TRIBE HEADLINES

» Cleveland has gone 15-4 in the month of August with a 2.42 team ERA (2nd-lowest in MLB)...the club's 21-9 record (.700) since the All-Star break ranks 2nd-best in MLB (OAK - .724).
 » The Indians have gone 17-4 on the road since July 1, scoring 6.33 runs per game in that span and posting a 2.88 team ERA (60ER/187.1IP), the lowest mark in MLB.
 » **GREG ALLEN enters play tonight riding a 14-game hit streak, the longest active run in MLB.**...he also enters tonight without a strikeout in each of his last 26 plate appearances, the 2nd-longest active run in the Majors.
 » **CARLOS CARRASCO** enters tonight leading the A.L. with a 1.33 ERA in the second half (min. 30.0IP)...he also enters play tonight with a 2.55 ERA on the road, the 4th-lowest mark in the A.L.
 » **EDWIN ENCARNACION** was activated from the 10-Day Disabled List today...he is a career .287 hitter at Fenway Park, with 17 homers and 47 RBI in 53 career games...he has gone 4-for-9 with three homers and six RBI in his last two games here.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» Cleveland took a 2-0 series lead with a 6-3 victory last night... moved the club to a new high-water mark of 21 games above .500.
 » Cleveland jumped to an early 2-0 lead in the 4th on RBI hits by **YAN GOMES** (single) and **GREG ALLEN** (double)...Allen's double extended his career-long hit streak to 14 games, the longest active run in MLB...Gomes went 3-for-4 with an 8th-inning solo shot.
 » **MELKY CABRERA** extended the lead with a solo homer in the 6th, his third consecutive game with a longball...Cabrera finished the night 3-for-4, marking his fourth game this season with three-or-more hits.
 » **SHANE BIEBER** was perfect through the first 10 batters he faced and finished the night allowing three runs on five hits (0BB, 5K) in 6.0 innings, picking up his seventh win of the year (T3rd among A.L. rookies)...Bieber has walked two-or-fewer batters in each of his first 13 career starts, the longest streak by an Indians pitcher to begin his career in the *Baseball Reference Play Index* era (1908-).
 » **ADAM CIMBER** (0.2IP), **ANDREW MILLER** (1.0IP, 2K) and **BRAD HAND** (1.0IP, 2K) each made a scoreless appearance in relief, with Hand earning his fifth save since joining the Indians.

AUGUST RUSH

» The Indians currently own a 15-4 record (.789) in August, marking the best record in the American League this month and 2nd-best in MLB (St. Louis is 16-4, .800).
 » **Tribe has posted a 2.44 ERA (46ER/170.0IP) in August, the 2nd-lowest in MLB (OAK - 2.42)**...Tribe has allowed three-or-fewer runs in 14 of 19 contests this month, going 12-2 in those games.
 » The Tribe's 21-9 record (.700) since the All-Star break ranks 2nd-best in MLB (OAK - 21-8, .724)...since the start of the 2013 campaign, Cleveland's 236-150 (.611) cumulative record in the second half is the best in the Majors.

STRONG STARTERS

» **SHANE BIEBER** recorded the Tribe's 80th quality start of the season last night, 2nd-most in MLB (Houston - 83)...Cleveland sits just four quality starts shy of matching its total of 84 last season.
 » Tribe starters have posted a collective 3.30 ERA this year, 2nd-lowest in the American League (HOU - 3.09) and 3rd-lowest in MLB (LAD - 3.27).
 » **Over Cleveland's last 24 games (since July 25), Indians starting pitchers have gone 15-3 with a 2.17 ERA (39ER/161.2IP), the lowest mark in MLB over that span.**

PLEASE COME TO BOSTON

» In a battle of first-place clubs, the Indians are in Boston this week for the first of two series against the Red Sox...following these four-games, Cleveland will host Boston for three games from Sept. 21-23...Tribe holds a 1041-981 (.515) all-time mark over the Red Sox.
 » Cleveland went 3-4 in its 2017 season series vs. the Red Sox, losing two of three contests at Fenway Park and splitting a four-game set at Progressive Field...since **Terry Francona** became Tribe manager in 2013, the Indians hold a 17-18 (.486) regular-season record vs. Boston, in addition to a three-game sweep in the 2016 ALDS.

 Richard Palacios went 2-for-3 with two runs scored, a triple and solo homer...Miguel Eladio (1-4) also went yard.
 » **MV Scrappers (Short-A): 34-28, 2nd (-0.5G)** » 8/21: W, 4-1 at Auburn » Today: 6:30 at Auburn
 The Scrappers sit just half a game behind 1st-place Auburn...Michael Tinsley (1-4) drove in two runs.

COOKIES FOR DINNER

» **CARLOS CARRASCO** will be making his 24th start (25th appearance) of the season tonight...owns a career 1-2 record and 6.83 ERA (21ER/27.2IP) in seven games (five starts) vs. Boston.
 » Will be pitching tonight on regular four days' rest after winning his last start on August 17 vs. Baltimore (7.0IP, 3H, 0R, 1BB, 6K)...has not allowed an earned run across his last 18.1 innings pitched, dating back to August 7.
 » Carrasco has compiled a 7-3 mark and 2.55 ERA (23ER/81.1IP) in 12 road starts this season...entering tonight, his road ERA ranks 4th-lowest in the American League.
 » Since his return from the Disabled List on July 6, Carrasco has posted a 7-1 record and 1.73 ERA (10ER/52.0IP) in nine outings (eight starts)...since July 6, his ERA is 2nd-lowest in the A.L. (CWS's **Carlos Rodón** - 1.41) and his 65 strikeouts are 3rd-most (min. 40.0IP).
 » Carrasco is due to make his 200th career appearance tonight and will become the 49th pitcher in franchise history with at least 200 outings in an Indians uniform.

GREG ROLLS

» **GREG ALLEN extended his career-long hit streak to 14 games last night**, going 2-for-3 with a double and an RBI.
 » **Allen's hit streak is the longest active run in MLB, as well as the longest streak by an MLB rookie this year**...represents the longest streak by an Indians rookie since **MICHAEL BRANTLEY's** 19-game run from August 30 - September 19, 2010.
 » He is batting .400 (20-50) across the streak (since July 15), with a double, a homer, six RBI and 11 runs scored...he also leads American League outfielders with a .375 (15-40) batting average in August.
 » The streak is the third-longest by a Tribe batter this season, trailing a 19-game streak by **MICHAEL BRANTLEY** (May 9-30) and a 15-gamer by **FRANCISCO LINDOR** (April 29-May 14).

SMOOTH SAILING

» **MICHAEL BRANTLEY** reached base three times last night, going 2-for-4 with an RBI and a walk en route to his 39th multi-hit game (2nd-most on Indians, behind **FRANCISCO LINDOR** - 49).
 » Extended his Fenway Park hit streak to 11 games, batting .435 (20-46) across the streak...marks the longest active streak at the park by a visiting player, as well as the longest by an Indians player in Boston since **Carlos Baerga's** 14-game run from 1993-95.
 » Brantley has hit safely in 13 of his last 15 games and is batting .354 (23-65) with five doubles, two home runs, 11 RBI, 14 runs scored and a .456 on-base percentage...his August OBP is 2nd-highest among A.L. outfielders this month, while his batting average is the 3rd-best.
 » He enters play tonight with a .304 batting average (7th in A.L.)...he is the second-toughest hitter in the A.L. to strike out (12.5 PA/SO) and also ranks T5th in batting average vs. RHP (.320).

ROAD WARRIORS

» Cleveland has gone 17-4 away from Progressive Field since July 1, earning wins in each of its last six road series...the Tribe enters play tonight at a high-water mark of six games over .500 on the road (34-28).
 » **Since July 1, Cleveland is averaging 6.33 runs per game (132 runs/21 games) on the road while posting a 2.88 ERA (60ER/187.1IP), the lowest mark in MLB over that span**...Tribe batters are hitting a combined .297 (228-767) on the road in that span, the top road batting average in the Majors.

THE MELKY WAY

» **MELKY CABRERA** homered in his third consecutive game last night, finishing the night 3-for-4 with two runs scored and an RBI.
 » Marks the third time in his career that he has homered in three consecutive games and first since his career-best streak of four games from April 4-8, 2014 with Toronto.
 » Cabrera's streak is the seventh occurrence of home runs in three-or-more consecutive games by an Indians hitter this season, the 2nd-most by any club this year (STL - 8 streaks).
 » **Over his past 9 games, Cabrera is batting .424 (14-33) with five homers and 14 RBI (most in MLB since August 12).**

THIS DAY IN INDIANS HISTORY

1970: Ninth-inning defensive replacement **Chuck Hinton** singles in the game-winning run in the bottom of the 10th as the Tribe tops the Oakland Athletics 6-5 at Cleveland Stadium...the Indians hit four homers in the game, off the bats of **Vada Pinson** (solo), **Graig Nettles** (solo), **Eddie Leon** (solo) and **Duke Sims** (two-run)...Tribe finished the season with a then-club record 183 longballs, good for 2nd-most in the American League.

TODAY'S START

» The 31-year-old right-hander is set to make his seventh start of the second half in this evening's contest at Boston...is pitching on regular four days' rest after facing Baltimore in his last start on August 17 at Progressive Field...earned his 15th win of the season, holding the Orioles scoreless for 7.0 innings on just three hits (1BB, 6K).
 » **Since returning from the Disabled List on July 6, Carrasco has gone 7-1 with a 1.73 ERA (10ER/52.0IP) in eight starts (nine appearances)...he has not allowed an earned run in each of his last 18.1 innings pitched.**
 » Carrasco is making his first start of the season against the Boston Red Sox...owns a career record of 1-2 with a 6.83 ERA (21ER/27.2IP) in five starts (seven appearances).
 » Has gone 7-3 with a 2.55 ERA (23ER/81.1IP) in 12 road starts this season...he currently owns the 4th-lowest road ERA in the American League.
 » Carrasco owns a 4-1 record with a 1.33 ERA (6ER/40.2IP) in six starts since the All-Star break...owns the lowest second-half ERA (min. 30.0IP) in the American League (3rd-lowest in MLB).

LAST TIME OUT | 2018 HIGHLIGHTS

» Carrasco is starting on regular four days' rest after making his last start on August 17 vs. Baltimore...**earned the win after tossing 7.0 shutout innings, holding the Orioles to just three hits (1BB, 6K)...Carrasco is now 7-1 with a 1.73 ERA (10ER/52.0IP) in eight starts (nine appearances) since returning from the Disabled List on July 6, and he has not allowed an earned run in each of his last 18.1 innings pitched...he enters play today T3rd in the American League with 15 wins.**
 » Improved to 3-0 for the first time in his career as he tossed his 9th career complete game on April 11 vs. Detroit... held the Tigers to just one run on three hits over 9.0 innings, walking two and striking out six batters...took a no-decision at Estadio Hiram Bithorn against Minnesota on April 18 despite tossing 7.0 shutout innings (3H, 1BB, 7K).
 » **Threw his 10th career complete game and his second of 2018 on May 9 at Milwaukee, holding the Brewers to two runs on five hits in the Tribe's 6-2 win...Carrasco struck out a season-high 14 batters, one shy of his career high and the most by any Indians pitcher this season...also helped his own cause at the plate, collecting an RBI-single in the 9th inning...became the first Tribe pitcher with an RBI in his own complete game since Gaylord Perry did so on September 22, 1972 vs. New York-AL.**
 » Earned his 10th win of the season on July 11 vs. Cincinnati after holding the Reds to one run on five hits over 5.0 innings of work...**struck out seven batters to reach 1,000 career punchouts, making him the 12th pitcher with 1,000 strikeouts in an Indians uniform and the 44th active MLB pitcher to reach 1,000.**

STRIKEOUTS RISING

» Carrasco has struck out 86 batters over his past 10 starts, bringing his season total to 161 punchouts...he enters play tonight ranked T9th in the American League in strikeouts despite missing three weeks on the Disabled List.
 » Currently ranks 9th in the American League with 10.2 strikeouts per 9.0 innings...he also is 4th in the A.L. with a 5.75 K/BB ratio and 5th in walks per 9.0 innings (1.76).
 » Since the beginning of 2015, Carrasco has amassed 10.06 strikeouts-per-9.0IP, the 3rd-highest total among American League pitchers with at least 500.0 innings pitched in that span (Chris Sale, Chris Archer, **Corey Kluber** ranks 4th with 9.97 K/9.0IP).
 » Carrasco also owns a 4.99 K/BB ratio since the 2015 season, which ranks 3rd-best in the A.L. in that span (min. 500.0IP) behind Chris Sale (6.34) and **Corey Kluber** (5.61).

WELCOME TO THE SECOND HALF

» Carrasco currently sits 4-1 with a 1.33 ERA (6ER/40.2IP) in six starts since the All-Star break, marking the lowest second-half ERA in the American League (min. 30.0IP) and 3rd-lowest second-half ERA in MLB...he has struck out 49 batters (T4th in MLB) and allowed just five walks in the second half.
 » Went 8-3 with a 3.12 ERA (33ER/95.1IP) in the second half in 2017...Carrasco also posted a 5-0 record with a 1.48 ERA (7ER/42.2IP) in September last season

VS. BOSTON | A.L. EAST

» Carrasco will be making his 6th career start (8th appearance) vs. the Boston Red Sox, as well as his first this season...owns a career record of 1-2 vs. Boston with a 6.83 ERA (21ER/27.2IP).
 » Made two starts against the Red Sox in 2017, going 0-1 with an 11.88 ERA (11ER/8.1IP)...allowed five runs in 1.2 innings in an August 1, 2017 no-decision at Fenway Park, and took the loss on August 22 at Progressive Field (6.2IP, 8H, 6R/ER).
 » Tonight will also mark Carrasco's fourth start (fifth appearance) this season against an opponent from the A.L. East division, going 3-0 with a 3.05 ERA (7ER/20.2IP) in those outings...two of those victories came against Baltimore (April 23, August 17), while Carrasco earned a win in relief on July 15 vs. New York-AL (1.0IP, 0H, 0BB, 2K).

ON THE ROAD AGAIN

» Owns a 7-3 record with a 2.55 ERA (23ER/81.1IP) through his first 12 road outings this season...won his first road start of 2018 on March 31 at Seattle (5.2IP, 7H, 5R/ER, 4K) and took a no-decision despite tossing 7.0 shutout innings against Minnesota in Puerto Rico on April 18...Carrasco threw a complete game on May 9 at Milwaukee, striking out 14 batters while allowing two runs on five hits...tossed 7.0 shutout innings at Chicago-AL on June 11, walking one and striking out 11 batters.
 » In his most recent road start (August 12 at Chicago-AL), Carrasco allowed one unearned run over 7.0 strong innings of work (0BB, 9K)...Carrasco has allowed three-or-fewer runs in each of his last five road starts (since June 11), going 4-0 in that span with a 0.79 ERA (3ER/34.1IP).
 » Overall has surrendered three-or-fewer runs in 10 of his 12 road starts this season...currently owns the 4th-lowest road ERA in the American League.
 » Since 2015, Carrasco's 2.53 road ERA is the 3rd-lowest in MLB among pitchers with at least 200.0 road innings, trailing only Clayton Kershaw (2.28) & Max Scherzer (2.36).

2017 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS

» **Enjoyed the most prolific season of his career, finishing fourth in American League Cy Young voting as he set new career-highs in wins (18), starts (32), innings pitched (200.0) and strikeouts (226)...Carrasco finished in the A.L. Top 10 in wins (T1st), ERA (3.29, 6th), strikeouts (5th) and innings (8th)...joined Corey Kluber as the first teammates to accumulate 18 wins and 220 strikeouts each since Arizona's Randy Johnson & Curt Schilling in 2002 (6th duo all-time).**
 » Made his Postseason debut in Game 3 of the ALDS against New York-AL after missing the 2016 playoffs...tossed 5.2 shutout innings on just three hits (3BB, 7K) but took a no decision in the Tribe's eventual 1-0 loss at Yankee Stadium.

CAREER SNAPSHOT

» Right-hander is in his 10th season with the Cleveland organization after being acquired from Philadelphia on July 29, 2009, along with INF Jason Donald, RHP Jason Knapp & C Lou Marson, in exchange for OF Ben Francisco & LHP Cliff Lee.
 » Signed 4-year contract extension with Indians thru 2018 on April 7, 2015, including club options for 2019 & 2020 and could cover up to first 3 years of free agency.
 » Made his major league debut September 1, 2009 as the Indians starter against the Detroit Tigers at Comerica Park...took the loss after allowing six runs on nine hits (three home runs) with three walks and three strikeouts in 3.0 innings.
 » Is in his 15th professional season since signing with Philadelphia as a non-drafted free agent on Nov. 25, 2003...has appeared in parts of nine Major League seasons with Cleveland...missed the entire 2012 season after having right elbow surgery.
