RED SOX NOTES (35-34)

THE RED SOX earned their 3rd walk-off win of the season (also 4/11 vs. TOR, 5/15 vs. COL), snapping a 3-game losing streak.

- 👉 Are 5-7 when allowing 2+ runs in the 1st inning, and 16-19 when their opponent scores first.
- 👉 With 2 triples, marked their 1st game with multiple triples since 7/28/18 vs. MIN.

MOOKIE BETTS (0-for-4, RBI) recorded his 4th career walk-off RBI with a bases-loaded BB in the 9th inning (previous: 7/27/18 vs. MIN).

RICK PORCELLO (6.2 IP, 5 H, 2 R, 6 SO) retired 15 consecutive batters faced spanning the final out of the 1st inning to Elvis Andrus' 2B with 2 outs in the 5th.

- 👉 Has issued just 7 BB over 9 starts beginning 5/5 (1.27 BB/9.0 IP, 49.2 IP).
- 👉 The Red Sox have won 8 of Porcello's last 11 starts...Porcello has tossed 6.0+ innings in 9 of his last 10 starts.
- 👉 Is 4-3 with a 3.71 ERA (21 ER/51.0 IP) in 8 home starts this season.

ANDREW BENINTENDI (3-for-4, R, 2 2B, 3B, 2 RBI) doubled in the 1st, hit an RBI triple in the 3rd, and hit an RBI double in the 5th...Marked his 2nd game with a career-best 3 XBH (also 7/4/17 at TEX, 2B, 2 HR)...Leads the Red Sox with 3 triples.

- 👉 Is batting .333 (17-for-51) with RISP this season.
- 👉 Has scored in a career-best 8 consecutive games, tied for the longest streak by a Red Sox this season (also Devers, 5/20-28).
- 👉 Is batting .327/.389/.612 (16-for-49) in 12 games beginning 5/29 (8 R, 6 2B, 3B, 2 HR, 8 RBI, 5 BB).

RAFAEL DEVERS (2-for-4, 2B, RBI) is tied with Bogaerts for the team lead in RBI (43)...Has 10 RBI in his last 9 games and 29 RBI in his last 29.

MATT BARNES (1.0 IP, BB, 2 SO) tossed a scoreless 9th inning...Has struck out 49 of his 115 batters faced this season (42.6%).

JACKIE BRADLEY JR. (1-for-3, R, BB, SB) has a .371 OBP in 28 games beginning 5/10 (24-for-90, 4 HBP, 11 BB).

CHRISTIAN VAZQUEZ (2-for-4, 2B) recorded multiple hits in his 2nd consecutive game, including a ground-rule 2B to begin the 9th inning.

BROCK HOLT (1-for-3, 3B) tripled to CF in the 4th inning...Was his 16th career triple, including the postseason (previous: Game 3 of the 2018 ALDS at NYY).

- 👉 Is batting .359 with a .405 OBP in 12 games since being reinstated from the IL on 5/27 (14-for-39, 8 R, 2 2B, 3B, 6 RBI, 3 BB).

RANGERS NOTES (36-31)

THE RANGERS suffered their 5th walk-off loss of the season (previous: 5/25 at LAA).

- 👉 Are 4-2 in their last 6 games, 6-3 in their last 9, 9-4 in their last 13, and 11-5 in their last 16...Are 19-9 (.679) beginning 5/15.
- 👉 Scored multiple runs in the 1st inning for the 13th time this season (10-3).
- 👉 Snapped a season-best 4-game road winning streak, the club's longest since 7/27-30/18 (also 4 games).

HUNTER PENCE (1-for-4, 2B, 2 RBI) hit a 2-run 2B in the 1st inning, giving the Rangers a 2-0 lead...Leads the Rangers with 45 RBI.

LANCE LYNN (6.0 IP, 6 H, 3 R, BB, 8 SO) tossed his 7th consecutive quality start (3-2, 3.18 ERA, 16 ER/45.1 IP).

- 👉 Lynn's streak of quality starts is the longest by a Ranger since Yu Darvish's 8-start stretch from 7/22-8/19/16.
- 👉 Has issued just 8 BB in 45.1 IP (1.59 BB/9.0 IP) during his last 7 starts.

ELVIS ANDRUS (2-for-3, R, 2B, RBI, SF) tied the score, 3-3, with an RBI sac fly in the 8th inning...Has 4 RBI in his last 7 games.

- 👉 Recorded multiple hits for the 5th time in his last 8 games (.343/12-for-35).
- 👉 Has doubled in 3 consecutive games, his 4th career streak of at least 3 consecutive games with a 2B (previous: 3 games, 4/24-26/13).

NOMAR MAZARA (1-for-3, R, 2B, BB) is batting .314 (22-for-70) over his last 17 games.
