### Moving Up

1B Freddie Freeman singled twice yesterday and now needs two hits to tie Javy Lopez (1,148) for fifth most in Atlanta franchise history (since 1966).

Only Hank Aaron (1,334), Andruw Jones (1,683), Dale Murphy (1,901) and Chipper Jones (2,726) have more hits since the Braves moved to Atlanta.

Freeman's 175 home runs are one shy of tying Brian McCann's total for the seventh most in Atlanta history.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Braves and Red Sox finish a three-game series with the sixth and final game of the Braves' fourth road trip of the year...This is the Braves' first trip to Boston since 2016, when they split a two-game set here...Atlanta is one of two N.L. teams to compile a winning record at Fenway Park since interleague play began in 1997...The Braves are 18-17 (.514) and the Cubs are 5-4 (.556).

*A* Despite the overall success here, the Braves have lost 17 of 22 games overall with the Red Sox, and 10 of their last 13 in Boston.

*A* RHP Mike Foltynewicz is set to make his first start against the Red Sox...He threw 3.1 innings against Boston over two relief outings with Houston in 2014.

*A* LHP Chris Sale allowed a career high-tying eight earned runs to take a 11-8 loss in his only career start against the Braves on July 8, 2016.

*A* The Braves are trying to avoid their first three-game sweep by Boston since June 16-18, 2006...The Braves have been swept once this season, May 4-6 vs. San Francisco.

**HITS:** OF Nick Markakis is tied for the major league-lead with 69 hits, while 1B Freddie Freeman ranks third in the National League with 62 hits...Both players finished with a two-hit effort in yesterday's 8-6 loss at Boston, the Braves' 50th game of the season.

*A* Freeman and Markakis became just the fifth pair of Atlanta teammates to collect more than 60 hits in the first 50 games of a season...The last pair to do so Rafael Furcal (69) and Gary Sheffield (62) in 2003.

*A* The other pairs were Marquis Grissom (65) and Fred McGriff (65) in 1996, Felix Milan (61) and Ralph Garr (76) in 1971, and Rico Carty (75) and Milan (62) in 1970.

*A* The last time three Braves teammates each had more than 60 hits through 50 games was 1961, when Hank Aaron (67), Frank Bolling (62), and Eddie Mathews (63) all did it...2B Ozzie Albies has 59 hits entering play today.

**EXTRA-BASE HITS:** 2B Ozzie Albies leads the N.L. with 31 extra-base hits and he is one five Braves players over the last 110 seasons with more than 30 extra-base hits in the first 50 games of a season...The only player on that list since the Braves moved to Atlanta in 1966 is Hank Aaron, who had 32 in 1969...Aaron also had 38 extra-base hits through 50 games in 1959.

*A* The other three players all had 31 through 50 games: Rogers Hornsby in 1928, Red Worthington in 1932 and Eddie Mathews in 1953.

*A* The modern-era franchise record for extra-base hits in a season is 92 by Hank Aaron in 1959...Albies is on pace for 100.

**FRAMING:** According to MLB's StatCast, Tyler Flowers has gotten a called strike on a MLB-most 7.9% pitches out of the strike zone over the last two seasons...The next closest qualifying catcher is Martin Maldonado at 6.6%... Since StatCast began tracking pitches in 2015, no catcher other than Flowers has had a full season mark over 7.8%.

*A* Flowers has gotten a called strike on 67 pitches out of the zone this season...He has received 917 total pitches (7.3%).

**INTERLEAGUE:** The Braves dropped to 2-2 against the American League this season after losing the first two games of this series.

*A* They went 9-11 against the American League last season and have not finished with a winning record in interleague play since 2013, when they went 11-9...Atlanta's .375 (30-50) interleague winning percentage over the previous four seasons was the third worst in baseball.

*A* Braves designated hitters have hit 16 home runs in interleague play, tied for the second fewest among N.L. teams...They hit none last season...Jeff Francoeur hit the last homer for the Braves as a DH, going deep on July 27, 2016 at Minnesota...The first three home runs Atlanta designated hitters hit came at Fenway Park in 1997 (Greg Colbrunn), 1999 (Ryan Klesko), and 2001 (Chipper Jones).

**DAY GAME:** The Braves are 12-3 in day games this season after yesterday's loss...They are averaging 6.87 runs per game (103 total/15 games) in daylight and have hit 27 of their 59 home runs in these games.

*A* 2B Ozzie Albies has hit a MLB-most nine home runs in day games...He is hitting .342/.377/.822 in these games.

*A* Today marks the Braves' 10th day game on the road...They have played only four at home.

**TWO-OUT RUNS:** The Braves scored three more times with two outs yesterday, giving them a MLB-most 122 such runs this season...Only three other teams are in triple digits: Boston (108), Milwaukee (106) and Oakland (105).

*A* The Braves also lead the majors with a .299 two-out batting average and .384 on-base percentage.

**SCHEDULE:** The Braves are in the midst of a 14-game stretch playing teams above .500...They have started the span 1-4.

*A* Despite the recent struggles, the Braves are 20-14 (.588) this season against teams over .500, the second-best record in the National League...Only the Washington Nationals have a better mark.

*A* The Braves have only played 16 games against teams under .500...That total is tied for the fifth fewest in the majors and the fourth fewest in the National League.

#### Today's Game

- A* Set to make his 11th start of the season and the 76th of his career...Is his 96th career appearance.
- A* Has made two career appearances against Boston, pitching to a 2.70 ERA (1 ER/3.1 IP) in a pair of relief outings at Fenway Park.
  - A* Has never faced the Red Sox in Interleague Play...Both appearances came in August of 2014 while with the Astros...They were the fifth and sixth games of his career.
  - A* Is 5-3 with a 4.48 ERA (30 ER/60.1 IP) in 11 career Interleague games (nine starts)...Has not pitched against an American League club this season, and went 2-1 with a 4.58 ERA in three starts last year.
- A* Took the loss in his last start, 5/21 at PHI, despite allowing just one run, earned, over 6.0 innings...Has allowed two earned runs or less in nine of his 10 starts this season, but is just 3-3.
  - A* Foltyniewicz has made six starts this season in which he allowed two earned runs or fewer and did not get the win, tied for the most such starts in the National League...LAD's Alex Wood also has six.
  - A* Has received just one combined run of support over his last two starts, and has received fewer than two runs of support in five of his 10 starts this season.
- A* Makes his sixth start away from his home ballpark...Is 2-2 with a 2.03 ERA in five starts away from SunTrust Park this season.
  - A* His 2.03 ERA on the road is second lowest in the National League and trails just NYM's Jacob deGrom (1.65 ERA).

#### 2018 Recap

- A* Was saddled with the loss in his last start, 5/21 at PHI, despite allowing one run over 6.0 innings of work...The start was his fourth against Philadelphia this season and the fourth time in which he faced Phillies starter RHP Nick Pivetta.
  - A* According to the Elias Sports Bureau, the last time two pitchers faced off for a fourth time in a team's 46th game or earlier was on 5/31/59, when Lew Burdette faced Robin Roberts in the Braves' 44th game and the Phillies' 45th game.
- A* Went 5.0 innings and allowed three hits and one unearned run, 5/15 vs. CHI...Walked a season-most five, and struck out a season-most 10.
  - A* Was the fourth double-digit strikeout game of his career...Since he joined Atlanta in 2015, his four 10+ strikeout games are most on the pitching staff.
- A* Earned his third win of the season, 5/10 at MIA, after tossing 5.0 innings and allowing just three hits and one unearned run.
  - A* Received eight runs of support, his most on the season and his most since also getting eight runs on 6/7/17...Entered his start against Miami averaging just 2.83 runs of support per 9.0 innings over his last 14 turns, fewest in the N.L.
- A* Allowed a season-most nine hits and six runs over 5.0 innings, 5/4 vs. SE...All six runs he allowed came in the second inning.
  - A* The outing snapped a 10-start stretch in which he allowed three earned runs or fewer, the longest such stretch of his career...Went 2-5 with a 3.04 ERA during the run, which started 8/27/17...Was one of just five starters in the majors to have as long a streak of three earned runs or fewer in that span, and was the only one with a losing record -- the other four pitchers went a combined 40-5.
- A* Went 6.0 innings and allowed three hits and one run to earn his second win of the season, 4/28 at PHI...Struck out six.
  - A* Threw just 91 pitches, his fewest of the season...Went as deep in a game on as few pitches for the first time since completing 6.0 innings in just 82 pitches on 4/30/17 at MIL...Entered play averaging an MLB-most 19.2 pitches per inning.
- A* Held the Nationals to four hits and one run over 5.1 innings, 4/4 at SunTrust Park...Walked two and fanned eight to earn his first win of the season and snap a career-worst seven-game losing streak.
  - A* Went 0-7 with a 7.34 ERA (31 ER/38.0 IP) over the spell, the longest losing streak of his career and tied for the second longest active streak in the majors at the time...The run dated to 8/11/17 at STL and spanned eight total starts.
- A* Took a no-decision in his season debut, 3/30 vs. PHI...Allowed five hits and three runs over 5.0 innings, striking out seven.
  - A* The no-decision snapped of streak of seven consecutive losses after he dropped each of his final seven starts of 2017...His skid in consecutive starts was one short of the franchise record, set by Preston Hanna from 1976-1978 and matched by Shelby Miller in 2015.

#### Career Recap

- A* Was diagnosed with costochondritis on 9/2/15 and sidelined for the remainder of the season...Underwent surgery on 9/21/15, to remove the anterior half of his first rib...The procedure was performed by Dr. William Mayfield at Wellstar Kennestone Hospital in Marietta, Ga.
- A* Acquired by the Atlanta Braves along with RHP Andrew Thurman and INF Rio Ruiz from the Houston Astros in exchange for C/OF Evan Gattis and RHP James Hoyt on 1/14/15.

## Braves Bullpen Briefs

**Jesse Biddle • LHP • 6-5 • 220 • 26 yrs • #63**

**Saves/Opp: 0/0 Holds: 0 1st Batter/Retired: 14/9 Inherited Runners/Scored: 4/3**

- Right-handed batters have just four hits in 37 at-bats (.108) against him...Lefties are hitting .500/.545/.900 with 10 hits, two walks, two doubles, two home runs and six RBI.
- Allowed the first two runs of his major league career, 5/4 vs. SF...Surrendered a two-run home run to Brandon Crawford in the top of the seventh.
- Went 2.0 innings and fanned a career-most five batters, 4/29 at PHI...Became the first Atlanta reliever to strike out at least five batters in 2.0 or fewer innings since Dario Álvarez did so on 6/15/16...Just four Atlanta relievers have had an outing of five strikeouts in 2.0 or fewer innings since 2000.
- Made his major league debut, 4/21 vs. NYM, and tossed 1.0 scoreless inning...Earned the win when Atlanta walked off in the bottom of the ninth...Became the first Atlanta reliever to earn the win in his debut since Jed Bradley on 9/3/16 at PHI.

**Shane Carle • RHP • 6-4 • 210 • 26 yrs • #51**

**Saves/Opp: 0/1 Holds: 8 1st Batter/Retired: 22/14 Inherited Runners/Scored: 12/3**

- Has allowed runs in consecutive outings, 5/21 and 5/23 at PHI...Prior to these two games, went 14 consecutive outings without allowing an earned run (15.1 innings).
- Holding batters to a .163 (8-for-49) average with men on base and has allowed just three hits (3-for-30, .100) with runners in scoring position...Batters are hitting .263 (15-for-57) with no one on base.
- Converted his eighth hold of the season, 5/19 vs. MIA...Eight holds are tied for the club lead (D.Winkler)...No rookie has led the Atlanta staff in holds since Jonny Venters in 2010 (24).
- Holding right-handed batters to a .213 (13-for-61) average...Lefties are hitting .222 (10-for-45).
- Tallied his first career win, 4/3 vs. WSH.

**Sam Freeman • LHP • 5-11 • 180 • 30 yrs • #39**

**Saves/Opp: 0/0 Holds: 5 1st Batter/Retired: 26/19 Inherited Runners/Scored: 20/4**

- Left-handed batters are hitting just 2-for-27 (.074) against him this season.
- Allowed runs in each of his last two appearances...Prior to this stretch, had totaled 9.1 consecutive scoreless innings dating to 9/26.
- Ranked tied for eighth in the majors with 26 appearances this season...Made a career-most 58 appearances last year.
- Tossed 1.1 scoreless innings to earn his first win of the season, 4/26 at CIN.
- Inherited the bases loaded, 4/19 vs. NYM, and allowed a sacrifice fly before stranding the remaining two runners...Has inherited 20 runners on the season, and has stranded 16 (80%)...Inherited just 19 runners last season.
- Took the loss, 4/23 at CIN...The loss snapped a streak of 190 consecutive games without a loss, the longest such active streak in the majors at the time...Freeman's run, which was the second-longest in MLB history, dated to 10/3/12...Only Trevor Miller (240 games, 2006-09) had a longer streak in MLB history.

**A.J. Minter • LHP • 6-0 • 215 • 24 yrs • #33**

**Saves/Opp: 2/2 Holds: 7 1st Batter/Retired: 22/15 Inherited Runners/Scored: 7/2**

- Logged his second save of the season, 5/14 at CHI...Two saves lead all rookie relievers in the majors...Is a perfect 7-for-7 in hold chances and has converted his only two save opportunities.
- Has earned the win in three of his last five appearances after picking up a victory, 5/20 vs. MIA...Three wins are tied for fifth in the majors among relievers.
- Inherited the bases loaded, 5/9 at TB, and allowed two runs to score...The runs were the first inherited runners he has allowed to score in his career...Has stranded five of seven runners this season and nine of 11 in his career.
- Earned the first save of his major league career with a scoreless ninth inning, 4/25 at CIN...Became the first left-handed pitcher to record a save for Atlanta since Jonny Venters logged five in 2011.
- Allowed a career high-tying three hits and two runs, 4/24 at CIN...Had surrendered just four hits total entering play...Had not allowed three hits or two runs since 8/27/17 vs. COL, his second career appearance.
- Appeared on consecutive dates four times this season...His back-to-back outings on 4/3 and 4/4 vs. WSH marked the first time doing so in his career...Did so just once in the minors (7/23 and 7/24/17 with GWN)...Underwent "Tommy John" surgery in 2015.

**Peter Moylan • RHP • 6-3 • 220 • 39 yrs • #30**

**Saves/Opp: 0/0 Holds: 0 1st Batter/Retired: 23/13 Inherited Runners/Scored: 11/5**

- Tossed 1.0 clean inning, 5/23 at PHI, retiring all three batters he faced...Marked his first clean appearance of at least 1.0 inning this season...Allowed at least one baserunner in 19 of his 23 outings this season.
- Overall, opponents have 21 hits and 13 walks over 17.2 innings of work (1.92 WHIP).
- Worked a season-most 1.1 inning, 4/29 at CIN, and has 12 outings of at least 1.0 full inning this season...Made 79 appearances with Kansas City last season, but just 34 of those games went 1.0 full frame...His 79 total appearances led the majors, but his 34 relief outings of at least 1.0 inning ranked tied for 142nd.
- Has appeared in 199 games without a loss, the longest such active streak in the majors...Moylan's run, which is the second longest in MLB history, dates to 9/9/11...Only Trevor Miller (240 games, 2006-09) has had a longer streak.
