WINS AND LOSSES: The Rangers snapped a 6-game losing streak vs. BOS and a 7-game losing streak at Fenway Park in the opener of this 4-game series and 7-game toadtrip on Monday...TEX has won 3 of 4, 5 of 7, 8 of 11 and 10 of 14, the latter span beginning 5/28...team's .700 win pct. (7-3) in June is 2nd best in the A.L. to .778 for HOU (7-2), 6th best in MLB...TEX has an 18-8 (.692) record since 5/15 is 4th-best in MLB, trailing only LAD and MIN (both .739, 17-6) and HOU (.708, 17-8) and **leading MLB in wins in that span**...season-high 5-G win streak from 5/19-24 was Rangers' 2nd-longest streak since start of 2018 (7-0 from 6/16-23/18)...current 18-8 run began after a 5-G losing streak from 5/9-14 that matched longest of 2019 (also 0-5 from 4/22-26)...TEX is 23-17 since 4/27.

- At 35-30 (.538), Rangers rank 5th in the A.L./10 in MLB in winning percentage and have matched their season best at 5 games above .500 (also 34-29 on 6/8-N)...club has not been more than 5+ game over .500 since the end of the 2016 season (95-67)...team has had a winning record for each of last 19 days...this is Texas' best 65-G start since 2016 (40-25), 2nd-best in last 6 seasons (beg. 2014).

- TEX was below .500 for 12 straight days prior to current 19-day stretch above the mark and was a season-low 5-under after loss 5/14 (17-22).

- Texas' win on Monday snapped a 4-game losing streak in series openers...club is now 6-16 in game one of a series, 3-7 on the road,

IN THE STANDINGS: Texas is in sole possession of 2nd place in the A.L. West for a 10th straight day, 9.0 GB of division-leading HOU who was idle on Monday., when Rangers gained ground for 2nd time in last 3 days...TEX currently holds the 2nd Wild Card position, 2.0 GA of BOS and CLE... Rangers have been between 7.0 GB and 10.0 GB for 23 straight days.

ON THE ROAD: Texas has 3 consecutive away games since a loss on 5/27 at SEA to match its longest road win streak of 2019 (5/15-24)...the Rangers last away win streak of more than 3 contests was 4 straight victories, 7/27-30/18...club has won 6 of last 9 away from home beginning 5/15 after losing 15 of 1st 20...the Rangers' .357 (11-18) road winning percentage is 4th lowest in the A.L. to TOR at .355 (11-20), BAL at .353 (12-22), and KC at .258 (8-23)...Texas' 28 total road games are 2nd fewest in the Majors (SD-28).

- Texas has both the highest road earned run average (5.31) and opponents batting average (.278) of any MLB team...club has posted a 3.79 ERA (34 ER/80/2 IP) over this 6-3 away stretch to lower its overall road ERA from 6.04.

- On the other hand, the Rangers are 24-12 (.667) at home, 3rd best in the A.L. and 5th best winning percentage in the majors

VERSUS BOSTON: Texas ended a 6-game losing streak to the Red Sox last night, winning for the 1st time since the 2018 opener on 5/3/18 at Arlington...club has lost 12 of 15 to the Carmine Hose beginning 7/6/16 with a pair of 6-game losing streaks...still, the Rangers hold a 42-34 lead in the series since 2009.

- The Rangers also snapped a 7-game losing streak at Fenway Park on Monday, winning for the 1st time since 7/5/16... Texas is 5-13 in BOS since the start of 2013...all-time, the Red Sox hold advantages of 241-228 overall and 142-92 at Fenway Park.

- The Rangers ae 5-2 vs. A.L. East teams in 2019 with Monday being the 1st road contest of the year vs. the East.

IT'S A RELIEF: Jesse Chavez' win on Monday was the 17th by the Texas bullpen in 2019, tying HOU, NYY, AND TB for 2nd most in the A.L., 4 behind LAA...relievers had 24 wins in all of 2018...Texas' relievers have pitched the 3rd most innings in the A.L. at 266.1.

COMING FROM BEHIND: Monday marked the 16th time that Texas has come from behind to win in 2019...prior to last night, the Rangers were 0-25 when trailing after 8.0 innings, 0-16 away from home...it was the club's 1st victory when it trailed entering the 9th inning since 8/24/18 at SF...in that game, Texas was trailing, 6-4 entering the 9th inning en route to a 7-6, 10-inning victory.

- Last night's 4-3 victory gave the Rangers a 12-10 record in one-run games...Texas is tied with HOU for the most victories by one run among A.L. clubs, T3rd in MLB with LAD behind SD (16) and SF (14)...the Rangers' 22 total one-run games are 2nd most in the A.L. to SEA (24) and 5 of the team's last 8 games have been decided by a single tally (3-2).

- The Rangers are 3-3 in extra innings this season, 1-1 away from home and have won the last 3 such games since a 1-0, 12-inning defeat to TOR on 5/3...club's had lost its last 2 extra inning road game since that 10-inning win at SF on 8/24/18.

DANNY SANTANA had hits in each of his last 4 plate appearances on Monday for his 2nd 4-hit game of the season (also 5/16 at KC) and 6th career game with 4+ H...career high is 5 on 8/3/14 at CWS...he is the only Ranger with 2 games of 4+ H in 2019...he is one of 9 A.L. players with multiple 4+ H games in 2019...Santana is 7-for-13 (.538) with 2 2B and 2 3B in his last 3 games to go from .282 to .306, his best since 5/25 (.314)...Santana is batting .339 (38-112) vs. RHP, 4th best in the A.L. among players with 100+ PA.

- Santana had a single and double from both sides of the plate last night...the last Texas switch-hitter with multiple hits from both sides of the plate in the same game was Omar Vizquel, 8/7/09 vs. LAA.

MIKE MINOR issued 2 runs over 8.0 IP on Monday, marking the 5th time in 2019 that he has had no decision when allowing 2 or fewer runs, the 3rd time in his last 4 starts (5/25 at LAA and 6/5 vs. BAL...the 5 such games matches 4 others (MIL's Zach Davies; NYY's Masahiro Tanaka; ATL's Julio Teheran; TOR's Trent Thornton) for most in MLB.

- It was the 9th straight start in which Minor has allowed 3 or fewer runs, tying MLB's 3rd longest current streak (non-openers) and the longest by a Ranger since 10 in a row for Yu Darvish, 4/23-6/12/17.

- Monday marked the 3rd time this season that Minor has pitched at least 8.0 IP, matching LAD's Hyun-Jiu Ryu and HOU's Justin Verlander for the 2nd most in MLB, one behind CHI's Kyle Hendricks.

- He lowered his ERA to 2.52, 5th lowest in the A.L. and he is 3rd with 89.1 IP...his 2.4 pitching WAR matches Lance Lynn for the 5th best mark in the A.L.

SCORELESS SKEIN: Jesse Chavez extended his scoreless streak to a career high 22.2 IP on Monday, the longest active streak in MLB and 2nd longest overall in 2019 to LAD's Hyun-Jiu Ryu (33.0 IP--5/1-25)...Chavez' streak is the longest by a Ranger since Cole Hamels, 24.0 IP from 7/1-20/17...of Chavez' streak, 18.0 IP have been in relief and 3.2 IP have come as the opener in 3 games.

SHORTS: Texas is 11-11 in games started by opposing LH pitchers in 2019, 4-9 on the road...Texas is 2nd in MLB with 69 double plays, 2 fewer than STL...Nomar Mazara's 2-R 1B in 9th inning on Monday was the 2nd GA RBI by Ranger w/ team trailing in 9th-or-later since start of 2017 (also Jose Trevino's walk-off 1B, 6/17/18 vs. COL).

#57 Ariel Jurado, RHP (3-2, 2.78)

TONIGHT: The 23-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his 14th appearance/5th start of the season tonight in the 2nd of 4 games against the Red Sox... has won back-to-back starts and registered quality starts in 3 straight outings...

WIN WIN: Jurado has won back-to-back outings for the 1st time this season, seeking to match his career high with a win tonight (3 straight wins from 9/15-27/18)...

Among A.L. pitchers with 35+ IP, Jurado ranks among leaders in ground ball pct. (3rd, 54.5), GIDP per 9.0 innings (6th, 1.26), and ERA (T12th, 2.78).

LAST START: Earned the win in the Rangers' 4-3 victory on Thurs. vs. BAL (6.0 IP, 8 H, 3 R-ER, 1 BB, 6 SO, 1 HR, 91 pitches/60 strikes)...allowed a solo HR to Trey Mancini...

VS. BOSTON / A.L. EAST: Has never faced the Red Sox...is 2-2 with a 5.82 ERA (11 ER/17.0 IP) in 4 G/3 GS career against A.L. East opponents...

ON THE ROAD: Has gone 1-0 with a 2.35 ERA (4 ER/15.1 IP) in 6 G/1 GS on the road this season...only other road start this season came on 5/26 at LAA (6.1 IP, 2 R-ER)...

WITH TEXAS IN 2019: Is 2-1 with a 3.57 ERA (9 ER/22.2 IP) in 4 starts and 1-1 with a 1.38 ERA (2 ER/13.0 IP) in 9 relief appearances since he was recalled from Nashville on 4/26...

AS STARTER: Has gone 5-5, 4.95 (35 ER/63.2 IP) in 12 ML starts, all but 3 in 2018...in addition to the 12 starts, has made 4 appearances as an "opener" (all in 2018)...

NASHVILLE: Began the year with the Sounds, going 3-0 with a 3.57 ERA (9 ER/22.2 IP) in 4 games/starts, posting a 1.368 WHIP figure with 8.7 strikeouts per 9 innings...

2018: Made his MLB debut in May and spent the final 2 months of the season in the club's rotation, going 5-5, 5.93 (36 ER/54.2 IP) over 2 stints with TEX (5/19 and 7/28-end of season)...

TEAM PITCHING: Staff has a 3.74 ERA (47 ER/113.0 IP) over last 12 games to drop season ERA from 5.10 to 4.84, 9th in A.L....allowed 2 R-or-less in 5 times in that span...team has a 3.86 ERA (102 ER/237.2 IP) last 26 G to drop from 5.52...staff has 219 SO last 22 G beg. 5/19, 2nd-most in MLB in that span (HOU-229), this after ranking last in MLB w/ 320 SO thru 5/18...has 9+ K's in 11 of last 15 G.

STARTERS: Monday was 4th time a starter has worked 8.0+ innings in 2019, 3rd for Mike Minor...it was 3rd time in last 5 G a starter has allowed 2 or fewer runs...rotation has a 3.49 ERA (51 ER/131.2 IP) last 26 G to lower season ERA from 5.97 to 4.93, 9th in A.L....has a 3.99 ERA (89 ER/200.2 IP) last 38 G to drop from 6.52...had streak of 18 straight starts of 3-or-fewer ER allowed (incl. 3 'opener' starts) from 5/15-6/2...Texas is one of 3 A.L. clubs with multiple complete games this season (2-CWS/CLE/TEX)...Rangers have posted QS in 13 of last 18 G in which they used a starting pitcher in standard fashion...starters have completed 6.0+ IP in 14 of last 18 traditional starts.

RELIEVERS: Bullpen has a 3.09 ERA (15 ER/43.2 IP) last 11 G to lower season ERA from 5.05 to 4.73, 11th in A.L...bullpen's 17 wins are T2nd in A.L...bullpen is 15-for-24 in save tries, successful on 8 of last 14 chances but just one of last 3...bullpen has 80 SO in 76.1 IP last 18 G...has allowed the 2nd-most hits (273), 4th-most runs (157), and T4th-most walks (112) in A.L.

53 JESSE CHAVEZ 2-1-0, 3.41 vs. LHB: 12-for-55 (.218) vs. RHB: 24-for-87 (.276)

- Worked a scoreless 10th inning on Monday for 2nd win of 2019...Has a current scoreless streak of career best 22.2 innings over 18 games, longest active streak in MLB and 2nd longest in MLB in 2019 (32--LAD's Hyun-Jin Ryu)...is the longest scoreless streak for a Ranger since Cole Hamels, 24.0 IP, 7/1-20/17.
- Over the 18 G/3 GS (beg. 5/5): 22.2 SHO IP, 13 H, 7 BB, 21 SO, .167 (13-78) opp. avg to lower ERA from 8.79 to season low 3.41...last R allowed (3 R-2 ER) on 4/30 vs. PIT...issued 6 HR in season's 1st 15.1 IP.
- Has 0.74 ERA (2 ER/24.1 IP) last 20 G and 1.95 ERA (7 ER/32.1 IP) last 27 G to drop ERA from 17.18...21 K's last 14 G/18.2 IP.
- Leads team w/ 31 G, T4th in A.L....has 3 scoreless starts as 'opener': 5/11 at HOU (1.0 SHO IP), 5/22 vs. SEA (1.2 SHO IP), 5/28 at SEA (1.0 SHO IP, 3 SO)...season high 2.0 IP 6 times.

46 PETE FAIRBANKS 0-0-0, 0.00 vs. LHB: 0-for-1 (.000) vs. RHB: 0-for-5 (.000)

- Retired 5 of 6 batters faced in ML debut on 6/9 vs. OAK...batter who reach on E was erased on GDP...fanned all 3 batters faced in his 1st inning in the 5th, 1st Ranger to accomplish that in ML debut since Michael Kirkman on 8/21/10 at BAL...Neftali Feliz fanned 1st 4 ML batters on 8/3/09 at OAK.
- Had contract selected from Nashville (AAA) prior to night game on 6/8.
- Had combined to post a 2-0 record with 2 saves and a 2.35 ERA (6 ER/23.0 IP) over 21 relief appearances with the Rangers' top three minor league affiliates in 2019...has an overall 0.870 WHIP figure while averaging 14.1 strikeouts per 9 innings, as opposing batters produced a .179/.225/.226/.451 (15-84) slash line with 5 walks/36 strikeouts and just 4 extra-base hits (all doubles) this season.
- After beginning the year at Down East (A+), Fairbanks was promoted to Frisco (AA) on 5/9 and elevated to Nashville (AAA) on 5/29...has 10 career appearances above the High-A level, and he last pitched with the Sounds on Thursday at Reno (0.1 IP, 2 H, 2 R-ER, 1 BB, 0 SO, 12 pitches/7 strikes).
- Returned to the mound this season after missing all of 2018 following 'Tommy John' ligament replacement surgery on his right elbow on 8/14/17.

- Had 2nd blown save in last 3 tries/appearances on Monday and is 7-for-11 overall in save chances...has allowed 5 H and 2 R-ER in 3.0 IP in his last 3 G with a 4.65 ERA (5 ER/9.2 IP) in 10 games since return from 10-day IL on 5/21 to go from 1.29 to season high 2.66...is 5-for-8 inn save tries in span.
- Has allowed runs in 6 of 24 G overall...4 of 7 runs allowed have been solo HR including 2 leadoff HR.
- Was on 10-day injured list, 5/6-20 and had minor neck surgery on 5/16
- Has stranded all 9 inherited runners in 2019...has 5 BB in 24 G/23.2 IP...save on 4/21 vs. HOU was 1st since 6/4/17 at OAK with WAS.

25 JOSÉ LECLERC 1-2-5, 5.14 vs. LHB: 14-for-44 (.318) vs. RHB: 8-for-60 (.133)

- Has issued 3 R in 2.0 IP in his last 2 G after allowing runs in just 2 of previous 13 G...has a 3.12 ERA (6 ER/17.1 IP) over last 15 G to lower season ERA from 8.44 to 5.14.
- Has K's in 20 straight appearances (38 SO/21.2 IP), longest span of his career (2.0-IP-or-less) - also a club record...has 14.19 SO/9 as reliever, 3rd-best in A.L. (16.06 by BOS' Matt Barnes and 15.12 by TOR's Ken Giles)... tied career high w/ 5 K over 2.0 SHO IP on 5/19 vs. STL.
- Has 2 scoreless starts as 'opener': 5/17 vs. STL and 5/29 at SEA (1.0 IP each).
- Took walk-off blown save/loss on 4/9 at ARI, ending his scoreless innings streak (25.1 IP) and saves streak (14)...Jarrod Dyson pinch walk-off HR marked 1st time in Leclerc's career to allow a game-ending HR...also took blown save 4/30 vs. PIT...is 5-for-7 in save chances in '19.
- Signed 4-year contract extension (2019-22) with club options for 2023 and 2024 on 3/6/19.

59 BRETT MARTIN (L) 0-0-0, 5.85 vs. LHB: 7-for-26 (.269) vs. RHB: 12-for-51 (.235)

- Worked 2.0 perfect innings on Sunday and has allowed one run in 5.0 IP in 2 G since recall from Nashville on 6/4...overall, has issued 1 R-ER in 8.0 IP last 6 G w/ TEX to drop season ERA from 9.00 to 5.85...was also with TEX from 4/19-5/21 with 7.20 ERA (12 ER/15.0 IP) in 14 games.
- Has allowed runs in 6 of 16 G overall in his 1st career ML action...pitched perfect 9th in ML debut on 4/19 vs. HOU.
- Had 0.71 ERA (1 ER/12.2 IP), 4 BB/19 SO, 1.105 WHIP with one save in 10 total appearances at Nashville.
