FISH BITES

Miami opens a brief two-game road trip to The Hub tonight at 7:10 p.m. against the Red Sox. RHP **José Ureña** will get the call for Miami; his only career start against Boston was on April 3 this season at Marlins Park, when he did not factor in the decision after allowing one run on four hits and a walk over 7.0 innings, with seven strikeouts, in a 4-2 loss. The Red Sox will counter with southpaw Brian Johnson, whose only career start against Miami came the day before Ureña's start; Johnson earned the win after allowing one run on six hits and two walks, with five strikeouts, over 6.0 innings in a 7-3 victory. The Marlins are coming off a 3-3 homestand against the Yankees (1-1) and Braves (2-2). They return home for an off-day on Thursday before opening a six-game homestand against the Blue Jays (Aug. 31-Sept. 2) and Phillies (Sept. 3-5).

SUNDAY'S RECAP

The Marlins dropped a 4-0 decision to the Braves to split their four-game series at Marlins Park. Starting pitcher **Pablo López** had Miami's only hit, a third-inning single, until **Derek Dietrich** extended his hitting streak to a career-high tying eight games with a ninth-inning knock. They were the only two hits the Marlins would muster on the day, however, in an anemic long-weekend for both teams. The 14 combined runs by the two clubs over the series marked the lowest combined output ever in a four-game set involving the Marlins, besting a 15-run total against the Mets in New York from Sept. 13-15, 2013, according to the *Elias Sports Bureau*. López suffered his fourth loss despite allowing just one run on six hits and five walks (two intentional) over 5.2 innings, with four strikeouts. He lowered his season ERA to 4.14.

TAKING THE GOOD WITH THE BAD

The Marlins' pitching staff has posted a 1.77 ERA (66.0 ip/13 er) over the last seven games, holding opponents to a .214 batting average (team record, 4-3). Their ERA and average against in that time (since August 19) both rank 2nd in the National League to Atlanta (1.29, .162). Tonight's starter, **José Ureña**, started the hot streak at Washington, tossing Miami's only complete game of the season (9.0 ip, 2 h, r, er, 2 bb, 4 so). However, Miami's offense has hit at just a .226 clip in those games (13th in NL), scoring 3.7 runs per game (9th) with a .305 on-base percentage (9th) and a .368 slugging percentage (13th).

VS. RED SOX

Miami begins a two-game Interleague series against the Red Sox tonight at 7:10 p.m. Boston took the first two games of the season series, April 2-3 at Marlins Park. The Marlins are looking to snap a five-game losing streak at Fenway Park; their last win in Boston was on June 18, 2009. Miami is just 6-14 all-time in Bean Town, and trail the overall series, 12-24.

WELCOME TO FRIENDLY FENWAY

The Marlins active roster does not boast much experience at Fenway Park. Second baseman **Starlin Castro**, formerly of the Yankees, is the only player with more than 10 career games played in Boston, batting .316 (24x76) in 19 outings. **Martín Prado**, currently on the disabled list, would be second, with a .310 average in 12 games. The next closest is **Bryan Holaday**, who has gone 5x11 (.455) in seven games here. Only the Reds (33) have fewer career games played at Fenway on their active roster than the Marlins (44), according to the *Elias Sports Bureau*. No one on Miami's active roster has ever homered at Fenway Park; again from *Elias*, no other team in the Majors has an active roster with zero career home runs at Fenway.

FIVE-0

José Ureña has a five-decision winning streak over his last seven Interleague starts, dating back to May 23, 2017 at Oakland. In that time, he has posted a 3.29 ERA (41.0 ip/15 er) and held opponents to a .170 average against. Ureña's winning streak vs. the AL is the third-longest in club history, behind six-game streaks for A.J. Burnett (2001-'02) and Josh Johnson (2009-'12), according to the *Elias Sports Bureau*. Since the start of 2017, Ureña's .175 average against in eight starts against the AL ranks second among NL pitchers (min. 8 GS) in Interleague Play, behind only Max Scherzer (.154), while his 2.85 ERA (53.2/17) ranks fifth, behind Trevor Williams (1.80), Scherzer (2.20), German Marquez (2.29), and Zack Greinke (2.43).

DH-ing

This series marks Miami's last venture into an American League stadium in 2018. Miami's designated hitters this year have produced a .265 (9x34) batting average, which ranks seventh among National League clubs, behind first-place St. Louis (.429; 12x28). Miami's DHs have an all-time average of .247, which ranks ninth among NL clubs, also behind overall leader St. Louis (.305). However, Miami DHs lead NL clubs in doubles (45); rank second in hits (192), behind the Cardinals (209); are fourth in RBI (102); and are tied with Chicago for fifth in runs scored (93). Marlins' DHs have a .288 overall batting average at Fenway Park, their seventh-best mark at an AL ballpark all-time, according to the *Elias Sports Bureau*.

POWER IN NUMBERS

With his home run Saturday night, **Brian Anderson** pushed his season to total to 10, becoming the seventh Marlins' player with 10+ home runs this season. The last time Miami had seven-or-more players with 10+ home runs in the same season was 2008, when seven Marlins reached the mark. The Club record for most players with 10+ homers is nine, done in 2006. Miami is one of only five NL teams to have seven-or-more players with 10+ home runs: the Dodgers (9), Atlanta (7), St. Louis (7), and Washington (7).

PROVING HIS WORTH

Brian Anderson leads all Major League rookies in games (131), at-bats (503), runs (70), average with RISP (.390), and on-base percentage (.357); is tied with Miguel Andujar for first in hits (139); ranks second in doubles (27), walks (51), and multi-hit games (40); ranks third in RBI (56), average (.276), and slugging (.402); is tied for third in triples (3); and tied for 12th in HR (10). On the defensive side, he leads all rookie outfielders with a .994 fielding percentage, committing just one error in 176 total chances. He also owns eight outfield assists, most among all ML rookie outfielders and just three off the Major League lead held by Billy Hamilton.

- He is on pace for 171 hits this season, which would rank as the second-most by a National League rookie since 2008, behind Corey Seager's 193 in 2016, and would be 10th-most by an NL rookie since 2000.
- He recorded 109 hits before the All-Star break, tying Rocco Baldelli for the second-most by a Major League rookie since 2003, behind only Hideki Matsui (114 in 2003). He is the only Marlins rookie in franchise history to record 100+ hits prior to the break.
- Anderson recorded 101 hits over his first 92 games of the season. Since 1958, 34 rookies have recorded 100+ hits in 92-or-fewer games and went on to win Rookie of the Year honors, including most recently Aaron Judge (2017), Corey Seager (2016), Carlos Correa (2015), José Abreu (2014), Mike Trout (2012) and Buster Posey (2010). - *Stats LLC*

INTERLEAGUE NOTABLES

The Marlins' 192 Interleague wins all time are the tied with the Mets for second-most all-time among National League clubs, behind only Washington (195), and they have the fourth-best winning percentage (.499; 192-193), behind St. Louis (.511; 180-172), the Mets (.507; 192-187), and the Cubs (.506; 178-174). Miami's offense is the all-time leader among NL clubs in Interleague runs (1,772) and hits (3,495).

José Ureña will make his team-leading 26th start of the season in the first of two against the Boston Red Sox. This is his first start since returning from a six-game suspension handed down by MLB.

In last start, August 19 at Nationals Park, tossed first career complete game and first by a Marlins starter since Edinson Volquez no-hit the Arizona Diamondbacks on June 3, 2017 at Marlins Park. Needed 108 pitches to complete the game, allowing one run on two hits and two walks, while striking out four. Was eighth complete game by a Marlins starter against Washington (since 2005), and first since Ricky Nolasco on September 9, 2012 at Nationals Park.

Tonight will mark his second career start, both this season, against Boston. Held Red Sox to one run on four hits and a walk, with a season-high seven strikeouts, over 7.0 innings on April 3 at Marlins Park.

Has made three Interleague starts this season, posting a 1-0 record and 0.45 ERA. In his only road Interleague outing, held Baltimore scoreless on three hits, a walk and four strikeouts over 8.0 innings on June 15 at Oriole Park at Camden Yards. For his career, owns 5-2 record and 2.89 ERA in 16 Interleague appearances (nine starts).

On August 15 at SunTrust Park, made one pitch before being ejected after hitting Ronald Acuna Jr. According to *Stats LLC*, he was the first starter in the live-ball era to hit a batter on the only pitch he threw. The only other starters to hit the only batter they faced were Bob Shaw (1965), Scott Elarton (2001) and John Lackey (2009).

Suffering from the second-lowest run support average of any starter in the National League (min. 20 GS) at 3.46. Only four starts this season has he left the game with more run support than runs allowed, and he has allowed three-or-fewer runs 14 times.

Snapped streak of 14 consecutive home starts without a win on July 29 vs. Washington. Allowed just one hit and four walks, with five strikeouts, over 6.0 scoreless innings.

The stretch of 14 home starts without a win was the longest such streak in Franchise history. Anibal Sánchez previously owned the longest stretch when he made 13 straight home starts without a win from June , 20, 2011 to May 24, 2012. The win also snapped an eight-game home losing streak, which was also the longest such streak in Club history. Jack Armstrong (7/22-10/3/93), Livan Hernández (7/9/98-4/6/99), Vladimir Cruz (8/5/99-4/22/01), and Dontrelle Willis (5/9-8/3/07) all had seven-game home slides. - *Stats LLC*

Was placed on 10-day DL on June 21 with right shoulder impingement, following his start at San Francisco the previous day (L, 5.2 ip, 8 h, 5 r, 5 er, 2 bb, 1bb, 5 so).

In his start prior to that outing in SF, he fired off 8.0 shutout innings on June 15 at Baltimore to pick up his second win of the season (3 h, bb, 4 so, hb). It was his fourth career game tossing at least 8.0 innings, and fell 0.2 inning shy of his career-long outing. Also threw a career-high 112 pitches.

Trevor Richards will make his 20th start of the season for Miami in the finale of this two-game set against the Boston Red Sox. Has also made six starts at Triple-A New Orleans, going 3-2 with a 2.06 ERA (39.1 ip/9 er).

Holding left-handed hitters to a .213 average (35x164), 15th-best among National League pitchers (min. 125 AB). Seth Lugo leads the NL with a .180 mark.

Since July 8, is tied for 21st among National League starting pitchers (min. 40.0 ip) with a 2.95 ERA (42.2/14). Has allowed a total of 35 hits in that span, tied with one other for 11th-fewest (min. 40.0 ip).

Despite allowing five runs in his last road start to Atlanta on August 14, he has gone 1-1 with a 3.51 ERA (25.2/10) in his last five road starts overall. Has limited opponents to one run three times and two runs once.
