RED SOX NOTES (62-58)

THE RED SOX are 3-3 in their last 6 completed games following a season-long 8-game losing streak from 7/28-8/4.

- Are 6-5 in extra inning this seasons, including 4-2 at home.
- Have homered in 38 of their 42 games since 6/24, hitting 76 HR during that time...Have homered in 17 of their last 18 games.
- Are 53-8 (.869) when leading after 7 innings this season.

CHRISTIAN VÁZQUEZ (1-for-5, R, HR, 2 RBI) homered for the 2nd time in his last 7 games, recording 5 RBI during that time.

- Has set career highs this season in HR (18), RBI (52), hits (100), BB (22), and games played (101).
- His 2-run HR in the 4th tied the score, 3-3...Of his 28 career HR, 14 have either given the Red Sox the lead or tied the score.

JOSH TAYLOR (2.1 IP, 5 SO) struck out a career-high 5 over a career-high 2.1 IP...Was his 3rd outing of 2.0+ IP for BOS: 2.0 IP on 6/18 at MIN, 2.0 IP on 7/7 at DET.

- Was the 2nd outing by a Sox reliever in 2019 in which they did not allow a baserunner over at least 2.1 innings (also Marcus Walden, 2.1 IP on 5/15 vs. COL).
- Was his 4th consecutive scoreless appearance (5.0 IP, beginning 8/6)...Has not allowed a hit his last 15 batters faced beginning with his outing on 8/6 vs. KC.
- In 26 appearances since his recall on 6/14, has a 1.98 ERA (6 ER/27.1 IP) with 38 SO and a .177 opponent AVG (17-for-96).

MARCUS WALDEN (1.0 IP, SO, BB) tossed his 6th consecutive scoreless appearance (6.2 IP, 0 H, 22 BF, 18 AB, 3 BB, 7 SO).

- Has not allowed a hit to his last 30 batters faced dating back to his outing on 7/28 vs. NYY.
- In 14 appearances since the All-Star break, has held opponents to a .048 AVG (2-for-42)...Owns a 1.88 ERA (3 ER/14.1 IP) during that time.

RAFAEL DEVERS (2-for-5, R, 2B) collected multiple hits for the 46th time this season, tied for the 2nd-most in MLB.

- Is tied with Xander Bogaerts for the AL lead with 39 2B, the 2nd-most in MLB...His 66 XBH trail only Mike Trout (67) for the AL lead.
- Ranks 2nd in MLB with 151 hits, trailing only Whit Merrifield (154).
- In 52 games beginning 6/11, is batting .342/.377/.662/1.039 (76-for-222, 49 R, 22 2B, 2 3B, HBP, 12 BB).

ANDREW BENINTENDI (2-for-4, R, BB) is batting .386 (32-for-83) in 20 games beginning 7/22 (14 R, 15 XBH, 18 RBI).

J.D. MARTINEZ (1-for-5) extended his hitting streak to 10 games (.447/17-for-38) and his on-base streak to 20 games (.413 AVG, .478 OBP).

- Martinez's current hitting streak is his 3rd of 10+ games in 2019: 11 games from 4/9-21, 10 games from 3/28-4/6.
- Is 1 of 5 ML players with 3 hitting streak of 10+ games this season: Rafael Devers, DJ LeMahieu, Charlie Blackmon, Nicholas Castellanos.

BRANDON WORKMAN (1.1 IP, H, 2 SO) tossed his 7th consecutive scoreless outing (7.1 IP, 4 H, 0 BB, 9 SO, 26 BF).

- Was his longest scoreless outing since 6/12 vs. TEX (1.1 IP).
- 46 of his 54 appearances this season have been scoreless (85.2%).

SAM TRAVIS (1-for-1, R, BB) has reached safely in each of his last 6 games, scoring in each of those games.

- In 23 games since his recall on 7/16, is batting .298 (17-for-57) with 5 HR, 12 RBI, and a .973 OPS.

ANDREW CASHNER (1.2 IP, 3 H, 5 BB, SO, HBP) matched a season high with 5 BB (also 5/31 with BAL vs. SF, 8/1 with BOS vs. TB).

ANGELS NOTES (58-61)

THE ANGELS have won each of their last 2 games following a season-long 8-game losing streak from 7/31-8/9.

- Are 2-4 in extra innings this season, having also won on 5/29 at OAK in 11 innings.
- Scored in the 1st inning for the 3rd straight game: 1 run today, 3 runs on Saturday, 3 runs on Sunday...Are 39-18 (.684) when scoring first this season.
- Have homered in 18 of their 20 games beginning 7/20, hitting 31 HR during that time.

ANTHONY BEMBOOM (1-for-1, RBI) entered the game in the 8th at catcher and drove in the winning run with a 2-out RBI single in the 10th.

👉 Each of his 2 RBI this season have given his club the decisive lead (also 5/15 with TB at MIA, 2nd inning).

SHOHEI OHTANI (3-for-5, 2 RBI) has multiple RBI in both of his last 2 games (also 2 on Saturday) after not recording 2+ RBI in 25 games since 7/7 at HOU.

👉 Recorded 3+ hits for the 7th time this season (previous: 7/30 vs. DET, 3 hits).

👉 In 63 games beginning 5/28, is batting .309 (67-for-220) with 13 2B, 2 3B, 13 HR, and 38 RBI.

KOLE CALHOUN (1-for-2, 2 R, HR, RBI, HBP, 2 BB) matched a career high with his 26th HR (also 2015), tying the score, 4-4, with a solo HR in the 8th.

👉 Was his 2nd game-tying or go-ahead HR in the 8th inning or later in 2019 (also 6/1 at SEA, 8th inning, 3-run HR to break a 3-3 tie).

👉 The Angels are 18-8 (.692) when Calhoun homers this season.

👉 10 of his last 15 hits have gone for extra bases: 5 2B, 5 HR.

LUIS RENGIFO (2-for-5, 2B) recorded his 17th multi-hit contest of the season (previous: 7/30 vs. DET).

CAM BEDROSIAN (2.1 IP, H, 2 BB, 2 SO) has not allowed a run in 9 of his last 10 appearances (0.77 ERA, 1 ER/11.2 IP).

👉 Set a career-high with 2.1 innings pitched...Was his 8th career outing with 2.0+ scoreless innings (previous: 4/18/17 at HOU, 2.0).

PATRICK SANDOVAL (4.2 IP, 6 H, 4 R, 4 BB, 4 SO) made his first career major league start and 2nd appearance (also 5.0 IP on 8/5 at CIN).
