Since June 11, **Ryon Healy** has hit safely in 8 of his last 10 games, batting .382 (13x34) with 6 runs, 1 double, 4 home runs, 7 RBI, 1 HBP, 1 walk, a .432 on-base percentage and a .765 slugging mark (1.197 OPS).

Wade LeBlanc has earned the win in 7 consecutive decisions as a starter, dating back to Sept. 23, 2014...marks the longest winning streak of his career as a starter (previous: 5, 9/4/09 - 4/29/10).

Dee Gordon has hit safely in 9 consecutive games (6/12-c)...during that span, Gordon is batting .385 (15x39) with 5 runs, 1 double and 2 RBI...he hit .346 (18x52) over a season-high 12-game hitting streak, March 29 - April 14.

VS. RED SOX

The Mariners and Red Sox meet for the 5th (2-2) of 7 games this season...the two clubs split a 4-game series in Seattle, June 14-17...since 2014, the Mariners are 6-6 at Fenway Park:

TONIGHT'S TILT...the Mariners continue an 11-day, 10-game, 3-city road trip with the first of 3 games at Boston...began the trip by going 0-3 at New York-AL...following this series, will conclude the trip with 4 games at Baltimore...went 5-2 on a recently-concluded 7-day, 7-game homestand vs. Los Angeles-AL (3-0) and Boston (2-2)...tonight's game will be televised on **ROOT SPORTS NW** and broadcast live on **710 ESPN Seattle** and the Mariners Radio Network.

ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners have lost 4 in a row, but have won 6 of their last 11 games, 13 of their last 20, 17 of their last 26, 22 of their last 32 and 24 of their last 36...Seattle is 32-18 in its last 50 games, 37-21 over its last 58 games and 42-25 in its last 67 games...Seattle is 14-13 during the day and 32-16 at night...Seattle is 25-14 at Safeco Field, 21-15 on the road.

- **First Things First** - **Dee Gordon** is batting .350 (21x60) when leading off a game this season.
- **Happy Totals** - since June 4, the Mariners are averaging 4.38 runs per game (70 R, 16 G), posting a record of 9-7...from May 20 to June 3, the Mariners averaged 3.36 runs per game (47 R, 14 G).
- **Multi-Hit Madness** - **Jean Segura** leads the Major Leagues with 32 multi-hit games, ahead of Jose Altuve-HOU (29), Nolan Arenado-COL (29), Francisco Lindor-CLE (29) and Nick Markakis-ATL (29)...Segura leads the Majors with 14 games of 3+ hits, ahead of Nicholas Castellanos-DET (12).
- **It's a Dee Thing** - the Mariners are 16-6 when **Dee Gordon** starts at second base this season.
- **Four Score** - The Mariners are 33-9 when scoring 4-or-more runs, but are 13-20 when scoring 3-or-fewer runs.
- **Series Stuff** - the Mariners have won or tied 21 of their first 25 series, posting a series record of 15-4-6.

WADE TO THE RESCUE...since moving into the Mariners starting rotation on May 3, Wade LeBlanc is 3-0 with a 2.06 ERA (11 ER, 48.0 IP) with 40 strikeouts and 11 walks in 9 starts...the Mariners are 7-2 in those 9 starts...LeBlanc has limited opponents to 3 or fewer runs in each of his 9 starts this season, including 8 starts of 2 or fewer runs...he has worked at least 5.0 innings in 7 of his 9 starts, including 3 outings of 6.0+ innings...in his last start on June 16 vs. Boston at Safeco Field, LeBlanc blanked the Red Sox for 7.2 innings, allowing just 2 hits while striking out 9; he retired 22 consecutive batters at one point...it marked one of his best starts in his career: his 7.2 innings pitched were his most since a career-high 8.0 innings on April 24, 2011 vs. Philadelphia with San Diego, while his 9 strikeouts were his most since a career-high 10 strikeouts on Sept. 23, 2011 vs. Los Angeles-NL with San Diego.

BUSINESS IS BOOMING...in 37 career games at Fenway Park, **Nelson Cruz** is batting .336 (51x152) with 27 runs, 14 doubles, 1 triple, 8 home runs, 28 RBI, 1 HBP, 14 walks, a .395 on-base percentage and a .599 slugging percentage (.994 OPS)...among active players Fenway Park, Cruz ranks 2nd in slugging, 3rd in OPS, 4th in batting and 5th in on-base percentage...among active players as visitors to Fenway Park, his 8 home runs are T6th-most (also: Curtis Granderson, Manny Machado and Mark Reynolds), trailing Jose Bautista (26), Evan Longoria (17), Edwin Encarnacion (17), Adam Jones (13) and Chris Davis (10).

DUCKS ON THE POND...when the Mariners record at least 3 hits with runners in scoring position, they are 21-4 (.840) this season, compared to 25-24 (.510) when held to 2 or fewer hits with RISP...from May 25 - June 16, the Mariners hit .260 (40x154) with runners in scoring position and went 17-5 over that span...in their last 4 games, Mariners hitters are 6-for-34 (.176) with runners in scoring position and have been held to 2 or fewer hits with RISP in 3 of those 4 games...overall this season, Seattle is batting .252 (152x602) with men in scoring position, which ranks 8th in the American League.

LEADERBOARD...this series features the top-2 American League leaders in RBI and saves, as well as two of the top-3 AL leaders in batting average...**Edwin Díaz** holds the top mark for saves in the AL with 27, ahead of Boston's Craig Kimbrel (22) and New York-AL's Aroldis Chapman (22)...Boston's J.D. Martinez leads the AL with 55 RBI, only 1 more than **Mitch Haniger** (54)...the Red Sox Mookie Betts is batting .344 (76x221), 2nd-best in the AL, while **Jean Segura's** .334 (99x296) average is 3rd-best.

GOOD STRETCH...since May 8, the Mariners have a .643 (27-15) winning percentage, 3rd-best in the Majors over that span...they trail only Houston (.718/28-11) and New York-AL (.684/26-12), while ranking ahead of Chicago-NL (.625/25-15) and Milwaukee (.615/24-15)...the Mariners join the Astros and Yankees as the only American League clubs with a winning percentage of at least .600 since May 8.

START IT UP...since May 8, Mariners **starters** lead the American League and rank 3rd in the Majors in ERA...Seattle starters have combined for a 3.24 ERA (93 ER, 258.2 IP) since May 8, trailing only Atlanta (3.01/75 ER, 224.0 IP) and Chicago-NL (3.09/75 ER, 218.1 IP), while ranking ahead of Cleveland (3.24/89 ER, 247.1 IP) and Los Angeles-AL (3.36/84 ER, 225.1 IP)...over that same stretch, Mariners **starters** lead the Major Leagues with 258.2 innings pitched, ahead of the Red Sox (248.2 IP), Indians (247.1 IP), Astros (237.2 IP) and Diamondbacks (228.0 IP).

CRUZ CONTROL...**Nelson Cruz** has 7 home runs in his last 11 games (6/9-c) and 8 home runs in his last 14 games (6/6-c)...since June 6, he leads the American League in home runs and is tied with Arizona's Paul Goldschmidt for the Major League lead...Cruz has hit safely in 20 of his last 27 games, dating back to May 24...during this span, he is batting .299 (29x97) with 17 runs, 3 doubles, 11 home runs, 23 RBI, 3 HBP, 10 walks, a .384 on-base percentage and a .670 slugging percentage (1.054 OPS)...**Cruz leads the Major Leagues in home runs since May 24**, while also ranking T6th in RBI, 6th in slugging and 10th in OPS.

AT HOME ON THE ROAD...the Mariners are 21-15 (.583) on the road this season, the 5th-best road winning percentage in the Major Leagues...they trail only Houston (.725/29-11), New York-AL (.656/21-11), Boston (.643/27-15) and Washington (.595/22-15)...the Mariners are 7-6 in their last 13 road games (5/14-c) and 15-8 away from Safeco Field since April 24...the Mariners rank 9th in the Majors in runs-per-game on the road (4.75/171 R, 36 G)...Seattle is batting .259 (322x1245) on the road, the 7th-highest average in MLB.

AS YOU KNOW...**Wade LeBlanc** owns a 2.06 ERA (11 ER, 48.0 IP) since moving into the Mariners starting rotation on May 3...**BUT DID YOU KNOW?**...that since May 3, LeBlanc's 2.06 ERA is 3rd-best in the American League?...during that span, he trails only Corey Kluber-CLE (1.82/12 ER, 59.1 IP) and Justin Verlander-DET (1.97/13 ER, 59.1 IP), while ranking ahead of Luis Severino-NYY (2.34/15 ER, 57.2 IP) and Blake Snell-TB (2.42/14 ER, 52.0 IP).

ABOUT LEBLANC...

- 33-year-old left-hander is making his 15th appearance and 10th start of the season, his 191st career appearance, 89th career start, 4th start (4th appearance) and second consecutive start vs. the Red Sox tonight.
- Signed with Seattle on March 25 after being released by New York-AL at his request.
- Previously played with Seattle in 2016...acquired on June 22, 2016 from Toronto in exchange for a player to be named later or cash considerations...was traded to Pittsburgh on Sept. 13, 2016 in exchange for a player to be named later or cash considerations.
- Selected by San Diego in the 2nd round of the 2006 MLB First-Year Player Draft.
- Native of Lake Charles, LA...attended Alfred M. Barbe High School.
- Made his Major League debut with the Padres on Sept. 3, 2008 at Los Angeles-NL (L,4,0,8,5,5,3,1,HR-2).
- Pitched for the University of Alabama, 2004-06...was 24-9 with a 2.81 ERA (100 ER, 320.1 IP) and 334 strikeouts in 46 career G/45 GS...holds Alabama's all-time record for strikeouts with 334...National Freshman of the Year (*Baseball America*) and SEC Freshman of the Year in 2004 after going 8-4 with a 2.08 ERA (26 ER, 112.2 IP) with 98 strikeouts in 16 G/15 GS while posting 8 complete games, including 2 shutouts.
- Went 2-5 with a 4.23 ERA (21 ER, 44.2 IP) in 8 starts with the Seibu Lions in the Japan Pacific League in 2015.
- Is 5-7 with a 4.78 ERA (48 ER, 90.1 IP) in 30 career G/14 GS in June.

LAST OUTING...won his 2nd consecutive decision in the Mariners 1-0 win over the Red Sox on June 16...tossed 7.2 scoreless innings, allowing just 2 hits and 0 walks while striking out a season-high 9 batters...retired 22 consecutive batters after allowing a leadoff single to Mookie Betts in the 1st inning; streak ended with a two-out single in the 7th inning...his 7.2 innings pitched were the most since tossing a career-high 8.0 innings (4/24/11 vs. PHI w/SD); his 9 strikeouts were the most since recording a career-high 10 strikeouts (9/23/11 vs. LAD w/SD).

START IT UP...in 17 career starts with the Mariners, is 6-0 with a 3.21 ERA (33 ER, 92.2 IP) with 74 strikeouts and 20 walks...the Mariners are 14-3 in his 17 starts with the club...made 8 starts with Seattle in 2016, going 3-0 with a 4.43 ERA (22 ER, 44.2 IP) with 34 strikeouts and 9 walks.

HE'S A WINNER...has made 17 career starts with the Mariners without suffering a loss...only 1 American League pitcher in the live-ball era has had a longer such streak to begin a tenure with a single club (Whitey Ford-NYY, 22, 7/6/50-6/12/53), while Jim Coates-NYY also sustained a 17-game streak (8/22/59-7/4/60)...among all pitchers in the live-ball era, LeBlanc's streak trails only Ford, Kirk Rueter-MON (22, 7/7/93-6/15/94) and Brooks Lawrence-CIN (18, 4/22/56-7/17/56), while tying Coates (STATS).

AS A RELIEVER...is 0-0 with a 4.61 ERA (7 ER, 13.2 IP) in 5 relief appearances this season...tossed a season-high 4.2 innings of relief in a 4-10 Mariners loss on April 23 at Chicago-AL...limited the White Sox to 2 runs on 6 hits while striking out 6 after entering the game with the Mariners trailing 0-8 in the 4th inning.

WELCOME (BACK) TO SEATTLE...signed with Seattle on March 25 after being released by New York-AL at his request...became the 43rd player in club history to have spent at least two different stints with the Mariners...Mike Blowers (1992-95, 1997, 1999), Raúl Ibañez (1996-2000, 2004-2008, 2013), Norm Charlton (1993, 1995-97, 2001) and Jeff Nelson (1992-95, 2001-03, 2005) are the only players who spent three separate stints with the Mariners.

SPRING TRAINING...was 0-1 with a 5.27 ERA (8 ER, 13.2 IP) and 10 strikeouts and 1 walk in 7 Grapefruit League appearances with New York-AL...held opponents to 1 earned run or fewer in 5 of his 7 appearances, including 2 outings with 0 earned runs.

2017 SEASON...went 5-2 with 1 save and 4 holds in 50 appearances (0 starts) with a 4.50 ERA (34 ER, 68.0 IP), 54 strikeouts and 17 walks with Pittsburgh...held right-handed batters to a .217 (38x175) batting average against with a .270 on-base percentage and a .389 slugging percentage (.658 OPS against).

LAST TIME AROUND...appeared in 11 games (8 starts) with the Mariners in 2016, going 3-0-1 with a 4.50 ERA (25 ER, 50.0 IP)...was 3-0 with a 4.43 ERA (22 ER, 44.2 IP), 34 strikeouts and 5 quality starts in 8 starts with the Mariners...held opponents scoreless in 2 of his 3 relief appearances...went 0-0-1 with a 5.06 ERA (3 ER, 5.1 IP) with 7 strikeouts in 3 relief appearances.

IT HAD BEEN A WHILE...in his Mariners debut on June 24, 2016, LeBlanc made his first Major League appearance since Sept. 28, 2014 at Seattle with Los Angeles-AL, a span of 634 days between appearances...LeBlanc made his first ML start since Sept. 23, 2014 at Oakland with Los Angeles-AL, a span of 639 days between starts.

FIRST SEATTLE WIN...earned his first win with Seattle on July 1, 2016, vs. Baltimore (6.0,3,2,2,1,5,HR-1), his first Major League win since Sept. 23, 2014, with the Angels at the A's, a span of 646 days between Major League wins.

IN JAPAN...spent the 2015 season with the Seibu Lions in the Japan Pacific League...went 2-5 with a 4.23 ERA (21 ER, 44.2 IP) in 8 starts...tossed his second career complete game on April 2, 2015 at Rakuten Golden Eagles, allowing 2 earned runs on 2 hits 9.0 innings (also: 4/25/14 at Reno w/Salt Lake).

CAREER...10-year MLB veteran with 7 clubs (San Diego, Miami, Houston, Los Angeles-AL, New York-AL, Pittsburgh & Seattle)...overall, is 33-35-3 with a 4.23 ERA (300 ER, 638.1 IP) in 190 career appearances/88 starts...in 88 career starts, is 25-31 with a 4.30 ERA (228 ER, 477.0 IP) with 334 strikeouts and 158 walks...in 102 career relief appearances, is 8-4-3 with a 4.02 ERA (72 ER, 161.1 IP) with 125 strikeouts and 43 walks...appeared in 11 games (8 starts) with the Mariners in 2016, going 3-0-1 with a 4.50 ERA (25 ER, 50.0 IP).
