Moving Up

1B Freddie Freeman singled in the third inning last night and now needs four hits to tie Javy Lopez (1,148) for fifth most in Atlanta franchise history (since 1966).

Only Hank Aaron (1,334), Andruw Jones (1,683), Dale Murphy (1,901) and Chipper Jones (2,726) have more hits since the Braves moved to Atlanta.

Freeman's 175 home runs are one shy of tying Brian McCann's total for the seventh most in Atlanta history.

TODAY'S GAME: The Braves and Red Sox continue a three-game series with the fifth game of the Braves' fourth road trip of the year...This is the Braves' first trip to Boston since 2016, when they split a two-game set here...Atlanta is one of two N.L. teams to compile a winning record at Fenway Park since interleague play began in 1997...The Braves are 18-16 (.529) and the Cubs are 5-4 (.556).

A Despite the overall success here, the Braves have lost 16 of 21 games overall with Boston, and nine of their last 12 in Boston.

A LHP Sean Newcomb is set to face the Red Sox for the first time in his career...Today marks his third career start against the American League...Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings against Tampa Bay in his only interleague start this season.

A LHP Drew Pomeranz is set to face the Braves for the first time since June 8, 2016, when he lost a 4-2 as a member of the San Diego Padres.

NEWCOMB: LHP Sean Newcomb, a native of Brockton, Mass., is set to face the Red Sox for the first time in his career.

A Newcomb has won each of his last four starts, and has a career-best five-game winning streak spanning eight starts in total dating to April 8 at Colorado...The left-hander is 4-0 with a 0.36 ERA in his last four turns, and 5-0 with a 1.68 ERA during the winning streak.

A Newcomb is the first Braves lefty to win four consecutive starts since Mike Minor won five straight turns from September 16, 2012 to April 13, 2013.

A Newcomb has not allowed more than four hits or more than one run in any of the four starts...He is just the second Braves pitcher over the last 110 seasons to toss at least 6.0 innings and allow four or fewer hits and no more than one run in four consecutive starts...The other was Hall-of-Famer Tom Glavine, who did so in 2000.

INTERLEAGUE: The Braves dropped to 2-1 against the American League this season after losing last night's series opener, 6-2.

A They went 9-11 against the American League last season and have not finished with a winning record in interleague play since 2013, when they went 11-9...Atlanta's .375 (30-50) interleague winning percentage over the previous four seasons was the third worst in baseball.

A Braves designated hitters have hit 16 home runs in interleague play, tied for the second fewest among N.L. teams...They hit none last season... Jeff Francoeur hit the last homer for the Braves as a DH, going deep on July 27, 2016 at Minnesota... The first three home runs Atlanta designated hitters hit came at Fenway Park in 1997 (Greg Colbrunn), 1999 (Ryan Klesko), and 2001 (Chipper Jones).

MARKAKIS: OF Nick Markakis increased his MLB-leading hit total to 67 with a two-run double last night, and is now hitting .344, the best mark in the National League.

A Last night's performance gave Markakis, who has never been named to a All-Star team, 2,118 hits... Since 1933, the year of the first All-Star game, 150 other players have collected that many hits...All of them, except OF Juan Pierre, made at least one All-Star team.

A Markakis' third-inning double was the 443rd of his career...Since that first All-Star game in 1933, only 84 other players have reached 2100 hits and 440 doubles...All 84 went to at least one All-Star game, while 35 of those players are in the Hall-of-Fame, four are still active, and 11 are still on the ballot and being considered for induction (50 total players, 60%).

TOTAL BASES: 2B Ozzie Albies leads the National League with 120 total bases, and is fourth in all of baseball with his total.

A Only three other National League players have reached triple digits in total bases this season, including two Braves...1B Freddie Freeman is second with 101, while OF Nick Markakis is tied with San Francisco's Brandon Belt at 100.

DAY GAME: The Braves are a major league-best 12-2 (.857) in day games this season...They are averaging 6.93 runs per game (97 total/14 games) in daylight and have hit 25 of their 57 home runs in these games.

A 2B Ozzie Albies has hit a MLB-most nine home runs in day games...He is hitting .362/.389/.870 in these games.

A Today marks the Braves' ninth day game on the road...They have played only four at home.

THE ROTATION: Atlanta starting pitchers have compiled a 20-11 (.645) record this season, the best mark in the N.L. ...The rotation's 3.47 ERA (102 ER/264.2 IP) is the seventh best in the baseball and the sixth best in the N.L.

VS. LEFTIES: The Red Sox scheduled three lefties to start against the Braves this series, and Atlanta is now 9-4 in games started by a lefty opponent this season.

A They are hitting .282 (133-for-472) against lefty starters, the best mark in the N.L., while their .356 on-base percentage is the best in baseball.

A 2B Ozzie Albies is hitting .411 (23-for-56) this season against all left-handers, the fifth-best mark in baseball and the third highest in the N.L.

A 1B Freddie Freeman is hitting .367 (22-for-60) against lefties, the second-highest average in baseball by a left-handed hitter...OF Nick Markakis is third with a .358 (24-for-67) mark...Only Pittsburgh's Corey Dickerson, who is hitting .378, is better.

Today's Game

- A* Set for his 10th start of the season and the 29th of his career.
- A* Has never faced the Red Sox...Is a native of Brockton, Mass. and resides in Randolph...Attended Middleboro High School in Middleboro, Mass.
- A* Is 1-1 with a 6.75 ERA (7 ER/9.1 IP) in two career Interleague starts... Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings against Tampa Bay, 5/8, in his only Interleague start this season.
- A* Over his last four starts, has allowed nine hits and one run over 25.0 combined innings...Walked 10 and struck out 24.
- A* Newcomb has not allowed more than four hits or more than one run in any of the four starts...Is just the second Braves pitcher since 1908 to toss at least 6.0 innings and allow four or fewer hits and no more than one run in four consecutive starts...The other was Hall-of-Famer Tom Glavine, who did so in 2000.
- A* Has won each of his last four starts, and has a career-best five-game winning streak spanning eight starts in total dating to 4/8 at COL...Is 4-0 with a 0.36 ERA in his last four turns, and 5-0 with a 1.68 ERA during the winning streak.
- A* Is the first Braves pitcher to win four consecutive starts since Julio Teheran last season (August 25 to September 12), and the first left-handed starter to do so since Mike Minor won five straight turns from September 16, 2012 to April 13, 2013.
- A* Opponents are hitting just .191 against him on the season...Lefties are batting .148 in 34 plate appearances, while righties are hitting .199 in 180 plate appearances.
- A* His .191 opponents' average ranks eighth in the majors.
- A* Is one of nine starting pitchers in the majors to face at least 30 batters from both sides of the plate and hold each side to an average under .200...Houston (Justin Verlander and Gerrit Cole) is the only team with two such starters.

2018 Recap

- A* Faced Miami for the second consecutive turn and allowed four hits and one run over 6.0 innings to earn his fourth consecutive win.
- A* A run-scoring groundout by Bryan Holaday scored Justin Bour with one out in the second inning to snap Newcomb's scoreless streak at 21 consecutive innings...The run was the longest of his career...Newcomb's run was the longest by a Braves pitcher since Julio Teheran in 2016 (23.0 IP), and the longest by a left-handed starter for Atlanta since Paul Maholm in 2013 (25.1 IP)
- A* Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings and allowed a career-low one hit, 5/13 at MIA...The start was his third consecutive scoreless turn.
- A* Became the first Braves pitcher over the last 110 seasons to allow two hits or fewer and no runs in three consecutive starts.
- A* Allowed two hits and three walks over 6.0 scoreless innings, 5/8 at TB...Turned in consecutive scoreless starts for the first time in his career.
- A* Tampa Bay logged just two hits, both of which were singles...Newcomb became the first Braves starter since Greg Maddux (6/27 and 7/2/99) to log consecutive scoreless starts of at least 6.0 innings with two or fewer hits allowed.
- A* Tossed a career-most 7.0 innings, 5/2 at NYM, and held the Mets to just two hits and one walk while fanning eight...The outing was his second scoreless start of at least 6.0 innings in his last five appearances after entering the season with just one such start in his career.
- A* Went 6.0 innings, 4/26 at CIN, and held the Reds to five hits and four runs while striking out seven...All four runs he allowed came in the fifth inning, including three on a home run by Joey Votto.
- A* Earned his first win of the season, 4/8 at COL, after allowing just five hits in 6.0+ scoreless innings...Did not walk a batter for the first time in his career...Pitched into the seventh for the third time in his career after facing two batters to open the inning.
- A* Walked at least one batter in each of his first 20 career games...Since the Braves moved to Atlanta in 1966, only two other pitchers opened their careers with longer streaks of walking at least one batter - Pete Smith (29 games) and Tom Glavine (27 games).
- A* Went 4.1 innings in his season debut, 4/2 vs. WSH...Allowed five hits, six runs (five earned) and four walks to take the loss...Struck out six.
- A* Failed to complete 6.0 innings for the eighth consecutive start, dating to 8/20 of last season...Over that stretch went 3-3 with a 4.73 ERA (21 ER/40.0 IP) and 24 walks.

- A* Selected by the Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim in the first round (15th overall) of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft.
- A* Acquired by the Atlanta Braves along with SS Erick Aybar, RHP Chris Ellis and cash considerations, from the Los Angeles of Anaheim in exchange for SS Andrelton Simmons and C Jose Briceno on 11/12/15.

Jesse Biddle • LHP • 6-5 • 220 • 26 yrs • #63

Saves/Opp: 0/0 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 13/9 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 4/3

- Right-handed batters have just four hits in 35 at-bats (.114) against him...Lefties are hitting .500/.550/.778 with nine hits, two walks, two doubles, a home run and five RBI.
- Allowed the first two runs of his major league career, 5/4 vs. SF...Surrendered a two-run home run to Brandon Crawford in the top of the seventh.
- Went 2.0 innings and fanned a career-most five batters, 4/29 at PHI...Became the first Atlanta reliever to strike out at least five batters in 2.0 or fewer innings since Dario Álvarez did so on 6/15/16...Just four Atlanta relievers have had an outing of five strikeouts in 2.0 or fewer innings since 2000.
- Made his major league debut, 4/21 vs. NYM, and tossed 1.0 scoreless inning...Earned the win when Atlanta walked off in the bottom of the ninth...Became the first Atlanta reliever to earn the win in his debut since Jed Bradley on 9/3/16 at PHI.

Shane Carle • RHP • 6-4 • 210 • 26 yrs • #51

Saves/Opp: 0/1 **Holds:** 8 **1st Batter/Retired:** 22/14 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 12/3

- Has allowed runs in consecutive outings, 5/21 and 5/23 at PHI...Prior to these two games, went 14 consecutive outings without allowing an earned run (15.1 innings).
- Holding batters to a .163 (8-for-49) average with men on base and has allowed just three hits (3-for-30, .100) with runners in scoring position...Batters are hitting .263 (15-for-57) with no one on base.
- Converted his eighth hold of the season, 5/19 vs. MIA...Eight holds are tied for the club lead (D.Winkler)...No rookie has led the Atlanta staff in holds since Jonny Venters in 2010 (24).
- Holding right-handed batters to a .213 (13-for-61) average...Lefties are hitting .222 (10-for-45).
- Tallied his first career win, 4/3 vs. WSH.

Sam Freeman • LHP • 5-11 • 180 • 30 yrs • #39

Saves/Opp: 0/0 **Holds:** 5 **1st Batter/Retired:** 25/19 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 19/3

- Left-handed batters are hitting just 1-for-26 (.038) against him this season.
- Snapped a 10-game scoreless streak in his last appearance, allowing a run in 1.0 inning, 5/23 at PHI...His scoreless streak stretched to 4/26 and totaled 9.1 innings.
- Ranked tied for 13th in the majors with 25 appearances this season...Made a career-most 58 appearances last year.
- Tossed 1.1 scoreless innings to earn his first win of the season, 4/26 at CIN.
- Inherited the bases loaded, 4/19 vs. NYM, and allowed a sacrifice fly before stranding the remaining two runners...Has inherited 19 runners on the season, and has stranded 16 (84%)...Inherited just 19 runners last season.
- Took the loss, 4/23 at CIN...The loss snapped a streak of 190 consecutive games without a loss, the longest such active streak in the majors at the time...Freeman's run, which was the second-longest in MLB history, dated to 10/3/12...Only Trevor Miller (240 games, 2006-09) had a longer streak in MLB history.

A.J. Minter • LHP • 6-0 • 215 • 24 yrs • #33

Saves/Opp: 2/2 **Holds:** 7 **1st Batter/Retired:** 22/15 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 7/2

- Logged his second save of the season, 5/14 at CHI...Two saves lead all rookie relievers in the majors...Is a perfect 7-for-7 in hold chances and has converted his only two save opportunities.
- Has earned the win in three of his last five appearances after picking up a victory, 5/20 vs. MIA...Three wins are tied for third in the majors among relievers.
- Inherited the bases loaded, 5/9 at TB, and allowed two runs to score...The runs were the first inherited runners he has allowed to score in his career...Has stranded five of seven runners this season and nine of 11 in his career.
- Earned the first save of his major league career with a scoreless ninth inning, 4/25 at CIN...Became the first left-handed pitcher to record a save for Atlanta since Jonny Venters logged five in 2011.
- Allowed a career high-tying three hits and two runs, 4/24 at CIN...Had surrendered just four hits total entering play...Had not allowed three hits or two runs since 8/27/17 vs. COL, his second career appearance.
- Appeared on consecutive dates four times this season...His back-to-back outings on 4/3 and 4/4 vs. WSH marked the first time doing so in his career...Did so just once in the minors (7/23 and 7/24/17 with GWN)...Underwent "Tommy John" surgery in 2015.

Peter Moylan • RHP • 6-3 • 220 • 39 yrs • #30

Saves/Opp: 0/0 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 22/12 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 11/5

- Tossed his fourth consecutive hitless outing in his last game, 5/23 at PHI, retiring all three batters he faced...Marked his first clean appearance of at least 1.0 inning this season...Allowed at least one baserunner in 18 of his 22 outings this season.
- Overall, opponents have 20 hits and 13 walks over 16.1 innings of work (2.02 WHIP).
- Worked a season-most 1.1 inning, 4/29 at CIN, and has 10 outings of at least 1.0 full inning this season...Made 79 appearances with Kansas City last season, but just 34 of those games went 1.0 full frame...His 79 total appearances led the majors, but his 34 relief outings of at least 1.0 inning ranked tied for 142nd.
- Has appeared in 199 games without a loss, the longest such active streak in the majors...Moylan's run, which is the second longest in MLB history, dates to 9/9/11...Only Trevor Miller (240 games, 2006-09) had a longer streak.

Lucas Sims • RHP • 6-2 • 230 • 23 yrs • #50

Saves/Opp: 0/0 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 3/0 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 1/1

- Recalled to Atlanta from Triple-A Gwinnett, 5/20, for his third stint on the roster...Also up from 4/15-4/19 and on 5/5 (recalled pregame, optioned postgame).
- Allowed three hits and two runs over 2.0 innings of relief, 5/20 vs. MIA...In three appearances with the Braves this season, has a 10.50 ERA (7 ER/6.0 IP) with two home runs...All three first batters he has faced have reached.
- In five starts with the Stripers this season, is 2-2 with a 1.50 ERA (4 ER/24.0 IP) and 25 strikeouts...Allowed four runs (one earned) over 5.0 innings in his last appearance, 5.16 at Columbus.
- Made his major league debut last season, 8/1 vs. LAD, after beginning the season in Triple-A Gwinnett's rotation...Finished the season in the Braves rotation after also working in relief for Atlanta.

Arodys Vizcaíno • RHP • 6-0 • 245 • 27 yrs • #38

Saves/Opp: 9/11 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 22/18 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 2/2

- Converted his ninth save of the season with 1.0 scoreless inning, 5/22 at PHI...Since assuming the primary closer role for Atlanta on 7/30/17, has converted 21-of-24 (88%) save opportunities.
