RED SOX NOTES (22-20)

THE RED SOX snapped their season-best 5-game winning streak, suffering their 1st extra-inning loss this season (2-1).

- Are 8-2 in their last 10 games, 11-3 in their last 14, and 16-7 in their last 23.
- With 24 SO, tied the franchise record for the most SO in a game (also 9/15/17 at TB, 15 innings).
- In 29 games beginning 4/12, Red Sox starting pitchers have a 3.16 ERA (56 ER/159.2 IP).
- The Red Sox pitching staff has a 2.83 ERA (52 ER/165.1 IP) in the club's last 18 games beginning 4/24, in which the club is 13-5.
- Have 27 HR in their last 13 games, beginning 4/30...Their current 6-game streak with multiple HR (15 total HR) is their longest since 2016 (6 games, 8/12-17).

CHRIS SALE (7.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 17 SO) struck out a career-high 17 and did not issue a walk...The only other pitcher with 14+ SO and 0 BB in consecutive starts is Dwight Gooden in 1984 (9/12-17).

- Marks the 6th time since 1908 a Red Sox pitcher has struck out 17+ batters in a game (previous: Pedro Martinez, 17 SO on 5/6/00 vs. TB).
- In his last 3 starts, has struck out 41 of his 76 BF (53.9%)...Has issued just 1 BB over those 3 starts, recording 10+ SO in each.
- Has struck out 59 batters in his last 5 starts (33.0 IP), after totaling 14 SO in his first 4 (18.0 IP).
- Retired each of his first 12 batters faced prior to allowing a leadoff 2B in the 5th inning to Mark Reynolds...Struck out 9 of those 12 BF.
- Was his 2nd straight start carrying a no-hitter through 4.0 IP, also carrying a no-hitter into the 6th inning in his last start on 5/8 at BAL.
- Struck out each of his first 6 batters faced...That is tied for the longest streak by a Red Sox pitcher to begin a game in the Expansion Era (1961-present; source: Elias)...Ray Culp also struck out his first 6 BF on 5/11/70 at CAL.

MITCH MORELAND (1-for-2, RBI) tied the score, 4-4, with a pinch-hit RBI single in the 8th inning...Was his 2nd pinch-hit RBI this season (9th inning, 3/29 at SEA).

- Was his 12th game-tying or go-ahead RBI this season, 7 of which have come in the 6th inning or later.

MICHAEL CHAVIS (2-for-5, R, HR, RBI) hit a solo HR to begin the 2nd inning, giving the Red Sox a 1-0 lead.

- His 2nd-inning HR was estimated at 451 feet...Has hit the 5 longest HR by a Red Sox this season: 459 feet on 5/3 at CWS, 451 feet tonight, 441 feet on 4/28 vs. TB, 441 feet on 4/23 vs. DET (G2), 438 feet on 5/4 at CWS.
- Is 1 of 4 Red Sox since 1908 with as many as 7 HR through his first 21 MLB games: George Scott-10 in 1966, Rafael Devers-8 in 2017, Sam Horn-7 in 1987.
- Since debuting, leads the Red Sox with 20 RBI.

J.D. MARTINEZ (2-for-5, R, HR, RBI) hit a solo HR in the 3rd, extending BOS' lead to 2-0...Has 4 HR in his last 6 games following a 15-game drought.

- Has 14 RBI in his last 16 games and 16 RBI in his last 22 games.

RAFAEL DEVERS (1-for-5, 2 R, HR, RBI) hit a solo HR to LF in the 3rd inning, extending the Sox' lead to 3-0...Has 8 RBI in his last 4 games and 19 RBI in his last 17.

- In his last 26 games, is batting .381/.445/.567/1.012 (37-for-97, HBP, 11 BB).

BRANDON WORKMAN (1.0 IP, 2 H, 2 R, 2 SO) retired David Dahl to begin the 7th inning, his 41st consecutive batter retired...Is the longest streak by a Red Sox since at least 1970 (source: Elias)...Chris Iannetta snapped the streak with a 2B in the next AB.

EDUARDO NÚÑEZ (1-for-4, BB, SB) stole 2nd base in the 6th...Has been successful in 4 of his 5 stolen base attempts this season (80.0%).

MATT BARNES (2.0 IP, 5 SO) struck out 5 of his 6 BF in a scoreless 9th and 10th inning...Has struck out 33 of his 66 BF this season (50.0%).

ROCKIES NOTES (20-21)

THE ROCKIES won for the 3rd time in 4 extra-inning games this season, and for 2nd time in extras on the road (also 4/3 at TB).

- Are 4-1 in their last 5 games, 7-4 in their last 11, and 13-7 in their last 20.
- Were held hitless through 4.0 innings and scoreless through 6.0 before a 2-run HR by Nolan Arenado in the 7th and a 2-run HR by Charlie Blackmon in the 8th.
- Have hit 20 HR in 11 games this month...Are 12-6 when hitting multiple HR this season, including 7-1 when doing so on the road.
- Chris Sale had 17 SO in his 7.0 IP, tying Randy Johnson (4/21/02) for the most SO for a starting pitcher against the Rockies in a single game in franchise history.

MARK REYNOLDS (2-for-5, 2B, RBI) drove in the eventual winning run with an RBI single in the 11th inning.

- 👉 Was his 9th career extra-inning go-ahead RBI (previous: 9/11/16 with COL at SD, 10th-inning HR).
- 👉 Also had the Rockies' 1st hit of the game, a ground-rule 2B to lead off the 5th inning.

CHARLIE BLACKMON (1-for-5, R, HR, 2 RBI) hit a 2-run HR to CF in the 8th inning, giving the Rockies a 4-3 lead.

- 👉 Was his 7th career go-ahead HR in the 8th inning or later (previous: 4/19/19 vs. PHI, 12th inning, walk-off HR).
- 👉 Extended his hitting streak to a season-long-tying 11 games (.362/17-47).
- 👉 In 23 games beginning 4/16, is batting .356 (36-for-101) with 9 HR and 22 RBI...Hit safely in 22 of those contests.

NOLAN ARENADO (1-for-4, R, HR, 2 RBI, BB) hit a 2-run HR off Chris Sale in the 7th inning, cutting the Rockies' deficit to 3-2.

- 👉 In 11 games during May, is batting .435 (20-for-46) with 12 runs, 3 2B, 3B, 5 HR, and 14 RBI.
- 👉 Has 8 RBI in his last 4 games, 14 RBI in his last 11, and 22 RBI in his last 19.

KYLE FREELAND (6.0 IP, 5 H, 3 R, 3 BB, 7 SO) tossed 6.0 innings for the 4th time his last 5 starts and allowed 3 ER for the 2nd straight start.

- 👉 Surrendered a season-high 3 HR for the 2nd time in his last 3 starts...Each HR allowed tonight was a solo HR.

TREVOR STORY (1-for-5, 2 R) singled to lead off the 7th inning...Hit safely in 24 of his last 29 games beginning April 11.

- 👉 Reached on a fielder's choice in the 11th inning and scored the eventual winning run on Mark Reynold's RBI single later in the frame.

BRYAN SHAW (1.0 IP) made his team-high 15th scoreless appearance in 20 outings this seasons, tossing a scoreless 7th.
