WINS AND LOSSES: The Rangers dropped the opener of this 3-game at Fenway Park on Monday and are 2-3 on this 10-game, 11-day trip to DET (2-2), BOS (0-1), and BAL (3 games) to close the season's 1st half...Texas has dropped 3 of 4 and 4 of the last 7 games but has won 13 of the last 21 contests beginning 6/16...in that span, the Rangers are tied with CLE (13-8) for the A.L.'s 5th best winning pct. at .619... club is 22-21 beginning 5/22.

- At 40-52 (.435), Rangers rank 11th in A.L. in winning pct... the 40 wins are the fewest for Texas after 92 games since 2014 (38-54) and 2nd fewest in last 11 seasons (beg. 2008).

- Texas has been under the .500 mark since a season best 1-1 on 3/30...Rangers were a season-high 17 games under .500 following loss on 6/15 vs. COL, just 4th season in TEX history to be 17+ under as early as 6/15 (last 2007, club-record 6/3)...club lost a season high 7 straight games from 6/7-15 and directly followed that with a 2018 best 7 consecutive wins from 6/16-23...Rangers became just 5th ML club since 2000 to win at least 7 in a row after dropping previous 7+ straight (last 2014 Red Sox).

IN THE STANDINGS: Texas has been a season-high 20.5 GB of division-leading HOU for the last 3 days, losing 4.0 games in the standings over the last 7 days...club has lost 7.0 games in the standings since 6/7 after the team had been between 11.5 and 13.5 GB for 19 straight days from 5/21-6/7...current deficit of 20.5 GB is 3rd-largest in the majors (BAL-37.0 GB and KC-24.5 GB)...club has been in 5th place in the A.L. West for the last 91 days and in either 4th or 5th place for 101 of the 102 days this season (T2nd following win on 3/30).

ON THE ROAD: Texas is 21-24 (.467) away from Arlington this season, tied for the 7th best winning percentage in A.L... club has lost 4 of last 6 on the road but won 7 of last 11, going 10-9 beginning 5/28...it is the best road record after 44 games since 2016 (25-20)...club is 2-0-1 in last 3 road series.

- The Rangers have a 3.84 ERA on the road, 5th lowest in the A.L. and compared to 5.32 home mark...team has posted a 2.56 ERA (38 R/30 ER/105.1 IP) in the last 12 road games.

VERSUS BOSTON: The Rangers are 1-4 against the Red Sox this season, losing the last 4 games since winning the year's 1st contest on 5/3 at Arlington...it will be the 1st time that Boston has won consecutive season's series vs. Texas since 4 in a row from 2005-08...the Rangers have lost 10 of 12 meetings to BOS dating back to 7/6/16 after winning 8 of previous 11 in a span from 5/20/15-7/5/16...Texas has a 41-32 advantage in the series since 2009...the Rangers have dropped 5 in a row at Fenway Park since a win on 7/5/16, their longest losing streak in this park since 8 in a row, 7/2/07-8/14/08...club is 5-11 here since 2013...in the all-time series, the Red Sox hold leads of 239-227 overall and 140-91 at Fenway Park.

- Texas is 7-10 vs. A.L. East clubs in 2018, 3-4 on the road.

BLANKED: Monday was the 4th time that the Rangers have been shut out in 2018, 1st since 6/24 at MIN...all 4 of the shutouts have come on the road in the last 21 away contests beginning 5/20...Texas was blanked 3 times on the road in 2017 and 4 in 2016.

- Texas has participated in consecutive shutouts after a 3-0 win at DET on Sunday...this is the 1st time that the Rangers have pitched a shutout and been blanked in the next game since 8/30-31/15--a 6-0 win vs. BAL followed by a 7-0 loss at SD.

- Monday was the 1st time the Rangers have been shut out by the Red Sox since 8/25/11 at Arlington (0-6) and the 1st here at Fenway Park since 8/14/08 (0-10).

- The Rangers have not scored in the last 16.0 innings with just 10 hits total since tallying a pair of runs in the 2nd inning on Sunday in DET...team's longest scoreless drought of the season is 20.0 straight innings, 5/31-6/2...club has scored 3 or fewer runs in each of last 4 games.

CLUB RECORD FOR REACHING BASE: Shin-Soo Choo did not play on Monday and enter's tonight's game having reached base via a hit, walk, or HBP in 47 consecutive games, a single season club record, one more than Julio Franco (7/28-9/15/93)...the only longer such streak for a Ranger over multiple seasons is 58 games for Will Clark (9/6/95-5/11/96).

- Over the last 12 seasons beginning in 2007, Choo is the 3rd ML player to reach safely in at least 47 consecutive games over one or multiple seasons: 52 G--BAL's Kevin Millar (6/20-8/25/07) and 48 G--CIN's Joey Votto (8/11-10/2/15).

- During the on-base streak which began on 5/13, Choo has batted .339/.464/.600/1.064 (61-180) to place himself among the A.L. season leaders in OBP (T4th, .402), OPS (9th, .903), and BA (16th, .293).

- Choo has hit safely in his last 5 and 17 of his last 18 games, the longer stretch beginning 6/16...in those 18 games, his average is .370 (27-73) to rise from .271.

KING OF THE ROAD: Choo enters tonight's game with an 18-game hitting streak on the road, matching TB's C.J. Cron (4/10-5/17) for the longest in the majors this season...last longer ML streak was 23 games for Eduardo Nunez, 5/10-8/12/17 with SF and BOS...Choo's streak matches the 4th longest single season in club history and is the best since Adrian Beltré's 19-game road hitting streak, 5/8-6/22/13...in this 18-game span away from home, Choo is hitting .356 (26-73) to improve his road average from .232 to .286.

FIRST TIME ALL-STAR: On Sunday, Choo was picked to the 2018 A.L. All-Star Team has an MLB selection, his 1st career ASG honor...he becomes just the 3rd native of South Korea to ever be selected as an All-Star, joining LAD's Chan Ho Park in 2001 and ARI's Byung-Hyun Kim in 2002...Choo, who celebrates his 36th birthday on July 13, will be the 2nd oldest 1st-time All-Star in Rangers' history...RHP Charlie Hough was 38 when he was selected for his lone ASG in 1986.

JURICKSON PROFAR has hit safely in his last 9 games at .351 (13-37) to improve his average from .233 to .247...he has the 4th longest active streak in the A.L. behind: 11--Khris Davis and Whit Merrifield and 10--Joey Wendle...it is also the 2nd longest streak of Profar's career (13 G, 5/27-6/10/16).

- Rangers' players have had 3 hitting streaks of at least 10 games in 2018, a pair of 12-gamers by Shin-Soo Choo and a 10-game streak for Delino DeShields.

ADRIÁN BELTRÉ singled in the 4th inning on Monday for his 3111th career hit, passing Dave Winfield for sole possession of 20th place on the all-time hit list, 4 behind Alex Rodriguez...Beltre has a .324 (34-105) average in 27 games vs. BOS since the start of 2013 with a .341 (14-41) mark in 11 contests at Fenway Park in that span.

PITCHING STREAKS END: Texas pitchers had worked 16.0 consecutive scoreless innings over the previous 2 games before Boston scored a pair of runs in the 1st inning last night...it was the club's longest scoreless innings streak since 23.0 IP, 9/21-25/16...the staff has allowed runs in just 2 of the last 24 overall innings beginning with the 2nd frame on 7/7 at DET...the Rangers bullpen had its scoreless inning streak snapped at 12.2 when Jesse Chavez issued a 3-run HR to J.D. Martinez in the 8th inning on Monday.

SHORTS: Monday was the 6th time that Texas pitchers have not issued a walk this season, matching the total number of walkless games for all of 2017...Robinson Chirinos' 7th inning triple last night was just the 3rd of his career, the others 5/19/15 here at Fenway Park and 8/25/17 at OAK...Cory Gearrin retired all 5 batters faced in his Rangers' debut last night to extend his scoreless innings streak to 7.0 IP in his last 8 appearances with SF and TEX...Gearrin is the 42nd different player and 23rd pitcher to appear in a game with the Rangers in 2018...Texas is now 13-17 in games started by LHP.

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER

#49 Yovani Gallardo, RHP (3-0, 8.17)

TONIGHT: The 32-year-old right-hander is slated to make his 8th appearance/5th start of the season in the middle of this 3-game set in Boston...has gone 3-0 with a 5.87 ERA (15 ER/23.0 IP) over 4 starts with the Rangers (Texas is 4-0 in those starts)...will be working on regular 4 days' rest after picking up his 3rd straight victory in the Rangers' 7-5 win on Thursday at DET (5.1 IP, 8 H, 4 R-3 ER, 1 BB, 2 SO, 1 HR, 92 pitches/58 strikes)...has won 3 straight decisions for the 1st time since 8/16-27/15 (also w/ TEX), seeking to win 4 straight for 1st time since 4/21-5/7/10 w/ MIL...opponents have batted .267/.320/.444/.763 in last 4 starts...had contract purchased from Round Rock (AAA) prior to start on 6/17, where he went 2-1 with a 3.81 ERA (21 ER/49.2 IP) in 10 starts after signing with Texas as a minor league free agent on 4/13...prior to joining the Texas organization, Gallardo had early season stints with Milwaukee and Cincinnati...the Fort Worth resident was a member of the rotation for the Rangers' 2015 division-winner in his lone season with the club...was the Rangers Opening Day starter in 2015, posting the lowest ERA of his career and starting Game 1 of the 2015 ALDS vs. Toronto...since 1st stint with Texas, has spent seasons with Baltimore (2016) and Seattle (2017)...was a mainstay in the Brewers starting rotation from 2009-14 as one of the National League's most durable pitchers over that period...was one of just 9 pitchers to work at least 180.0 innings and one of 10 hurlers to make 30+ starts each year from 2009-14...has fanned 200 or more batters in a season 4 times (2009-10-11-12) and remains the Milwaukee franchise's career strikeout leader...was a 2nd round selection by the Brewers in the 2004 1st Year Player Draft out of Trimble Tech High School in Fort Worth, TX...has the 2nd-most strikeouts (1544) among natives of Mexico, and also ranks among the all-time Mexican leaders in wins (3rd, 116), starts (3rd, 293), and innings (4th, 1747.2).

LAST START: Earned his 3rd straight victory in the Rangers' 7-5 win on Thursday at DET (5.1 IP, 8 H, 4 R-3 ER, 1 BB, 2 SO, 1 HR, 92 pitches/58 strikes)...worked into the 6th inning for a 4th straight start...exited the game with a 7-4 lead and one out in the 6th inning...permitted just 2 hits through his 1st 3 innings of work...induced 2 GIDPs...did not allow an extra-base hit until the Tigers' Niko Goodrum hit a solo home run to lead off the 6th...has won 3 of his 4 starts since joining the Rangers, with the club going 4-0 in those games.

VS. THE RED SOX: Has gone 2-3 with a 5.25 ERA (21 ER/36.0 IP) over 7 career starts vs. the Red Sox, quality starts in 2 of 7...Gallardo in 5 G/GS career at Fenway Park: 1-3, 6.12 (17 ER/25.0 IP)...last season, took the loss for Seattle in a 3-0 setback on 5/26/17 in this park (5.1 IP, 3 R-ER), matching career high w/ 6 BB...has one victory vs. the Red Sox with both the Rangers and the Brewers...tossed 6.2 SHO IP in a 4-0 Milwaukee win on 4/6/14 at BOS...in career on the road against A.L. East opponents, has gone 6-9 with a 4.58 ERA (50 ER/98.1 IP).

ON THE ROAD: Has gone 2-0, with a 5.91 ERA (7 ER/10.2 IP) in 2 road starts with the Rangers...has gone 8-11 with a 5.64 ERA (81 ER/129.1 IP) over 25 road starts since the start of 2016...opponents have batted .365/.431/.596/1.027 in 4 G/2 GS on the road compared to .245/.310/.434/.744 in 3 G/2 GS at home.

2018: Signed by Milwaukee to major league contract as a free agent on 12/21/17...in spring training with Brewers, went 0-1, 4.73 (7 ER/13.1 IP) in 8 G/1 GS w/ 8 BB/12 SO...released by MIL on 3/28 and signed by CIN to one-year major league contract on 3/31...made 3 relief appearances with Reds (2.1 IP, 8 R-ER) before he was designated for assignment on 4/10...rejected outright assignment to Louisville (AAA) on 4/12, signed minors deal with Rangers on 4/13, and reported to Round Rock (AAA).

ROUND ROCK: Was 2-1 with a 3.81 ERA (21 ER/49.2 IP) in 10 starts with Triple-A Round Rock...went 2-0 with a 2.50 ERA (5 ER/18.0 IP) over his last 3 starts with the Express...held opponents to a .239/.271/.328/.600 slash line over that stretch...opposition batted .263/.317/.344/.661 overall...had a 57% ground ball rate and induced 6 double play ground balls...surrendered just one HR in 49.2 IP...permitted 3 ER-or-less in all 10 outings...threw 61% of his pitches for strikes...had an 8.10 SO/9 rate in last 4 starts after a 6.49 figure through his 1st 6 outings...last started in Round Rock's 12-5 win on 6/8 at Las Vegas (5.0 IP, 5 H, 4 R-1 ER, 1 BB, 3 SO, 0 HR, 110 pitches/68 strikes)...threw a season-high 110 pitches, eclipsing the 100-pitch mark for the 1st time in 2018...his own throwing error contributed to 3 unearned runs.

2017: Acquired by SEA from BAL, along with cash considerations, on 1/6 in exchange for OF Seth Smith...with the M's, went 4-10, 6.28 in 22 GS and 1-0, 1.69 in 6 relief app...1st bullpen appearances since his rookie season in 2007...had 5 quality starts...team was 8-14 in his starts...1st ML save, 6/23 vs. HOU (3.0 IP)...pitched for Mexico in World Baseball Classic, lone start on 3/9 vs. Italy (ND, 4.0 IP, 4 H, 4 R-ER), a 10-9 loss for Mexico...signed as a free agent w/ MIL on 12/21.

TOMORROW'S SCHEDULED STARTER — RHP BARTOLO COLON (5-6, 4.65 ERA in 18 games/16 starts)

The 45-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his 19th appearance and 17th start of the season in Wednesday's series finale here in Boston...enters tomorrow's start with 245 career wins, tied with Nicaragua's Dennis Martinez for most in MLB history by a native of Latin America...Colon is already the career leader for wins by a native of the Dominican Republic (previously 243 by Juan Marichal)...has gone 2-2, 3.81 (11 ER/26.0 IP) in last 4 G/GS to lower season ERA from 4.94 to 4.65, allowing 3-or-fewer runs in all 4 starts...is still 3-5, 6.52 (36 ER/49.2 IP) last 9 G/GS to rise from 2.82...will pitch on regular 4 days' rest after suffering the loss in Texas' 3-1 setback on Friday at DET (8.0 IP, 5 H, 3 R-ER, 0 BB, 3 SO, 2 HR, 97 pitches/72 strikes)...went the distance for the 38th time in his career, T6th-most in the majors since his debut season in '97 (Roy Halladay leads w/ 67)...Colon (45 years, 43 days) was the oldest pitcher to toss a CG since PHI's Jamie Moyer (47.199) on 6/5/10 vs. SD...also the oldest pitcher to take a loss in a CG since Nolan Ryan (45.138) in the Rangers' 3-0 loss on 6/17/92 at California...ranks among A.L. leaders in BB/9 (2nd, 1.34) and pitches per inning (3rd, 14.8)...has permitted 22 HR, 2nd-most in A.L....earned win in Rangers' 13-4 victory on 6/29 vs. CWS to tie Martinez for most wins by a pitcher from Latin America...is 9-12, 3.82 (78 ER/184.0 IP) in 30 G/28 GS career vs. BOS, suffering the loss in lone start this year on 5/4 in Arlington (7.0 IP, 5 H, 4 R-ER)...in that start, matched career high with 4 HR allowed, all solo shots...has gone 7-6, 3.74 (42 ER/101.0 IP) in 17 G/16 GS career at Fenway Park, earning the win in his last outing at this park on 4/23/13 with Oakland (7.0 SHO IP, 7 SO), a 13-0 A's victory...is 3-4, 4.37 (27 ER/55.2 IP) in 9 G/GS on road in '18, quality starts in 3 straight and in 7 of 9 overall...was selected Rangers March/April Player of the Month by broadcasters and writers that cover the team on a regular basis, this after going 1-0, 2.87 (10 ER/31.1 IP) in 6 G/4 GS in April...took perfect game bid into 8th inning on ESPN Sunday Night Baseball, 4/15 at HOU...has won games with 11 different teams, tied for most all-time (also LaTroy Hawkins, Edwin Jackson, Mike Morgan, Ron Villone)...Colon is the oldest MLB player since Omar Vizquel's final game on 10/3/12 (age 45.162)...joins teammate Adrián Beltré (21 seasons) as the only active MLB players to have appeared in 20+ seasons...Rangers are 8-8 in his 16 starts.
