## BOSTON RED SOX (1-2) vs. HOUSTON ASTROS (2-1)

Monday, October 9, 2017 • 1:08 p.m. ET • Fenway Park • Boston, MA

**STAYIN' ALIVE:** The Red Sox defeated the Astros yesterday, 10-3, after losing the first 2 games of the series...In each of the previous 2 Division Series in which the Sox won Game 3 after dropping Games 1 and 2, they went on to win the series (1999 vs. CLE, 2003 vs. OAK).

• This is the 7th time the Sox have faced a 2-games-to-none deficit in a Division Series...They came back to win the 1999 and 2003 series and were swept in the other 4 (1995, 2005, 2009, 2016).

• Prior to 2017, 54 teams had lost the first 2 games of a Division Series; 7 of them came back to win the series: 1981 Dodgers (vs. HOU), 1995 Mariners (vs. NYY), 1999 Red Sox, 2001 Yankees (vs. OAK), 2003 Red Sox, 2012 Giants (vs. CIN), and 2015 Blue Jays (vs. TEX).

**NEVER GIVE UP:** The Red Sox scored the final 10 runs of yesterday's game after coming to bat in the 2nd inning with a 3-0 deficit...That tied the club's largest deficit ever overcome to win a Division Series game (also 1999 ALDS-G5 at CLE, trailed 5-2, won 12-8)...It marked the Sox' largest comeback win in any postseason game since Game 2 of the 2013 ALCS vs. DET (trailed 5-0, won 6-5).

• Yesterday marked the 16th time this season between the regular season and postseason the Sox have allowed 3+ runs in the 1st inning; they have come back to win 8 of those games...BOS has overcome a deficit of 3+ runs in 6 of its last 11 wins (since 9/15).

**ON THE OFFENSIVE:** Yesterday marked the 15th time the Red Sox have scored 10+ runs in a postseason game (last: 2013 ALDS-G1 vs. TB, W 12-2), as well as the 10th time they recorded 15+ hits (last: 2007 WS-G3 at COL, 15 hits).

• The Sox' 6-through-9 hitters accounted for all 10 of the club's RBI yesterday (Ramirez-3, Devers-3, Leon-1, Bradley-3)...According to Elias, it marked the 1st time a team scored 10+ runs in a postseason game without receiving an RBI from players batting in the 1-through-5 spots in the batting order (since RBI became an official stat in 1920).

**PRICE CHECK:** David Price threw 4.0 scoreless innings of relief in yesterday's win...The only other Red Sox pitchers to allow 0 runs in a postseason relief appearance of at least 4.0 innings are Pedro Martinez (6.0 IP, 1999 ALDS Game 5 at CLE), Tex Hughson (4.1 IP, 1946 WS Game 6 at STL), and Ray Collins (7.0 IP, 1912 WS Game 6 at NYG).

• Price has not allowed a run in any of his 7 appearances—including the postseason—since returning from the 10-day DL on 9/14 (15.1 IP, 8 H, 4 BB, 19 SO)...In that time, Price has held opponents to a .145 AVG and a .367 OPS (8-for-55, 1 2B).

**DEVERS' ENDEAVORS:** Rafael Devers gave the Red Sox a 4-3 lead with a 3-run HR in the 3rd inning of yesterday's win...At 20 years and 349 days old, he became the youngest player ever to hit a postseason HR for the Sox (previous: Andrew Benintendi in Game 1 of the 2016 ALDS at CLE).

• The only other players ever to hit a postseason HR before turning 21 are Mickey Mantle, Andruw Jones, Miguel Cabrera, Manny Machado, and Bryce Harper.

• In Game 1 on Thursday, Devers became the youngest position player ever to appear in a postseason game for the Red Sox (20 years, 346 days)...The only other Red Sox to appear in a postseason game before their 21st birthday are Babe Ruth in 1915 and Ken Brett in 1967.

**ROSTER BREAKDOWN:** The Red Sox' ALDS roster features 11 pitchers and 14 position players...6 of the Red Sox' position players have appeared in 10+ postseason games: Dustin Pedroia (50), Mitch Moreland (36), Rajai Davis (19), Hanley Ramirez (19), Xander Bogaerts (18), and Chris Young (15).

• 6 of the Red Sox' pitchers have appeared in 5 or more postseason games: David Price (17), Joe Kelly (16), Addison Reed (12), Rick Porcello (10), Doug Fister (10), and Craig Kimbrel (9).

**HOME FIELD ADVANTAGE:** The Red Sox are 43-32-1 all-time in postseason games at Fenway Park...They are 27-14 (.659) in home playoff games since 1999, including 11-4 (.733) in the Division Series.

**TAKE ON ME:** Hanley Ramirez went 4-for-4 with 3 RBI in yesterday's win, becoming the 3rd Red Sox player ever to go 4-for-4 or better in a postseason game (also Rich Gedman and Spike Owen in the 1986 ALCS vs. CLE).

• Ramirez has posted a .373/.447/.582 batting line with 14 RBI in 19 career postseason games (25-for-67, 9 2B, 1 3B, 1 HR)...Among players with 75+ postseason plate appearances, he ranks 3rd all-time in AVG behind Lou Brock (.391) and Justin Turner (.375), as well as T-4th in OBP (Turner-.487, Lou Gehrig-.483, Babe Ruth-.470, Carl Yastrzemski-.447).

**THE CONSTANT:** Dustin Pedroia has started at 2B in all 50 Red Sox postseason games since 2007...The only other players in ML history with 50+ postseason starts at 2B are Mark Lemke (61), Roberto Alomar (56), Chase Utley (54), Robinson Canó (51), and Joe Morgan (50).

• Among that group, the only players (along with Pedroia) to start 50+ consecutive postseason games for a single team are Lemke (55 for ATL from 1991-96) and Canó (51 for NYY from 2005-12).

**SOX & 'STROS:** This is the 1st time the Red Sox and Astros are meeting in the postseason...These clubs closed out their respective regular-season schedules with 4 games against each other at Fenway Park from 9/28-10/1...This is the 1st time the Sox have ever begun a postseason against the team they played in their regular-season finale...The last teams to play each other in a regular-season finale and then in a postseason opener were the 2013 Reds and Pirates.

**MANAGING EXPECTATIONS:** John Farrell is 12-10 in postseason games, all with BOS...He ranks 2nd all-time among Red Sox managers in postseason games managed and postseason wins...The only other manager to lead BOS to the postseason 3+ times is Terry Francona (5 times).

• Farrell has led the Sox to 3 AL East titles in a 5-year span (2013, '16, '17)...He is the only manager in club history to finish in 1st place 3 times...Prior to 2016-17, it had been 101 years since a Red Sox team finished in 1st place in consecutive years (1915-1916)...Prior to Farrell becoming manager in 2013, BOS won 2 AL East titles in the previous 22 seasons (1991-2012).

**BACK IN THE POSTSEASON:** The Red Sox are making their 23rd postseason appearance...Boston has made 9 trips to the postseason in the past 15 years (2003-17), including in each of the last 2 seasons.

• The Red Sox are 91-82-1 all-time in postseason play...They are 19-14 in 33 postseason series, having gone 6-5 in 11 trips to the ALDS (20-23 in DS play), 5-5 in the ALCS (26-31), and 8-4 in the World Series (45-28-1).

• The Red Sox' 8 World Series titles are tied with the Giants for 4th all-time behind the Yankees (27), Cardinals (11), and A's (9)...The Sox have won 3 of the last 13 World Series, tied with the Giants for the most championships this century.

POSTSEASON:

- Will be making his 2nd appearance of the series, after tossing 1.0 scoreless frame in relief during Game 1 on 10/5 at HOU.
- His last postseason start came in Game 1 of the 2016 ALDS at CLE (L, 4.1 IP, 6 H, 5 R, 6 SO).

TODAY'S START:

- Won 7 of his final 11 outings of 2017 after going 4-14 through his first 22 starts.
- Lost a ML-high 9 quality starts, the most by a Red Sox pitcher since Milt Gaston also lost 9 in 1930.
- Went 3-5 with a 2.61 ERA (17 ER/58.2 IP) over 9 day starts this season.

2017 RANKINGS:

- Was 1 of 4 AL pitchers (1 of 8 ML pitchers) to toss multiple complete games (went 0-2 in CG).
- Ranked among AL leaders in starts (T-3rd, 33), IP (5th, 203.1), SO (9th, 181), BB/9.0 IP ratio (5th, 2.12), and SO/BB ratio (7th, 3.77).
- His 19 starts with 1 or 0 BB were tied for the 2nd-most in the AL (Josh Tomlin-23, Chris Sale-19, Corey Kluber-19, Carlos Carrasco-19).
- Led MLB with 20 UER allowed, the most during a season by a Red Sox since Tim Wakefield in 2011 (22).

VS. THE ASTROS:

- Last started against HOU on 6/17/17 at Minute Maid Park (L, 6.0 IP, 10 H, 7 R, BB, 3 SO).
- In his only other 2 career starts against the club in 2013-14 with DET, was 1-0 with a 3.29 ERA (5 ER/13.2 IP).

2017 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Reached double-digit wins for the 8th time in 9 ML seasons (9 in 2015 with BOS).
- Matched a career high with a team-leading 33 starts (also 33 in 2016 with BOS)...Made 30+ starts for the 6th time in his career...Joins Max Scherzer and Jon Lester as the only pitchers to make 27+ starts in each of the last 9 seasons.
- Logged 200.0+ IP for the 2nd consecutive season, and 3rd career time (204.2 in 2004 with DET, 223.1 IP in 2016 with BOS).
- Tossed 6.0+ IP in 19 straight starts from 4/19-7/28...Marked the longest such streak in MLB this year, and 2nd-longest of his career (20 starts from 6/28/16-4/9/17).

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:

- Won the 2016 AL Cy Young Award after leading MLB in wins (22-4, 3.15 ERA) and SO/BB ratio (5.91)...Also named AL Comeback Player of the Year by MLB.
- Over the course of his career, has issued 2.05 BB/9.0 IP, the 2nd-lowest rate in the AL among active pitchers and the 4th-lowest in the majors (min. 1,000.0 IP).
