

# BOSTON RED SOX SPRING TRAINING GAME NOTES

**STATE OF THE SOX:** The Red Sox began their Grapefruit League slate with a 1-5 record, but they are 8-6-2 in their last 16 games.

- Between Grapefruit League and exhibition games, BOS is 9-4 at home and 2-7-2 on the road...The Sox are 0-4-1 in their last 5 games away from home.
- BOS is playing 39 games in 38 days during spring training, including 4 exhibition contests...The club's lone off day from 2/23-4/1 is scheduled for 3/22.

**JIMMY FUND VISIT:** A group from the Jimmy Fund is visiting Fort Myers today for the organization's annual trip to Spring Training...The group will take batting practice at Jet-Blue Park today at 4 p.m.; tomorrow, the children will visit with Red Sox players in the morning and then watch the game against the Twins from a suite.

**CLOSE CALLS:** In 6 of the last 7 days, the Red Sox have played a game that was decided by 1 run or ended in a tie: Sat. vs. TB (W, 2-1), Sun. at PHI (L, 5-6), Mon. at TOR (L, 3-4), Tue. vs. TOR (W, 5-4), Wed. at TB (T, 3-3), and Thu. vs. PIT (W, 4-3)...6 of the Sox' 11 losses have come by 1 run.

**CHAIRMAN'S CUP:** The 2017 Chairman's Cup (formerly Mayor's Cup) between the Red Sox and Twins continues today with the 3rd of 6 scheduled meetings...BOS defeated MIN, 8-7, on 2/25 at JetBlue Park...The Twins shut out the Sox, 13-0, on 3/11 at Hammond Stadium.

- The Red Sox trail the Twins, 11-12-1, in the yearly series, which began in 1993...Minnesota owns a 71-62-1 edge in those contests.
- BOS has lost the Cup just twice in the last 10 years, taking 7 of those and tying once...Prior to that stretch, the Twins took 10 of the first 14 series (1993-2006).

**OPENING ACT:** Rick Porcello has been named the Red Sox' Opening Day starting pitcher (4/3 vs. PIT)...This will be the 1st O.D. start of his career...Porcello has started his club's 4th game of the season 6 times (2009-12, '14, '16), the 3rd game once (2013), and the 2nd game once (2015).

- Porcello won the 2016 AL Cy Young Award after leading the majors in wins (22) and SO/BB ratio (5.91)...The Red Sox went 25-8 in his starts last season, including 17-3 in his final 20...BOS was 15-1 in his home starts in 2016, having won each of his first 14.
- Porcello has pitched 6.0+ innings in each of his last 18 starts, the majors' longest active streak to begin 2017...He has thrown at least 5.0 innings in 41 consecutive starts, the AL's longest active streak.

**WRIGHT ON TIME:** Steven Wright is making his 2nd appearance of spring training today...He started for the Sox on 3/13 at TOR, tossing 2.0 hitless and scoreless innings.

- Wright missed the final month of the 2016 season recovering from a right shoulder strain...He made his 1st career All-Star team last season after leading qualifying AL pitchers in ERA (2.68), opponent SLG (.322), complete games (tied, 3), and HR/9.0 IP ratio (0.55) at the break...He and Chris Sale were the only 2 AL pitchers to throw as many as 4 complete games in 2016.

**BUY LOCAL:** Of the 49 players in Red Sox major league camp, only RHP Matt Barnes was born in New England (Danbury, CT)...Barnes has not allowed a run in his last 5 appearances (5.0 IP, 2 H).

**1-THROUGH-5:** The first 5 batters in today's Red Sox lineup are batting a combined .316 (42-for-133) in Grapefruit League games this season...5 players in the starting lineup are batting above .300: Dustin Pedroia (.381), Andrew Benintendi (.324), Chris Young (.308), Pablo Sandoval (.314), and Blake Swihart (.318).

**ON BASE MACHINE:** Marco Hernandez has reached base via hit or BB in each of his 13 Grapefruit League games this spring...He leads the Sox in OBP (.462), hits (13), BB (tied, 5), and triples (2) and is batting .382 (13-for-34) with a 1.079 OPS.

- In 30 career Grapefruit League games with the Red Sox (2015-17), Hernandez has hit .446 with a .508 OBP and a .696 SLG (25-for-56, 10 2B, 2 3B, 7 BB, 13 R, 11 RBI).

**SLAMMIN' SAM TRAVIS:** Sam Travis has hit .400 and slugged .700 (28-for-70, 6 2B, 5 HR) with 24 RBI in 37 career Grapefruit League games (2015-17)...6 of his 11 hits this spring have gone for extra bases (3 HR, 3 2B).

- Travis leads the Red Sox in HR (3), RBI (10), SLG (.719), and OPS (1.151)...He also led BOS with 13 RBI in only 18 Grapefruit League games in 2016.

**WORLD TOUR:** SS Xander Bogaerts (Netherlands), LHP Fernando Abad (Dominican Republic), and minor league OF Mike Meyers (Israel) are representing the Red Sox at the 2017 World Baseball Classic.

- The Netherlands is 4-2 in the tournament and has advanced to the single-elimination championship round (3/20-22 at Dodger Stadium)...Bogaerts has started all 6 games at 3B (4-for-19, 3B, 6 BB, 2 RBI, 4 R).
- The D.R. is 4-1 and will play the U.S. tonight at 10 p.m. (ET) in San Diego, with the winner advancing to the championship round and the losing team being eliminated...Abad has made 3 appearances, all scoreless (2.1 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 1 SO).
- Team Israel went 4-2 but has been eliminated...Meyers appeared in 3 games (0-for-1, BB, 2 R).

**FIRST IMPRESSION:** Signed by BOS as a minor league free agent on 1/14/17, Kyle Kendrick is 2-0 with a 1.50 ERA (3 ER/18.0 IP) in 5 appearances (4 starts) this spring...He has not allowed a run in his last 15.0 innings.

- Among qualifying pitchers in both the Grapefruit and Cactus leagues, Kendrick ranks 1st in innings (18.0), 4th in ERA (1.50) and WHIP (0.83), 5th in opponent AVG (.188), and T-7th in strikeouts (16).
- In his last 3 starts, Kendrick has held opponents to 0 runs and a .159 AVG (7-for-44, 9 SO, 3 BB).

**ROSTER MOVES:** Prior to Friday's game vs. HOU, the Sox optioned RHP Kyle Martin and LHP Luis Ysla to Triple-A Pawtucket and reassigned RHP Marcus Walden to minor league camp.

- Prior to Tuesday's game vs. TOR, the Red Sox optioned LHPs Brian Johnson and Henry Owens and RHP Brandon Workman to Pawtucket...3B Rafael Devers, OF Junior Lake, and C Jordan Procysen were reassigned to minor league camp.

**GOOD LUCK CHARM:** Jackie Bradley Jr. had 2 HR and 5 RBI in the Sox' 19-2 win over the Rays on 3/2, then homered in a 7-5 win over Team USA on 3/9...In the regular season, the Sox are 33-5 (.868) all-time in games in which Bradley homers, including 10-0 since 7/29/16.

**HAVE WE BENINTRODUCED?:** Red Sox OF Andrew Benintendi is ranked No. 1 overall in *Baseball America's* Top 100 Prospects list...Since the list debuted in 1990, the only other Red Sox player to begin a season ranked No. 1 overall is Daisuke Matsuzaka (2007).

- Also representing the Red Sox on *Baseball America's* Top 100 Prospects list are 3B Rafael Devers (No. 18) and LHP Jason Groome (No. 43).

**YOUTH BRIGADE:** Dustin Pedroia (born 8/17/83), Chris Young (9/5/83), and Hanley Ramirez (12/23/83) are the oldest players in Red Sox camp, and they are only 33 years old.

- 22-year-olds Andrew Benintendi (born 7/6/94) and Jamie Callahan (born 8/24/94) are the youngest Red Sox in major league camp.
