RED SOX NOTES (34-33)

THE RED SOX have lost 4 of their last 5 games following a 4-game winning streak...Fell to 2-21 when scoring 3 runs or fewer.

- 👉 Scored multiple runs in the 1st inning for the 9th time this season (6-3).
- 👉 Have hit 61 HR in 38 games beginning 4/30...Have homered in 31 of those 38 games.
- 👉 Gave Chris Sale 2 runs of support or fewer for the 10th time in his 14 starts...Sale has received 4+ runs of support twice (8 on 6/5 at KC, 6 on 5/3 at CWS).

CHRIS SALE (7.0 IP, 3 H, R, 0 ER, BB, 10 SO) faced the minimum through 4.0 IP...Retired each of his first 10 batters faced before allowing a 1-out 2B to Danny Santana in the 4th, who was thrown out attempting to steal 3rd base.

- 👉 Leads MLB with 8 starts of 10+ SO...The next closest pitchers are Gerrit Cole (7) and Max Scherzer (4)...Had 10+ SO for the 3rd straight start, 7th time in his last 8 starts, and 8th time in his last 10 starts.
- 👉 In 10 starts beginning 4/23, is 2-3 with a 2.17 ERA and 0.80 WHIP (66.1 IP, 16 ER, 38 H, 15 BB, 106 SO).
- 👉 Extended his scoreless-IP streak to 15.0 before allowing an UER in the 6th...Has not allowed an ER in his last 17.0 IP (since the 6th inning on 5/31 at NYY).

ANDREW BENINTENDI (1-for-5, R, HR, 2 RBI) hit a 2-run HR off Minor as the 2nd batter of the game...Was his 1st HR vs. LHP since 8/10/18 at BAL (Donnie Hart).

- 👉 His HR had an estimated distance of 420 feet, his furthest HR since 5/15/18 vs. OAK (437 feet).

BROCK HOLT (1-for-2, RBI) tied the game, 3-3, with a 2-out, pinch-hit RBI single...In 55 career pinch-hit AB, is batting .313 (15-for-48) with 11 RBI.

- 👉 Is batting .406 with a .457 OBP in 10 games since being reinstated from the IL on 5/27 (13-for-32, 8 R, 2 2B, 6 RBI, 3 BB).

HEATH HEMBREE (1.1 IP, 3 SO) retired all 4 batters faced after entering with 2 outs in the 9th...Has not allowed a run in his last 9 outings (6.2 IP).

- 👉 Beginning 4/25, has allowed only 1 ER (2 runs) over 20 appearances (17.1 IP, 0.52 ERA).

JACKIE BRADLEY JR. (1-for-4, SB) is 20-for-68 (.294) with a 1.040 OPS in 21 games beginning 5/20 (12 R, 7 2B, 5 HR, 11 RBI).

- 👉 Has a .366 OBP in 27 games beginning 5/10 (23-for-87, 4 HBP, 10 BB).

MOOKIE BETTS (1-for-3, R, 2B, 2 BB) walked to begin the 1st for the Sox and scored on Benintendi's HR...Has reached base safely in 42 of his last 47 games (.415 OBP).

BRANDON WORKMAN (1.0 IP) retired all 3 batters faced in the 8th inning...29 of his 32 appearances this season have been scoreless.

J.D. MARTINEZ (2-for-3, BB) reached base in 3 of his 4 plate appearances during his 1st game since 6/6 at KC.

MARCO HERNÁNDEZ (1-for-2, 2B) hit a pinch-hit 2B with 2 outs in the 9th inning, his 3rd 2B since being recalled from Triple-A Pawtucket on 6/8.

RANGERS NOTES (35-30)

THE RANGERS are 5-2 in their last 7 games, 8-3 in their last 11, and 10-4 in their last 14...Won for the 8th time this season when scoring 4 runs or fewer (8-21).

- 👉 Are 6-3 in their last 9 road games after losing 15 of their first 20 this season.

MIKE MINOR (8.0 IP, 4 H, 2 R, 2 BB, 6 SO) held the Red Sox scoreless over his final 7.0 IP following a 2-run 1st inning.

- 👉 Ranks T-3rd in the AL with 6 starts of 7.0+ IP (Verlander-8, Bauer-7, Giolito-6).
- 👉 Has a 2.19 ERA (6 ER/24.2 IP) in his last 4 starts, and a 2.10 ERA (13 ER/55.2 IP) in 9 starts beginning 4/27.
- 👉 Has received just 5 runs of support in his last 4 starts.

ELVIS ANDRUS (2-for-5, R, 2B, RBI) gave the Rangers their decisive 4-3 lead with an RBI single in the 11th inning.

- 👉 Was his 2nd career RBI in the 11th inning or later (also 5/26/12 vs. TOR), and his 1st career go-ahead RBI in the 11th inning or later.
- 👉 Has 34 RBI in 55 games this season after totaling 33 over 97 games in 2018.

NOMAR MAZARA (1-for-5, 2 RBI) hit a 2-run single in the 9th inning, giving the Rangers a 3-2 lead...Has 12 RBI in his last 14 games.

DANNY SANTANA (4-for-5, 2 R, 2 2B, RBI) hit a 2-out RBI single in the 6th inning, cutting the Rangers' deficit to 2-1...Has 3 RBI in his last 5 games.

- 👉 Recorded a season-high 4 hits for the 2nd time (also 5/16 at KC, 4-for-7)...Was his 6th career game with as many as 4 hits.
- 👉 Has an XBH in each of his last 3 games, also tripling in his previous 2 games...Is the 3rd career time Santana has recorded at least 1 XBH in as many as 3 consecutive games (also 3 games from 4/17-20/19, 4 games from 8/22-24/14 with MIN).
- 👉 Is batting .338 (23-for-68) on the road this season, compared to .276 at home.

ROUGNED ODOR (0-for-3, R, BB) walked in the 6th and stole 2nd base, advancing to third on a throwing error by León and scoring on Danny Santana's RBI single.
