**WINS AND LOSSES:** The Rangers have won the 1st 2 games of this 4-game series and 7-game roadtrip which also includes 3 contests at CIN...TEX has won 4 of 5, 6 of 8, 9 of 12 and 11 of 15, the latter span beginning 5/28 ...team's .727 win pct. (8-3) in June is 3rd best in MLB to .800 for ATL and HOU (both 8-2)...TEX has a 19-8 (.704) record since 5/15 is 4th-best in MLB in that span, **leading MLB in wins in that span** (see below)...season-high 5-G win streak from 5/19-24 was Rangers' 2nd-longest streak since start of 2018 (7-0 from 6/16-23/18)...current 19-8 run began after a 5-G losing streak from 5/9-14 that matched longest of 2019 (also 0-5 from 4/22-26)...TEX is 24-17 since 4/27.

- At 36-30 (.545), Rangers rank 5th in the A.L./10th in MLB in winning percentage and are a **season best at 6 games above .500** for the 1st time since the end of the 2016 season (95-67)...team has had a winning record for each of last 20 days...this is Texas' best 66-G start since 2016 (41-25), 2nd-best in last 6 seasons (beg. 2014).
- TEX was below .500 for 12 straight days prior to current 19-day stretch above the mark and was a season-low 5-under after loss 5/14 (17-22).

- With Tuesday's victory, the Rangers are now 16-7 in the 2nd game of a series in 2019.

**IN THE STANDINGS:** Texas is in sole possession of 2nd place in the A.L. West for an 11th straight day, 9.0 GB of division-leading HOU on each of last 2 days...TEX currently holds the 2nd Wild Card position, 2.0 GA of CLE...Rangers have been between 7.0 GB and 10.0 GB for 24 straight days.

**ON THE ROAD:** Texas has won 4 consecutive away games since a loss on 5/27 at SEA, its longest road winning streak since 4 straight victories, 7/27-30/18...last longer road streak was 5 victories in a row, 6/18-23/18...club has won 7 of last 10 away from home beginning 5/15 after losing 15 of 1st 20...the Rangers' .400 (12-18) road winning percentage is 4th lowest in the A.L. to BAL at .353 (12-22), TOR at .344 (11-21) and KC at .258 (8-23)...Texas' 30 total road games are T2nd fewest in the Majors with CLE (SD-29).

- Texas has the 2nd highest road earned run average (5.30) and highest opponents batting average (.278) of any MLB team...club has posted a 3.91 ERA (39 ER/89.2 IP) over this 7-3 away stretch to lower its overall road ERA from 6.04.

- On the other hand, the Rangers are 24-12 (.667) at home, 3rd best in the A.L., 5th best winning percentage in majors

**VERSUS BOSTON:** Texas has won consecutive games against the Red Sox for the 1st time since 7/5/17 and 5/3/18 after losing previous 6 and 12 of last 14 contests...the Rangers hold a 43-34 lead in the series since 2009.

- The Rangers have also posted back-to-back wins at Fenway Park for the 1st time since 5/20-21/15...Texas is 6-13 in BOS since the start of 2013...all-time, the Red Sox hold advantages of 241-229 overall and 142-93 at Fenway Park.

- Rangers last series win vs. the Red Sox was 6/24-26/16 at Arlington (2-1), 5/19-21/15 at Fenway Park (2-1).

- The Rangers' 9 runs on Tuesday were the team's most at Fenway Park since a 10-8 victory on 4/8/14.

- The Rangers ae 6-2 vs. A.L. East teams in 2019, 2-0 on the road.

**DAY GAMES:** Texas is 13-9 (.591) in day games, 4th best winning percentage in the A.L...club has won 4 of 5 and 6 of 8...Rangers are 4-5 on the road.

**MANY WALKS/MANY STRIKEOUTS:** Rangers' batters recorded 8 walks and 15 strikeouts on Tuesday...it marks just the 5th time in club history that the offense has posted 8+ BB and 15+ SO in a single game...the last occasion was 7/20/18 vs. CLE (8 BB/15 SO)...the other 3 occasions: 6/6/87 at MIN (8/17); 9/25/92 vs. SEA (8/18); 8/9/17 at NYM (8/15).

- Texas batters have fanned 30 times in the last 2 games with 15 SO in each contest.. it marks just the 3rd time in franchise history w/ 15+ K's by batters in consecutive games (also 4/13-14/18 and 6/26-27/17) and is the 1st time in franchise history team has won back-to-back games w/ 15+ K's from offense.

**HUNTER PENCE** connected for his 1st career inside-the-park home run on Tuesday as part of a 3-run, 2 RBI, 3 walk performance...Pence matched his career best for BB (8th time) while reaching base in 4 of 5 plate appearances.

- Pence produced the 7th game in club history of 3+ R, 3+ BB, 2+ RBI, and a home run...the last was by Rougned Odor, 8/2/18 vs. BAL.

- Pence's 14 HR are his most in a season since 2014 (20 with SF) and he leads the club with 43 RBI after driving in 24 runs all last season with the Giants.

**INSIDE-THE-PARK NOTES:** Pence's blast was the 29th inside-the-park home run in Rangers' history, the 1st since Odor on 7/28/18 at HOU off Justin Verlander...it was the Rangers' 1st ever inside-the-park homer at Fenway Park... at 36 years, 59 days, Pence became the 2nd oldest Ranger to ever hit an inside-the park homer...Jim Sundberg was 37 years, 108 days old when he accomplished the feat on 9/4/88 at TOR.

**ASDRUBAL CABRERA** is 7-for16 (.438) with 7 RBI in his last 3 games and is batting .413 (19-46) over his last 13 games beginning 5/29 to go from .217 to .261, best since 4/4 (.269)...that is the A.L.'s 3rd best average in that span (36 or more PA) to LAA's Cesar Puello at .455 (15-33) and DET's Jacoby Jones at .417 (15-36)...he is 5-for-11 with 10 RBI with the bases loaded in 2019...Cabrera has all 40 of his RBI while playing 3B, 2nd most in the A.L. for a 3B to BOS' Rafael Devers (42).

**MATTER OF QUALITY:** Ariel Jurado's outing on Tuesday marked the 3rd time in the last 4 games and the 5th time in the last 7 contests that a Texas pitcher has posted a quality start...Rangers have quality starts in 14 of their last 19 games in which they used a starting pitcher in standard fashion (non-openers).

- Jurado's effort last night marked his 4th consecutive quality start...today's starter Lance Lynn enters the contest with a string of 6 straight quality starts and is T5th in the A.L. with 9 QS overall...Mike Minor is T10th with 8 QS.

- With Minor's effort on Monday, it marks the 1st time the Rangers have received back-to-back quality starts at Fenway Park since 4/17-18/12 (Colby Lewis and Derek Holland).

**SCORELESS SKEIN:** Jesse Chavez extended his scoreless streak to a career high 22.2 IP on Monday, the longest active streak in MLB and 2nd longest overall in 2019 to LAD's Hyun-Jiu Ryu (33.0 IP--5/1-25)...Chavez' streak is the longest by a Ranger since Cole Hamels, 24.0 IP from 7/1-20/17...of Chavez' streak, 18.0 IP have been in relief and 3.2 IP have come as the opener in 3 games...Chavez was the guest at the Rangers Destinations event this morning at Fenway Park.

**SHORTS:** Rougned Odor has walked in a career high 5 consecutive games, matching the longest streak by a Ranger this season...Chris Woodward received his 1st MLB ejection when he was tossed by Angel Hernandez in the 6th inning last night...it was the 1st ejection of the year for a Ranger.

**TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER**

**#35 Lance Lynn, RHP  
(7-4, 4.39)**

**TODAY:** The 32-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his 14th start of the season this afternoon in the 3rd of 4 games against the Red Sox this week...has gone 5-2 with a 3.27 ERA (19 ER/52.1 IP) over his last 8 starts to drop his season ERA from 6.51 to 4.39...will be working on 4-days rest after a no decision in the Rangers' 5-3 loss to the Athletics on Friday at Globe Life Park...has quality starts in 6 straight, longest streak by a Texas starter since Andrew Cashner (6 G, 7/5-8/13/17)...last longer streak was an 8-gamer by Yu Darvish, 7/22-8/29/16...has 7 BB/49 SO in last 6 G/39.1 IP since season-high 5 walks on 5/4 vs. TOR...ranks T8th in the A.L. with 7 wins...has the 2nd-most innings (80.0) and strikeouts (85) on Texas staff, trailing Mike Minor in both categories...signed a three-year contract as a free agent on 12/18/18...combined to go 10-10, 4.77 in 31 games/29 starts with MIN and NYY in 2018...has posted at least 10 wins in each of his 6 ML seasons beginning 2012 (missed all of 2016 after undergoing "Tommy John" surgery), one of 13 Major League pitchers with at least 6 10-win campaigns in that span...was a rookie in Cardinals' World Championship season of 2011, defeating the Rangers in Game 3 of the World Series in Arlington...was a 1st round pick of STL in 2008 after pitching 3 seasons at the University of Mississippi...Rangers are 8-5 in his 13 starts.

**OF LATE / QUALITY STARTS / STRIKEOUTS:** Enters today with a streak of 6 consecutive quality starts, the longest span by a Ranger in 2019...last longer streak by a Texas start was an 8-game run by Yu Darvish, 7/22-8/29/16.  
• Has gone 5-2 with a 3.27 ERA (19 ER/52.1 IP) in last 8 starts to lower season ERA over 2 full runs from 6.51 to season-low 4.38...Lynn has 6.0+ IP in each of those 8 starts, longest such span by a Texas starter in 2019...only other span that long by a Ranger since start of 2018 was by Cole Hamels (8, 5/5-6/19/18)...last longer streak? 9 straight starts by Colby Lewis, 4/26-5/20/16.

**LAST START:** Settled for a no decision in the Rangers' 5-3 loss to the Athletics on Friday at Globe Life Park (6.0 IP, 6 H, 2 R-ER, 1 BB, 8 SO, 1 HR, 104 pitches/62 strikes)...did not factor into the decision for the 1st time since his 1st start of the season on 3/31 vs. CHC, a span of 11 consecutive outings with a decision...posted a quality start and exited in position to win, but Oakland scored 3 times against the Texas bullpen in the loss.

**VS. BOSTON:** Has gone 2-1 with a 2-1 with 1.91 ERA (7 ER/33.0 IP) over 6 G/5 GS in his career vs. The Red Sox, including 2-0, 1.93 (3 ER/14.0 IP) over 3 G/2 GS last season...Sox slashed just .212/.317/.327/.644 vs. Lynn last season...has also made 4 postseason starts vs. the Carmine Hose, going 0-1 with a 6.75 ERA (6 ER/8.0 IP) over 4 G/1 GS...had a pair of relief appearances vs. the Sox in the ALDS last season (3 ER/2.1 IP)...started Game 4 of the 2013 World Series, taking the loss in a 4-2 Cardinals defeat (5.2 IP, 3 R-ER)...also appeared in relief in Game 6 of that series.

**ON THE ROAD:** Has gone 3-4 with a 3.95 ERA (19 ER/43.1 IP) over 7 road starts this season...has quality starts in 4 straight road outings, going 2-2, 2.67 (8 ER/27.0 IP) over that stretch...allowed season-high 8 R on 4/23 at OAK and has permitted 11 R over 40.0 IP in other 6 road starts...home/road splits are nearly identical as opponents have .742 OPS in Arlington and a .733 figure on the road.

**2019:** Isiah Kiner-Falefa has caught 7 starts (5-2, 4.50) and Jeff Mathis has caught 6 starts (2-2, 4.26)...in 2019, has thrown 100+ pitches in 11 of 13 starts to begin the year, one of just 4 MLB pitchers with 9-or-more 100-pitch starts (13-Trevor Bauer; 12-Max Scherzer, 11-Justin Verlander/Lynn)...105.2 pitches per start ranks 3rd in MLB, 2nd in A.L. (Bauer-112.3/Scherzer-106.7)...his 6.86 run support average ranks 8th in the A.L...has 9 quality starts, 4 ultra quality starts (7.0+ IP, 2-or-less ER)...opponents have batted .256 (22-86) w/ RISP, including 2-for-28 w/ RISP and 2 outs...opponents by plate appearance vs. Lynn: 1st PA (.243, 25-103), 2nd PA (.274, 29-106), 3rd PA (.296, 29-98), 4th PA (1-4)...opponents are slashing .178/.269/.267/.536 vs. Lynn in the 1st inning (13.0 IP) this season... 120 pitches on 5/21 vs. SEA (200th career start) were the most by a Texas starter since Yu Darvish on 4/29/17 vs. LAA (125)...had 10+ K's in back-to-back starts, 5/21 vs. SEA and 5/27 at SEA, 1st such instance by a Ranger since Yu Darvish from 5/9-16/14 and 2nd instance of Lynn's career (also 6/7-13/12).

**ON THE LEADERBOARD:** Most seasons of 10+ wins, 2012-18: 7—Gio Gonzalez, Zack Greinke, Chris Sale, Max Scherzer; 6—R.A. Dickey, J.A. Happ, Clayton Kershaw, Jon Lester, Lance Lynn, Rick Porcello, David Price, Stephen Strasburg, Justin Verlander.

**AMATEUR BACKGROUND:** Pitched 3 seasons at the University of Mississippi at Oxford and ranks on the Rebels' all-time lists in career strikeouts (2nd, 332) and wins (T6th, 22) with 3.95 ERA...graduated from Brownsburg (IN) High School in 2005...was named 2005 Gatorade Indiana High School Player of the Year and a 2005 Louisville Slugger All-American...as a senior, posted a 16-0 record with two
