WINS AND LOSSES: The Rangers and Red Sox conclude their 2018 series tonight...Texas has lost the 1st 2 games of this set and is 2-4 on this 10-game, 11-day trip to DET (2-2), BOS (0-2), and BAL (3 games) to close the season's 1st $\,$ half...Texas has dropped 2 in a row, 4 of 5 and 5 of the last 8 games...club has won 13 of the last 22 contests beginning 6/16...in that span, the Rangers are tied with CLE (13-9) for the A.L.'s 5th best winning pct. at .591...club is 22-22 begin-

- At 40-53 (.430), Rangers rank 11th in A.L. in winning pct... the 40 wins are the fewest for Texas after 93 games since 2014 (38-55) and 2nd fewest in last 11 seasons (beg. 2008).
- Texas has been under the .500 mark since a season best 1-1 on 3/30...club has dropped back to 13 games below .500, most since 6/19 (31-44/30-44)...Rangers were a season-high 17 games under .500 following loss on 6/15 vs. COL, just 4th season in TEX history to be 17+ under as early as 6/15 (last 2007, club-record 6/3)...club lost a season high 7 straight games from 6/7-15 and directly followed that with a 2018 best 7 consecutive wins from 6/16-23...Rangers became just 5th ML club since 2000 to win at least 7 in a row after dropping previous 7+ straight (last 2014 Red Sox).
- The Rangers have lost all games in a series of 3 or more games twice in 2018, both in Arlington: 4/9-11 vs. LAA (3) and 6/7-10 vs. HOU (4)...club has not lost all games of a series of 3+ road games since 9/22-24/17 at OAK (3).

IN THE STANDINGS: Texas is now a season-high 21.5 GB division-leading HOU, losing 5.0 games in the standings over the last 8 days...club has lost 8.0 games in the standings since 6/7 after the team had been between 11.5 and 13.5 GB for 19 straight days from 5/21-6/7...current deficit of 21.5 GB is 3rd-largest in the majors (BAL-37.5 GB and KC-23.5 GB)...club has been in 5th place in the A.L. West for the last 92 days and in either 4th or 5th place for 102 of the 103 days this season (T2nd following win on 3/30).

ON THE ROAD: Texas is 21-25 (.457) away from Arlington this season, the 8th best winning percentage in A.L...club has lost 2 in a row and 5 of last 7 on the road but won 7 of last 12, going 10-10 beginning 5/28...club had gone 2-0-1 in last 3 road series before losing the 1st 2 games in BOS.

• The Rangers have a 3.94 ERA on the road, 6th lowest in

the A.L. and compared to 5.32 home mark...team has posted a 3.02 ERA (46 R/38 ER/113.1 IP) in the last 13 road games.

VERSUS BOSTON: The Rangers are 1-5 against the Red Sox this season, losing the last 5 games since winning the year's 1st contest on 5/3 at Arlington...Texas' fewest wins in a season vs. Boston: 1-9 in 2008; 1-5 in 2017...it is the 1st time that Boston has won consecutive season's series vs. Texas since 4 in a row from 2005-08...the Rangers have lost 11 of 13 meetings to BOS dating back to 7/6/16 after winning 8 of previous 11 in a span from 5/20/15-7/5/16...Texas has a 41-33 advantage in the series since 2009...the Rangers have dropped 6 in a row at Fenway Park since a win on 7/5/16, their longest losing streak in this park since 8 in a row, 7/2/07-8/14/08...club is 5-12 here since 2013...in the all-time series, BOS hold leads of 240-227 overall & 141-91 at Fenway Park.

• Texas is 7-11 vs. A.L. East clubs in 2018, 3-5 on the road.

BARTOLO AND EL PRESIDENTE: Bartolo Colon enters tonight's start here in Boston with 245 career wins, tied with Nicaragua's Dennis Martinez for most in MLB history by a native of Latin America...Colon passed Hall of Famer Juan Marichal for the most victories by a native of the Dominican Republic with his 244th win on 6/18 at KC.

JACKSON DESIGNATED FOR ASSIGNMENT: OF Austin Jackson, who was acquired in the 3-player deal with SF on Sunday, has been designated for assignment...Texas has 10 days to trade, release, or outright Jackson to the minors.

BARTOLO VS. BOSTON: Colon makes his 31st overall career appearance and 29th start versus the Red Sox tonight... Colon is 9-12, 3.82 vs. BOS with the 12 losses matching SEA for his most vs. one team...Colon's 4 career CG against the Red Sox tie TOR for 2nd most vs. any club (5--LAA)...as an opposing pitcher, Colon is 5-5, 3.87 in 13 G/12 GS at Fenway Park, working 7.0 shutout innings in a rain-shortened CG 13-0 win in his last outing here on 4/23/13 with OAK.

· Colon has 10 or more career victories versus 10 teams entering tonight's start in Boston...the only active pitcher to defeat more teams at least 10 times is C.C. Sabathia (12).

THE STREAK CONTINUES: Shin-Soo Choo's had a pair of walks on Tuesday to extend his streak of reaching base via a hit, walk, or HBP to 48 consecutive games, a single season club record, 2 more than Julio Franco (7/28-9/15/93)...the only longer such streak for a Ranger over multiple seasons is 58 games for Will Clark (9/6/95-5/11/96).

- Over the last 12 seasons beginning in 2007, Choo is the 3rd ML player to reach safely in at least 48 consecutive games over one or multiple seasons: 52 G--BAL's Kevin Millar (6/20-8/25/07) and 48 G--CIN's Joey Votto (8/11-10/2/15).
- During the on-base streak which began on 5/13, Choo has batted .333/.463/.590/1.053 (61-183) to place himself among the A.L. season leaders in OBP (4th, .399) and OPS (11th, .899)...he is also 3rd in the A.L. with 58 walks...his .403 OBP as a leadoff hitter is 2nd best in the majors to BOS' Mookie Betts (.438).
- Choo's road hitting streak was snapped on Tuesday at 18 games, which matched TB's C.J. Cron (4/10-5/17) for the longest in the majors this season...it tied the 4th longest single season in club history and was the best since Adrian Beltré's 19-game road hitting streak, 5/8-6/22/13.

FIRST TIME ALL-STAR: On Sunday, Choo was picked to the 2018 A.L. All-Star Team as an MLB selection, his 1st career ASG honor...he becomes just the 3rd native of South Korea to ever be selected as an All-Star, joining LAD's Chan Ho Park in 2001 and ARI's Byung-Hyun Kim in 2002...Choo, who celebrates his 36th birthday on July 13, will be the 2nd oldest 1st-time All-Star in Rangers' history...RHP Charlie Hough was 38 when he was selected for his lone ASG in 1986.

BATTING STREAKS: Jurickson Profar has hit safely in his last 9 games at .351 (13-37) to improve his average from .233 to .247...that matches the 4th longest active strreak in the A.L. behind: 12--Khris Davis and Whit Merrifield and 10--Joey Wendle; 9--Jonathan Schoop...it is also the 2nd longest streak of Profar's career (13 G, 5/27-6/10/16).

- Ronald Guzman has hit safely in his last 7 games with an at bat, a career best, at .520 (13-25) to improve from .224 to .260...Guzman is 5-for-8 in his last 2 games
- Rougned Odor has a hit in his last 4 contests at 6-for-14 with a pair of homers to go from ,229 to .242, his highest average since he was 1-for-2 on opening day...Odor's season high hit streak is 5 games. 6/16-23.

ORIOLES NEXT: The Rangers close the pre-All-Star break schedule with 3 games in Baltimore after a Thursday offday...the Orioles are the lone A.L. team that Texas has not played in 2018...the Rangers lost the final 2 meetings a year ago and were 1-6 overall in the series after going 10-4 in 2015-16...Texas was swept in a 4-game set at Oriole Park, 7/17-20/17 and are just 4-11 in BAL since the start of 2014.

• The Rangers are scheduled to play 97 games before the All-Star break, which would be the team's 2nd most ever...club had played 98 games when the ASG was held on 7/23/74.

SHORTS: Texas is 13-17 in games started by LHP in 2018, 3-9 on the road...the 2 double plays turned last night give the Rangers 90 for the year, 2nd in the A.L. to LAA (96)...Texas is just 3-for-32 with RISP on the 1st 6 games of this roadtrip.

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER

#40 Bartolo Colon, RHP (5-6, 4.65)

TONIGHT: The 45-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his 19th appearance and 17th start of the season in tonight's finale of this 3-game set at Boston...will pitch on regular 4 days' rest after suffering the loss in last start on Fri. at DET (8.0 IP, 5 H, 3 R-ER, 0 BB, 3 SO, 2 HR, 97 pitches/72 strikes)...Colon will look to pass Dennis Martinez in most wins by a native of Latin America tonight, as he is already the career leader for wins by a native of the Dominican Republic (previously 243 by Juan Marichal)...is 2-2, 3.81 (11 ER/26.0 IP) last 4 G/GS to drop season ERA from 4.94 to 4.65, allowing 3-or-fewer runs in all 4 starts...is still 3-5, 6.52 (36 ER/49.2 IP) last 9 G/GS to rise from 2.82...ranks among A.L. leaders in BB/9 (2nd, 1.34) and pitches per inning (3rd, 14.8)...has permitted 22 HR, 2nd-most in A.L...was selected Rangers March/April Player of the Month by broadcasters and writers that cover the team on a regular basis, this after going 1-0, 2.87 (10 ER/31.1 IP) in 6 G/4 GS in April...has won games with 11 different teams, tied for most all-time (also LaTroy Hawkins, Edwin Jackson, Mike Morgan, Ron Villone)...was originally signed by Texas to a minor league contract on 2/4, going 0-1, 3.00 ERA (6 ER/18.0 IP) in 5 G/GS for the Rangers this spring w/ 2 BB/10 SO before he was released on 3/23...was re-signed to minors contract on 3/26...joins teammate Adrián Beltré (21 seasons) as only active MLB players to have appeared in 20+ seasons...Colon (age 45.048 today) is oldest MLB player since Omar Vizquel's final game on 10/3/12 ge 45.162), and 2nd-oldest in Rangers history (Nolan Ryan, 46.234 for final start 9/22/93 at SEA)...Rangers are 8-8 in his 16 starts.

AMONG THE GREATS: Earned career win no. 245 in start on 6/30 vs. CWS, tving Nicaragua's Dennis Martinez (245) for most in MLB history by a native of Latin Ame ica...Colon is already all-time wins leader for a native of the Dominican Republic (formerly 243 by Hall of Famer Juan Marichal)...Colon leads all actives with 245 wins and 3416.0 IP (Sabathia is 2nd w/ 243 wins/3411.1 IP).

LAST START: Suffered the loss in Rangers' 3-1 defeat on Fri. at DET (8.0 IP, 5 H, 3 R-ER, 0 BB, 3 SO, 2 HR, 97 pitches/72 strikes)...allowed at least 2 HR in a start for the 6th time...had gone 3 previous starts allowing just one...threw 12 pitchers or less in 7 of 8 frames...was his 38th career complete game, ties CC Sabathia for most among active players...logged the 1st complete game by a Texas starter since Cole Hamels in a 4-1 win on 8/5/17 at MIN...was the 1st complete game loss by a Texas hurler since Colby Lewis in a 4-2 defeat on 8/9/15 at SEA...was the 1st time to be defeated in a complete game since a 1-0 loss on 6/15/05 vs. WSH as an Angel... Colon (45 years, 43 days) was the oldest pitcher to toss a complete game since PHI's Jamie Moyer (47.199) on 6/5/10 vs. SD...was the oldest pitcher to take a loss in a complete game since Nolan Ryan (45.138) in the Rangers' 3-0 loss on 6/17/92 at California.

VS. BOSTON: Is 9-12, 3.82 (78 ER/184.0 IP) in 30 G/28 GS career vs. BOS, suffering the loss in lone start this year on 5/4 in Arlington (7.0 IP, 5 H, 4 R-ER)...allowed 4 HR, all solo shots, tying a career high...received run one in support for the third time in his first five starts...his 12 losses vs. Red Sox are most against any opponent... has made four career postseason starts against Boston, appearing in the 1998, 1999 and 2004 ALDS...went 0-1 with a 5.66 ERA (13 ER/20.2 IP) in those four starts. Has gone 7-6, 3.74 (42 ER/101.0 IP) in 17 G/16 GS in career at Fenway Park, allowing 3-or-fewer earned runs in each of last 6 starts (3-2, 2.61 in 7 G/6 GS)... tossed a complete-game shutout on 4/23/13 in his last start on Fenway, a rain-short-ened 7 inning contest (7.0 IP, 3 H, 0 R-ER, 1 BB, 7 SO).

MILESTONE STRIKEOUT: Whiffed Max Muncy in the 1st inning on 6/12 at LAD for career strikeout no. 2500, 34th in MLB history to reach that mark...his 2510 career SO rank 33rd all-time and are 3rd among actives (2921-Sabathia, 2576-Verlander)...next on list is A.J. Burnett (32nd all-time, 2513 SO).

ON THE ROAD: Has gone 3-4 with a 4.37 ERA (27 ER/55.2 IP) in 9 starts away from Arlington this season...went 2-0, 1.59 in his 1st 4 road starts, then lost back-to-back road starts at LAA and LAD (14 R-ER/6.1 IP)...has posted consecutive quality starts in his last 3 away outings (8 R-ER/21.0 IP) and still has lower ERA on road (4.37) than at home (5.00) this season.

2018: Opponents are batting .262/.288/.496/.785 this season...RHB have just 4 BB against 34 SO...has permitted 22 HR, 2nd-most in A.L....after the 1st out of an inning, opponents have a .213 (52-244) BA...opposition batting .263 (21-80) w/ RISP, Inicl. .340 (18-53) last 8 starts...opponent avg. by PA in game (as a starter): 1st PA - .227 (32-141); 2nd PA - .306 (41-134); 3rd PA - .265 (26-98); 4th PA - 1-for-4... Robinson Chirinos has caught 14 G/11 GS (4.90 ERA, 39 ER/71.2 IP), Carlos Pérez has 4 G/GS (4.50, 11 ER/22.0 IP), and Kiner-Falefa (2 ER/7.0 IP) caught on 6/24 at MIN...Pérez started on 5/16 in SEA, but Chrinos caught his BF in the 8th...matched career high w/ 4 HR allowed on 5/4 vs. BOS, 2nd time in Rangers history for pitcher to post qualifying start, allowing 4+ R all on solo HR (also Fergie Jenkins, 7/1/75 vs. KC)...also 4 HR allowed, 5/21 vs. NYY...took ND in Rangers' 5-4 10-inning walk-off win on 5/9 vs. DET...6/18 at KC was 1st win at The K since 5/4/09...on 6/24 at MIN, became 1st TEX starter to lose in ultra QS since Hamels on 9/16/17 at LAA

A BIRD OF MANY COLORS: Colon has earned a victory with each of the 11 clubs for which he has pitched in his career, tying a trio of other pitchers for the ML record of winning games with the most different teams (also LaTroy Hawkins, Edwin Jackson, Mike Morgan, and Ron Villone - 11 each).

ALMOST PERFECT: Flirted with a perfect game on ESPN Sunday Night Baseball on 4/15 at HOU, retiring the 1st 21 Astros he faced before issuing a leadoff walk to Carlos Correa in the 8th inning...Josh Reddick followed w/ double to break up the no-hit bid...threw a first pitch strike to 20-of-25 batters faced...became the oldest pitcher in ML history to ever work at least 7.2 IP and allow one or fewer hits (previous TEX's Nolan Ryan at 44.090 for 7th no-hitter on 5/1/91 vs. TOR).
