THE LATEST:

- Yesterday afternoon, the Blue Jays took a 2-1 lead with a pair of runs in the 7th inning before allowing a tying run in the 9th, then lost, 6-2, in 10 innings on a walk-off grand slam by Xander Bogaerts...Was the 9th walk-off slam allowed in team history and the 5th to come in extra innings (last: April 27, 2017 at STL - 11th inning)...Marked their 3rd walk-off loss at Fenway over the last two seasons - all in extras - also doing so on July 18 (15 inn.) and Sept. 5 (19 inn.) last year...Are now 6-3 in walk-off contests this season...Drop to 8-4 in extra-inning affairs, having lost three straight such games.
- The Jays are now 4-8 in July but have won 13 of their last 26 games, as well as 17 of their last 33...Are 18-18 in their last 36 contests, following a 4-15 stretch...Are now 5.5 games back of the Rays for 3rd place in the AL East...Drop back to 22.5 games behind the division-leading Red Sox, matching their season mark...Have not been further back since ending the 2013 season 23.0 games behind Boston.

DWIGHT DOING DAMAGE:

- Dwight Smith Jr. doubled and walked in a 1-for-2 effort yesterday...Has three extra-base hits in his last five MLB games (2-2B, 1-HR)...Now has 11 hits this season to surpass his total of 10 from last year...Has gone 11-for-35 (.314) with 5-2B, 2-HR, 7-RBI and 4BB/4K over 17G with the Blue Jays this season (.390 OBP, 1.019 OPS)...Is now batting .339 (21-for-62) with 9-XBH and 8-RBI over 29 career MLB games (.948 OPS).

LOURDES LEADS OFF:

- Lourdes Gurriel Jr. was slotted into the leadoff spot for the 2nd time in his career yesterday (also May 3 at CLE - Game 2)...Singled three times and drove in a run for his 2nd career three-hit game (also May 3 at CLE - Game 1)...Extended his career-long streak of multi-hit games to four (8th career multi-hit game)...Became the first Toronto rookie with a 4G multi-hit streak since Adam Lind in 2006...Is one of four Jays all-time with a 4G such streak within their first 31 MLB contests (Lind, Steve Skaggs, Al Woods)...Is one of three Blue Jays this season with a 4G multi-hit streak.
- Gurriel has hits in each of his last 10 starts, batting .381 (16-for-42) with two doubles, two homers, six runs and eight RBI over that span...Now has 30 hits, which are tied for 13th most all-time by a Blue Jay through their first 31 MLB contests, and the most since Devon Travis had 32 hits in 2015.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN:

- This afternoon marks the final contest of a six-game road trip for the Blue Jays...Starting tomorrow, will enjoy the four-day All-Star Break...Will then kick off the unofficial second half with a six-game homestand, hosting Baltimore (27-69) and Minnesota (43-50) each for a trio of dates.
- The Jays are now 2-3 on the current road trip and have lost 15 of their last 21 away games...Hold a road record of 19-26 for a .422 win% (10th among AL teams)...Have been out-scored, 235-201, and out-hit, 419-362, in road contests...Have averaged 4.47 runs/game on the road (7th highest in the AL) while allowing 5.22 R/G (13th in the AL).

- The Blue Jays are now 3-9 against the Red Sox this season, matching their most losses vs. any opponent this season (also NYY)...Need a win today to earn a split of this series...Are 0-3 against the Red Sox in series play so far this year...Are now 1-5 at Fenway Park this season, after going 5-5 there in 2017.
- Devon Travis has gone 9-for-28 (.321) with 2-3B and 1-HR in eight games against the BoSox this season...Is now a career .298 (37-for-124) hitter against them, with 6-2B, 2-3B, 4-HR and 13-RBI over 32 games (.817 OPS).
- Kendrys Morales has an eight-game hitting streak vs. Boston, batting .393 (11-for-38) with 5-XBH over that span...Is now hitting .308 (36-for-117) with 9-2B, 5-HR and 21-RBI in his last 30 games against them.
- Curtis Granderson leads all current Blue Jays with 20 career home runs and 49 RBI vs. Boston...Has hit .244 (87-for-357) with 14-2B and 7-3B over 98 games.

EVEN MO TIMES ON BASE:

- Kendrys Morales went 2-for-3 with a walk yesterday, a game after reaching base four times (2B, 3BB)...Has back-to-back games of reaching base 3+ times for the 2nd time this year (also June 20-21)...Has gone 10-for-23 (.435) over his last eight games, with 2-2B, 3-HR, 4-RBI and 5-BB for a .536 OBP, .913 SLG and 1.449 OPS...Among AL batters since June 6, ranks 3rd in SLG (.632), 6th in AVG (.337), 6th in OPS (1.039) and 9th in OBP (.407).

- Toronto's .324 win% in games vs. LH starters is the lowest in the Majors this year...It's only season with a lower win% in such games came in 1981 with a 14-30 record (.318)...courtesy STATS.

- At 43-51, the Jays have a win% of .457...Can up it to .463 with a win today or see it drop to .453 as they enter the All-Star Break...Had a .466 win% at the break last year (41-47)...Their 95 games played at the break will be tied for 2nd most all-time (96G in 2014, 95G in 2003 and 2008).

Marcus Stroman, RHP # 6

Born: Medford, NY AGE: 27

TODAY'S START:

- ✦ Making his 12th start of the season and looking for his 1st consecutive winning decisions this year...Coming off his 1st road win and 2nd win overall of the season on 7/10 at ATL, where he allowed 1 ER on 6 hits over 7.0 innings (2BB, 5K), matching his longest outing of the season for the 3rd time.

2018 HIGHLIGHTS:

- ✦ Ranks 1st among MLB pitchers with a groundball rate of 63.3% since the start of last season.
- ✦ Made his 100th career start on 7/10 at ATL...Earned his 1st road win of the season after throwing 7.0 IP and allowing 1ER on 6 hits (2BB, 5K)... Stroman also singled in his first at-bat of the season... Was his 3rd career hit, to go with a pinch-hit double and a home run last season...Has gone 3-for-10 (.300) as a batter since the start of last year...The three hits in that time are the most by an AL pitcher other than Shohei Ohtani, and are tied for 2nd most in Blue Jays history (Happ-4, Halladay-3, Williams-3).
- ✦ Earned his 1st win of the season on 6/29 vs DET...Also recorded his 500th career strikeout with a K of James McCann in the 5th inning...Became the 21st player to record 500 SO as a Blue Jay... Snapped his career-long streak of 6 consecutive lost decisions... Allowed 2 runs on 5 hits across 7.0 innings, matching his longest outing of the year (5/2 at MIN)...Recorded 4 strikeouts without issuing a free pass for his first walk-free start since 9/2/17 at BAL.
- ✦ Was reinstated from the disabled list on 6/23 and threw his 1st scoreless start of the year that night at LAA, allowing 6 hits through 5.0 IP (1BB, 5K).
- ✦ Was placed on the 10-Day disabled list from 5/9-6/22 with right shoulder fatigue.
- ✦ Allowed 5 runs on 9 hits over 5.0 innings on 5/8 vs. SEA (2BB, 2K)...The 9 hits matched a season high (also 4/13 at CLE).
- ✦ Threw a season-high 7.0 innings on 5/2 at MIN and allowed 2 runs on 6 hits for his 1st quality start of the year.
- ✦ Played in his 100th career game (94th start) vs. TEX (4/27)... Allowed 6 ER in back-to-back starts for the 2nd time in his career (also May 28 (7) and June 4, 2016 (6)).
- ✦ Allowed five runs on six hits over 4.2 innings on 4/7 vs. TEX... Walked five batters, one shy of career high (7/17/17 vs. OAK)... Was his 1st career game recording more balls than strikes (51-44).
- ✦ Opening Weekend, he threw 5.0 innings on 4/1 vs. NYY, allowing 4 ER on 4 hits...Struck out 8 batters, his most ever in a first start of a season.

VS. THE RED SOX:

- ✦ Has not started against the Red Sox this season...Went 0-1 in 3 starts vs. the Red Sox last season with a 3.63 ERA...Holds a 1-1 record in 3 starts at Fenway Park with a 3.26 ERA (19.1 IP, 20H, 0HR, 10BB, 17K)...Has a 4-2 record with a 4.19 ERA and a .283 OBA in 10 career starts overall against Boston.
