RED SOX NOTES (76-68)

THE RED SOX have lost each of their last 3 games and 4 of their last 5.

- Were held scoreless for the 5th time in 2019 (previous: 7/21 at BAL) and for the 1st time at Fenway since 9/14/18 vs. NYM.
- In their last 27 games, 119 of the Red Sox' 247 hits (48.2%) have gone for extra bases.
- Hit 33 HR vs. NYY in 2019, their highest single-season total ever vs. NYY (previous: 32 in 2004).

EDUARDO RODRIGUEZ (6.0 IP, 5 H, R, BB, 9 SO) has a 1.11 ERA (4 ER/32.1 IP) in 5 starts since 8/17 and is 9-2 with a 2.44 ERA (22 ER/81.0 IP) in 13 starts since 7/1.

- Threw a career-high-tying 117 pitches (3x, also 8/4/17 vs. CWS & 8/26/17 vs. BAL)...Recorded his most SO (9) since 7/12 vs. LAD (10).
- Made his 30th start...Is the 1st Red Sox pitcher to make at least 30 starts in a season at 26 years old or younger since Jon Lester in 2010 (32).
- Has set career highs this season in games (30), starts (30), wins (17), IP (178.2), and SO (177).
- The Red Sox are 22-8 (.733) in his starts this season.
- Is 8-2 with a 3.12 ERA (30 ER/86.2 IP) in 14 starts at Fenway Park this season.

JACKIE BRADLEY JR. (3-for-3, 2B, BB) recorded at least 3 hits for the 4th time this season (previous: 3-for-4 on 7/25 vs. NYY).

- Is slugging .633 with a 1.017 OPS (2 2B, 3B, 6 HR) in his last 23 games (since 8/9)...Of his 26 hits since 7/20, 15 have gone for extra bases (4 2B, 2 3B, 9 HR).
- In 17 games vs. NYY this season, hit .370/.424/.648 (20-for-54) with 10 R, 4 2B, 3B, 3 HR, and 7 RBI.

MOOKIE BETTS (1-for-5) has reached base safely in each of his last 23 games (.327 AVG, 32-for-98, 1.042 OPS)...Is tied for his longest on-base streak of the season, also reaching safely in 23 straight from 6/29-7/6.

RAFAEL DEVERS (1-for-3, BB) has 180 hits this season...Is 1 of 4 Red Sox ever with 180+ hits in a season at 22 years old or younger, joining Xander Bogaerts (194 in 2015), Ted Williams (193 in 1940, 185 in '39), and Tris Speaker (183 in 1910).

CHRISTIAN VÁZQUEZ (2-for-4) recorded his 34th multi-hit game of the season, the most by a Red Sox catcher since Jason Varitek's 47 in 2004.

- This season, has set career highs in games (123), hits (119), XBH (44), 2B (24), HR (19), RBI (59), and runs scored (57).

YANKEES NOTES (95-50)

THE YANKEES went 14-5 (.737) vs. BOS in 2019, the most wins by any team over the Red Sox since the Tigers went 15-3 (.833) in 1973...Were the Yankees' most wins over the Red Sox since going 15-7 (.682) in 1960.

- Are tied with HOU for the highest winning percentage in MLB this season (.655).
- Have hit 14 HR in their last 6 games and 38 HR in their last 15...Have homered in 19 of their last 21 games, with multiple HR in 10 of their last 14.
- Are 42-28 (.600) on the road this season, having won 7 of their last 8 road games.
- Recorded their 8th shutout of the season...Also held the Red Sox scoreless on 4/16...Was their 1st shutout at Fenway Park since 7/16/17 (G1).
- Are 65-12 (.844) when hitting multiple HR this season.

AUSTIN ROMINE (2-for-2, 3 R, 2B, HR, RBI, 2 BB) gave NYY a 1-0 lead with a HR in the 5th inning...Has homered in each of his last 2 games at Fenway Park (7/28).

- Reached base safely 4 times...The last time he reached base 4+ times in a game was 4/8/18 vs. BAL...Scored 3 R for the 1st time since 8/25/18 vs. BAL (G2).
- In 26 games since the start of July, is batting .345 (30-for-87) with 14 R, 6 2B, 5 HR and 15 RBI.

JAMES PAXTON (6.2 IP, 4 H, 3 BB, 7 SO) has set a career-high with 13 wins this season (went 12-5 in 2017 with SEA)...The Yankees are 9-3 when he goes 6.0+ IP.

- Has won a career-high 8 consecutive starts, tied for the longest single-season streak by a Yankee since Ron Guidry won 11 consecutive starts from 7/21-9/13/79.
- Has allowed 2 ER or fewer in each of his last 4 starts, tied for the longest such streak by a Yankees starting pitcher this season (Tanaka-4).
- Has not allowed a run in consecutive starts for the 2nd time this season (other: 4/16-21)...In on a season-high 14.2-inning scoreless streak.

GIO URSHELA (2-for-4, R, 2B, HR, RBI) has 19 HR in 116 games this season after hitting a combined 8 HR over 167 games in his previous 3 seasons.

👉 Has multiple hits in 10 of his last 20 games and 12 of his last 24....Over his last 24 games, is batting .380 (35-for-92) with 8 2B, 8 HR, and 17 RBI.

GLEYBER TORRES (2-for-4, 2B, RBI, SF) has 84 RBI this season, the most by a Yankee in a season at 22 years old or younger since 1963 (Joe Pepitone-89).

👉 Recorded his 38th multi-hit game of the season, the 2nd most on the club (LeMahieu-55).

AARON JUDGE (2-for-4, 2B, BB) is batting .303 (20-for-66) with 11 R, 3 2B, 8 HR and 13 RBI over his last 16 games since 8/23.

DJ LEMAHIEU (1-for-5, R, RBI) scored his team-leading 100th run of the season...Has scored 100+ R for the 2nd time in his career (104 in 2016 with COL).
