**WINS AND LOSSES:** The Rangers open a 3-game series at Fenway Park tonight, the 2nd stop on this 10-game, 11-day trip to close the season's 1st half...Texas snapped a 2-game losing streak on Sunday at DET to split the 4-game series with the Tigers...trip and 1st half concludes with 3 games at BAL...Texas has dropped 4 of the last 6 G but has won 13 of the last 20 contests beginning 6/16...in that span, the Rangers are tied with CLE and TB (both 13-7) for the A.L.'s 4th best winning pct. at .650...club is 22-20 beginning 5/22.

- At 40-51 (.440), Rangers rank 11th in A.L. in winning pct...the 40 wins are the fewest for Texas after 91 games since 2014 (38-53) and 2nd fewest in last 11 seasons (beg. 2008).
- Texas has been under the .500 mark since a season best 1-1 on 3/30...Rangers were a season-high 17 games under .500 following loss on 6/15 vs. COL, just 4th season in TEX history to be 17+ under as early as 6/15 (last 2007, club-record 6/3)...club lost a season high 7 straight games from 6/7-15 and directly followed that with a 2018 best 7 consecutive wins from 6/16-23...Rangers became just 5th ML club since 2000 to win at least 7 in a row after dropping previous 7+ straight (last 2014 Red Sox).

**IN THE STANDINGS:** Texas has been a season-high 20.5 GB of division-leading HOU for the last 2 days, losing 4.0 games in the standings over the last 6 days...club has lost 7.0 games in the standings since 6/7 after the team had been between 11.5 and 13.5 GB for 19 straight days from 5/21-6/7...current deficit of 20.5 GB is 3rd-largest in the majors (BAL-37.0 GB and KC-24.5 GB)...club has been in 5th place in the A.L. West for the last 90 days and in either 4th or 5th place for 100 of the 101 days this season (T2nd following win on 3/30).

**ON THE ROAD:** Texas is 21-23 (.476) away from Arlington this season, the 7th best winning percentage in A.L...club has won 7 of last 10 road games and gone 10-8 beginning 5/28...it is the best road record after 44 games since 2016 (24-20)...club is 2-0-1 in last 3 road series.

- The Rangers have a 3.80 ERA on the road, 6th lowest in the A.L. and compared to 5.32 home mark...team has posted a 2.31 ERA (33 R/25 ER/97.1 IP) in the last 11 road games.

**VERSUS BOSTON:** The Rangers lost 3 of 4 to the Red Sox in the season's 1st meeting, 5/3-6 at Arlington, dropping the final 3 games...Texas has lost 9 of 11 meetings to BOS dating back to 7/6/16 after winning 8 of previous 11 in a span from 5/20/15-7/5/16...Texas has a 41-31 advantage in the series since 2009...the Rangers have dropped 4 in a row at Fenway Park since a win on 7/5/16 and are 5-10 here since 2013...in the all-time series, the Red Sox hold leads of 238-227 overall and 139-91 at Fenway Park.

- Texas is 7-9 vs. A.L. East clubs in 2018, 3-3 on the road...this is Texas' 1st series in an A.L. East park since 4/27-29 at TOR (2-1).

**PUTTING UP ZEROES:** Sunday's 3-0 victory at DET was the Rangers' 2nd shutout of the year, 1st since 5/11 at HOU...that total matches CIN and SD for 2nd fewest in the majors, one more than DET and TOR...Texas pitchers have not issued a run in a season best 16.0 consecutive innings since the Tigers scored 7 times in 1st inning on Saturday...it is the club's longest scoreless innings streak since 23.0 IP, 9/21-25/16.

**GEARRIN JOINS CLUB:** RHP Cory Gearrin (#44) is expected to be activated for tonight's game after being acquired from San Francisco on Sunday with RHP Jason Bahr and OF Austin Jackson for a PTBNL or cash...he was 1-1 with one save and a 4.20 ERA (14 ER/30.0 IP) over 35 relief appearances for the Giants this season and has not allowed a run in his last 7 appearances (5.1 IP).

- Bahr will report to High-A Down East and is expected to make his first start for the Wood Ducks on Saturday...Jackson's status is unresolved and he will not report on Monday...Texas will make a 25-man roster move today for Gearrin.

**CLUB RECORD FOR REACHING BASE:** Shin-Soo Choo had an infield single in the 9th inning on Sunday to extend his streak of reaching base via a hit, walk, or HBP to 47 games, a single season club record, one more than Julio Franco (7/28-9/15/93)...the only longer such streak for a Ranger over multiple seasons is 58 games for Will Clark (9/6/95-5/11/96).

- Over the last 12 seasons beginning in 2007, Choo is the 3rd ML player to reach safely in at least 47 consecutive games over one or multiple seasons: 52 G--BAL's Kevin Millar (6/20-8/25/07) and 48 G--CIN's Joey Votto (8/11-10/2/15).
- During the on-base streak which began on 5/13, Choo has batted .339/.464/.600/1.064 (61-180) to place himself among the A.L. season leaders in OBP (4th, .402), OPS (9th, .903), and BA (16th, .293).

**KING OF THE ROAD:** Choo enters tonight's game with an 18-game hitting streak on the road, matching TB's C.J. Cron (4/10-5/17) for the longest in the majors this season...last longer ML streak was 23 games for Eduardo Nunez, 5/10-8/12/17 with SF and BOS...Choo's streak matches the 4th longest single season in club history and is the best since Adrian Beltré's 19-game road hitting streak, 5/8-6/22/13...in this 18-game span away from home, Choo is hitting .356 (26-73) to improve his road average from .232 to .286.

**FIRST TIME ALL-STAR:** On Sunday, Choo was picked to the 2018 A.L. All-Star Team has an MLB selection, his 1st career ASG honor...he becomes just the 3rd native of South Korea to ever be selected as an All-Star, joining LAD's Chan Ho Park in 2001 and ARI's Byung-Hyun Kim in 2002...Choo, who celebrates his 36th birthday on July 13, will be the 2nd oldest 1st-time All-Star in Rangers' history...RHP Charlie Hough was 38 when he was selected for his lone ASG in 1986.

- Two of the 3 active ML hit leaders without an All-Star appearance were selected for the 2018 midsummer classic, Nick Markakis (2165) and Choo (1446)...Denard Span (1451) is now the active hit leader for a non All-Star.

**IN RELIEF:** The Texas bullpen has worked 11.0 consecutive scoreless innings in the last 2 games since Keone Kela allowed a run in the 9th inning on 7/5 at DET (7/6 was CG by Colon)...it is the team's longest relief streak since 13.0 IP, 5/31-6/5...relievers have a 1.72 ERA (6 ER/31.1 IP) in the last 8 games to drop their season mark from 3.72 to 3.52, lowest since 4/18 (3.28)...bullpen has 22 K's/14.2 IP last 3 games.

- Jose Leclerc retired 5 of 6 batters faced on Sunday with a walk and career high 5 strikeouts...opponents are 0-for-22 w/ 0 R/3 BB/12 K's over his last 7 games/7.1 IP beginning 6/20...Leclerc has the lowest opponents OPS (.443) among A.L. relievers and his .1321 opponents batting average is just behind NYY's Aroldis Chapman (.1318) for the league's best.

**KEONE KELA** converted his 22nd consecutive save to start the season on Sunday, a club record and the longest such streak in the majors since 3 pitchers in 2017: Wade Davis (32), Kenley Jansen (24), and Greg Holland (23)...it is also the longest string of consecutive saves for an ML reliever at any point in 2018, one more than Jansen (also current)...Kela has converted his last 24 saves tries overall beginning on 5/21/17, the 3rd-best streak in club history behind: 31-Joe Nathan, 4/15-9/12/12; 25-John Wetteland, 7/25/97-5/20/98...the 24 straight saves is also the longest in the majors since Davis had 38 straight, 9/3/16-9/19/17.

**ADRIÁN BELTRÉ** singled in the 8th inning on Sunday for his 3110th career hit, matching Dave Winfield for 20th place on the all-time hit list, 5 behind Alex Rodriguez.

**SHORTS:** Jurickson Proffar's 1st inning HR on Sunday was his 10 GWRBI, T4th most in the A.L...Joey Gallo's GDP in the 8th inning yesterday ended a string of 380 consecutive AB without a GDP since his last on 9/3/17 vs. LAA...it was just the 4th GDP of his MLB career in 880 at bats...Isiah Kiner-Falefa has thrown out last 3 runners trying to steal.

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER

#36 Mike Minor, LHP (6-4, 4.63)

TONIGHT: The 30-year-old left-hander is scheduled to make his 17th start of the season in tonight's series opener against the Red Sox...has gone 2-0 with a 2.53 ERA (9 ER/32.0 IP) in 5 G/GS since the start of June to lower ERA from 5.76 to 4.63, with opponents batting .195/.246/.336/.582 in that span...has QS in 5 straight after 2 QS in 1st 11 games w/ Texas, longest QS streak since 6 in a row w/ ATL from 8/12-9/8/14...his 6 wins lead the team and his 74 SO rank 2nd on staff (106-Hamels)...will be working on regular 4 days' rest after taking no decision in the Rangers' 5-4 loss in 10 innings on Independence Day, Wednesday vs. HOU (6.0 IP, 4 R-3 ER)...with 91.1 innings pitched this season, has already surpassed innings total from 2017 (77.2) when he worked as a reliever for Kansas City...has permitted 3 HR in last 5 starts (0.84 HR/9), this after 11 HR in 1st 11 starts (1.67 HR/9)...is in his 1st season as a starting pitcher since 2014 (w/ ATL), also his 1st season with the Rangers after signing a 3-year contract on 12/6/17...did not make ML appearance in 2015-16 following surgery for a torn labrum in his left shoulder on 5/13/15...was 38-36, 4.10 in 111 games/110 starts for ATL from 2010-14...from the 2012 All-Star break through 2014 season, ranked 11th in N.L. with a 3.52 ERA (min. 70 starts)...was selected by the Braves as the 7th overall selection in the 2009 June draft out of Vanderbilt University.

ON A ROLL: In last 5 starts beg. 6/9, Minor has gone 2-0 with a 2.53 ERA (9 ER/32.0 IP) and 8 BB/22 SO with opponents slashing .195/.246/.336/.582...his streak of 5 straight quality starts is the longest by a Ranger in 2018...among A.L. pitchers w/ 30.0+ IP since start of June, Minor ranks among leaders in opp. average (3rd, .195) and ERA (7th, 2.53)...Minor's 0.77 WHIP in June was lowest in a single month by a TEX pitcher (min. 90 BF) since Yu Darvish (0.74) in Sept. 2012.

LAST START: Did not factor in the decision in the Rangers' 5-4 loss in 10 innings on Independence Day, Wednesday vs. HOU (6.0 IP, 7 H, 4 R-3 ER, 3 BB, 4 SO, 2 HR, 97 pitches/62 strikes)...staked to a 4-0 lead on home run by Shin-Soo Choo and run-scoring hits by Jurickson Profar and Rougned Odor in the 3rd inning...allowed 3 runs in a 32-pitch 4th inning and exited after 6 innings with game tied 4-4...Evan Gattis' sac fly put Houston ahead 5-4 in the 10th...home run allowed to Josh Reddick in the 4th inning was just 2nd by a LHB off Minor in 2018 (also Mike Moustakas, 5/25 in Arlington).

VS. BOSTON: Tonight marks 2nd start against Red Sox this season...earned the win in series opener between these clubs on 5/3 in Arlington (6.0 IP, 3 R-ER), an 11-5 Rangers victory...Texas tagged David Price for 9 runs in the win, but dropped final 3 games of series...has gone 1-2 with a 3.86 ERA (10 ER/23.1 IP) in 7 G/3 GS career vs. Boston, including 0-2, 4.50 (7 ER/14.0 IP) in 4 G/2 GS here at Fenway Park...Minor went 0-1, 7.71 (2 ER/2.1 IP) in pair of relief outings in this park last season...was the losing pitcher on 7/29/17, when Sandy Leon scored the game winning run on a 10th-inning groundout to give the Red Sox a 9-8 win...Minor last started at Fenway w/ ATL on 5/29/14 (ND, 7.0 IP, 1 R-ER), a 4-3 Braves loss.

ON THE ROAD: Tonight will be just 2nd road start since beginning of June...in 6 G/GS on the road in 2018: 2-2, 6.82 (23 ER/30.1 IP), ERA more than 3 runs higher than mark at home (3.54)...lone QS came in last road start on 6/22 at MIN (6.0 IP, 1 R-ER)...opponents are batting .303/.351/.533/.884 in 6 starts away from Arlington compared to .227/.280/.444/.725 in 10 starts at home...just 4 of his 14 home runs allowed have come on the road.

2018: Texas is 8-8 in his 16 starts...T13th in A.L. w/ 6 hit batters, tying his career high (also 2014)...has allowed 2 HR in last 4 starts, this after permitting at least one HR in 7 straight starts from 5/3-6/9...has still given up 12 HR in his last 11 GS after only allowing just 2 HR in his first 5 GS...batters leading off innings have hit .306 (26-85) with 6 BB and 3 HBP...bottom 3 spots in the lineup are a combined 17-for-101 (.168)...opponents batting .178 (18-101) with 2 outs in an inning...opposing batters w/ RISP are 17-for-77 (.221)...has allowed at least one hit w/ RISP in 5 straight starts (6-for-23 in that span)...opponents by plate appearance vs. Minor: 1st PA (.226, 30-133), 2nd PA (.277, 36-130), 3rd PA (.275, 22-80), 4th PA (0-4)...Chirinos has caught 9 starts (3-2, 5.03), Centeno 3 starts (2-0, 5.29), Pérez 2 starts (0-2, 6.00), Trevino caught start on 6/16 (0-0, 2.57), and Kiner-Falefa (1-0, 0.00) caught start on 6/27...win on 4/7 vs. TOR was 1st victory as a starter since 8/28/14 w/ ATL...HR allowed to Mike Moustakas on 5/25 vs. KC was 1st by a LH batter against Minor since he was with ATL on 7/1/14 vs. NYM (Daniel Murphy in the 5th inning at Turner Field)...took a perfect game into the 7th on 6/27 vs. SD, as game score of 80 (Bill James formula) matched the highest of his career (also w/ ATL on 5/25/13 at NYM)...was 2nd-deepest perfect game effort by a Ranger in '18, as Bartolo Colon retired 1st 21 Astros on 4/15 at HOU.

2017: In his lone season with KC, led staff in relief wins (6), was 2nd in appearances (65) and saves (6) and placed 3rd in holds (17) and games finished (13)...career low 2.55 ERA was 2nd lowest among all KC pitchers...tied for 7th among A.L. relievers in wins and was T11th in strikeouts (88), 2nd most ever for a Roy-

als lefty (Tim Collins, 93 in 2012)...issued just 0.58 home runs per 9.0 innings, 2nd-lowest among A.L. pitchers (min. 70.0 IP), bettered by Rangers' Alex Claudio (0.54 HR/9.0 IP)...held opposition to .204 batting average, including .163 vs. LHB, 7th-lowest mark in A.L. (minimum 90 batters faced)...had a 1.017 WHIP, 10th-lowest in ML (min. 70.0 IP).

TOMORROW'S SCHEDULED STARTER — RHP YOVANI GALLARDO (3-0, 8.17 ERA in 7 games/4 starts w/ CIN/TEX)

The 32-year-old right-hander is slated to make his 8th appearance/5th start of the season tomorrow night in the middle of this 3-game set in Boston...has gone 3-0 with a 5.87 ERA (15 ER/23.0 IP) over 4 starts with the Rangers (Texas is 4-0 in those starts)...will be working on regular 4-days' rest after picking up his 3rd straight victory in a 7-5 win on Thursday at DET (5.1 IP, 8 H, 4 R-3 ER, 1 BB, 2 SO, 1 HR, 92 pitches/58 strikes)...has worked into the 6th inning in all 4 starts...has won 3 straight decisions for the first time since 8/16-27/15...opponents have batted .267/.320/.444/.763 in the 4 starts...has gone 2-3 with a 5.25 ERA (21 ER/36.0 IP) over 7 career starts vs. the Red Sox, including 1-3, 6.12 (17 ER/25.0 IP) in 5 starts at Fenway Park...has gone 2-0 with a 5.91 ERA (7 ER/10.2 IP) in 2 road starts this season and is 8-11 with a 5.64 ERA (81 ER/129.1 IP) over 25 road starts dating to the start of 2016...made his 1st start of 2018 in the Rangers' 13-12 win on 6/17 vs. COL, his 1st start with the Rangers since Game 1 of the 2015 ALDS...had contract purchased from Triple-A Round Rock prior to start on 6/17, where he went 2-1 with a 3.81 ERA (21 ER/49.2 IP) in 10 starts after signing with Texas as a minor league free agent on 4/13...was 2-0 with a 2.50 ERA (5 ER/18.0 IP) over his last 3 starts with the Express...held opponents to a .239/.271/.328/.600 slash line over that stretch...signed with Milwaukee as a free agent on 12/21/17 and was released near the end of spring training on 3/26...signed with Cincinnati on 3/31 and was added to the Reds bullpen...allowed 8 R-ER over 2.1 IP with 6 of the 8 runs coming on 4/6 at PIT...was designated for assignment by Cincinnati on 4/10 and refused a minor league assignment on 4/12 to become a free agent...signed a minor league deal with Texas the following day...was 5-10 with a 5.72 ERA (83 ER/130.2 IP) in 28 games/22 starts with Seattle in 2017...was the Rangers Opening Day starter in 2015, posting the lowest ERA of his career and starting Game 1 of the 2015 ALDS vs. Toronto...has the 2nd-most strikeouts (1544) among natives of Mexico, and also ranks among the all-time Mexican leaders in wins (3rd, 116), starts (3rd, 293), and innings (4th, 1747.2).
