98).

🔥 Dustin Pedroia, who is on the 60-day injured list, is 36 years old; he has 13 years and 41 days of MLB service.

**FRESH FACES:** When the Red Sox opened spring training in 2019, Colten Brewer was the only player on the 40-man roster who was not in the organization the previous year.

🔥 In 2020, the Sox have 13 players on their 40-man roster who were not in the organization last year, including 5 position players: Jonathan Araúz, José Peraza, Kevin Pillar, Kevin Plawecki, and Alex Verdugo.

🔥 8 of the Red Sox' 40-man pitchers were not in the organization last year: Austin Brice, Matt Hall, Chris Mazza, Collin McHugh, Josh Osich, Martín Pérez, Jeffrey Springs, and Phillips Valdez.

**HEART OF THE ORDER:** Last year marked the first time in franchise history the Red Sox featured 3 players who hit .300+ with 30+ HR: J.D. Martinez (.304/36), Xander Bogaerts (.309/33), and Rafael Devers (.311/32).

🔥 Each of those 3 players also had 100+ RBI in 2019...The other 29 teams feature a total of 4 players who hit .300+ with 30+ HR and 100+ RBI last season (Nelson Cruz, Anthony Rendon, Nolan Arenado, and Cody Bellinger).

**AHEAD IN 2020:** The Red Sox' regular season will begin with a 7-game road trip through TOR (3/26-29) and BAL (3/30-4/1)...Their home opener is set for Thursday, 4/2 vs. CWS.

🔥 The Sox' 2020 Interleague schedule will include 16 games vs. NL Central opponents: 3 vs. MIL, 3 vs. STL, 3 at CHC, 3 at PIT, and 4 against CIN (2 home, 2 road)...They will also play 4 games against ATL (2 home, 2 road).
