### FISH BITES

Miami and Boston wrap up this brief two-game series tonight at 6:35 p.m. Right-hander **Trevor Richards** will get the start for Miami; his only career start against Boston was on April 2 this season, his MLB debut (L, 4.1 ip, 8 h, 5 r, 5 er, hr, bb, 5 so). The Red Sox will counter with southpaw David Price, who is 1-3 with a 3.42 ERA in four career starts against the Marlins, whom he has not faced since June 4, 2014 while with the Rays in Tampa. The Marlins are coming off a 3-3 homestand against the Yankees (1-1) and Braves (2-2). They return home for an off-day on tomorrow before opening a six-game homestand against the Blue Jays (Aug. 31-Sept. 2) and Phillies (Sept. 3-5).

### LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

The Marlins staged a pair of comebacks, but Boston responded with two of its own and handed Miami an 8-7 walkoff loss in the opener of this quick two-game set. After the Red Sox staked a 1-0 lead in the second, **Isaac Galloway** tied the game with a solo homer in the third. Boston scored twice in its half of the frame, and pushed the lead to 4-1 in the sixth. Miami rallied for five runs in the eighth to take a 6-4 lead. **Brian Anderson** started the rally with a leadoff single, scored on a two-run homer by **J.T. Realmuto**, and **Starlin Castro** followed with a solo homer to tie it. **Rafael Ortega** drove in the go-ahead run with a bases-loaded bloop single later in the inning. After Boston stormed back ahead with a three-run eighth, **Magneuris Sierra** tied the game again with an RBI single in the ninth. A throwing error on a double play attempt in the bottom of the ninth allowed Boston to walk off with the win. According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, it was just the 10th time in club history that Miami suffered a walk-off loss on an error.

### TAKING THE GOOD WITH THE BAD

The Marlins' pitching staff has posted a 2.41 ERA (74.2 ip/20 er) over the last eight games, holding opponents to a .231 batting average (team record, 4-4). Their ERA ranks third in the NL in that time, behind Atlanta (1.71) and Chicago (2.02), while their average against ranks fourth, behind Atlanta (.185), Arizona (.230), and San Francisco (.231). However, Miami's offense has hit at just a .241 clip in those games (10th in NL), scoring 4.1 runs per game (9th) with a .319 on-base percentage (6th) and a .406 slugging percentage (9th).

### VS. RED SOX

After last night's loss in the series opener, Miami is looking to avoid a four-game season series sweep tonight. Boston took the first two games of the season series, April 2-3 at Marlins Park. The Marlins are looking to snap a six-game losing streak at Fenway Park; their last win in Boston was on June 18, 2009. Miami is just 6-15 all-time in Bean Town, and trail the overall series, 12-25.

### WELCOME TO FRIENDLY FENWAY

The Marlins active roster does not boast much experience at Fenway Park. Second baseman **Starlin Castro**, formerly of the Yankees, is the only player with more than 10 career games played in Boston as a visiting player, batting .325 (26x80) in 20 outings. **Martin Prado**, currently on the disabled list, would be second, with a .310 average in 12 games. The next closest is **Bryan Holaday**, who has gone 6x14 (.429) in eight games here as a visitor. Entering last night's series opener, only the Reds (33) had fewer career games played at Fenway on their active roster than the Marlins (44, now 61), according to the *Elias Sports Bureau*. Prior to Miami's three-homer outburst last night, it was the only active roster in the Majors without a career home run at Fenway Park.

### SECOND TIME'S A CHARM

**Trevor Richards** is making his 20th career start tonight. He made his Major League debut back on April 2 at Marlins Park against Boston, suffering a loss after allowing five runs on eight hits (one home run) and a walk over 4.1 innings, with five strikeouts. It was a rocky start, but was one of only four outings this season in which he has allowed five-or-more runs, something he has done just once since June 23. Since that date, Richards has posted a 3.43 ERA (57.2 ip/22 er) in 11 starts, which ranks 24th among National League pitchers (min. 10 GS). Since July 8, Richards has allowed two-or-fewer runs in six of his eight starts, with a 2.95 ERA (42.2/14).

### CATCH & HIT

**J.T. Realmuto** hits his 17th home run of the season last night, tying his single-season career high, which he set last season. Only Charles Johnson (19 in 1997, 18 in 2001) hit more home runs in a season in Club history among players whose primary position was catcher. Realmuto drove in two runs last night, giving him 64 RBI on the year. That is fourth-most by a catcher in Club history, behind his 2017 campaign (65), Johnson's 2001 season (75), and Ivan Rodriguez's club record of 85 in 2003. Realmuto leads NL catchers in RBI this season, ranks second in home runs, and leads qualified MLB catchers in slugging (.492).

### DH-ing

This series marks Miami's last venture into an American League stadium in 2018. Miami's designated hitters this year have produced a .237 (9x38) batting average, which ranks eighth among National League clubs, behind first-place St. Louis (.429; 12x28). Miami's DHs have an all-time average of .246, which ranks ninth among NL clubs, also behind overall leader St. Louis (.305). However, Miami DHs lead NL clubs in doubles (45); rank second in hits (192), behind the Cardinals (209); are fourth in RBI (102); and are tied with Chicago for fifth in runs scored (93).

### POWER IN NUMBERS

With his home run Saturday night, **Brian Anderson** pushed his season total to 10, becoming the seventh Marlins' player with 10+home runs this season. The last time Miami had seven-or-more players with 10+ home runs in the same season was 2008, when seven Marlins reached the mark. The Club record for most players with 10+ homers is nine, done in 2006. Miami is one of only five NL teams to have seven-or-more players with 10+ home runs: the Dodgers (9), Atlanta (7), St. Louis (7), and Washington (7).

### PROVING HIS WORTH

**Brian Anderson** leads all Major League rookies in games (132), at-bats (507), runs (71), hits (141), average with RISP (.387), and on-base percentage (.360); ranks second in doubles (28), walks (52), and multi-hit games (41); ranks third in RBI (56), average (.278), and slugging (.404); is tied for third in triples (3); and tied for 12th in HR (10). On the defensive side, he leads all rookie outfielders with a .994 fielding percentage, committing just one error in 176 total chances. He also owns eight outfield assists, most among all ML rookie outfielders and just four off the Major League lead held by Billy Hamilton.

- He is on pace for 171 hits this season, which would rank as the second-most by a National League rookie since 2008, behind Corey Seager's 193 in 2016, and would be 10th-most by an NL rookie since 2000.
- He recorded 109 hits before the All-Star break, tying Rocco Baldelli for the second-most by a Major League rookie since 2003, behind only Hideki Matsui (114 in 2003). He is the only Marlins rookie in franchise history to record 100+ hits prior to the break.
- Anderson recorded 101 hits over his first 92 games of the season. Since 1958, 34 rookies have recorded 100+ hits in 92-or-fewer games and went on to win Rookie of the Year honors, including most recently Aaron Judge (2017), Corey Seager (2016), Carlos Correa (2015), José Abreu (2014), Mike Trout (2012) and Buster Posey (2010). - *Stats LLC*

Trevor Richards will make his 20th start of the season for Miami in the finale of this two-game set against the Boston Red Sox. On the season, has posted 3-7 record and 4.23 ERA (95.2 ip/45 er). Has also made six starts at Triple-A New Orleans, going 3-2 with a 2.06 ERA (39.1/9).

Holding left-handed hitters to a .213 average (35x164), 12th-best among National League pitchers (min. 150 AB). Seth Lugo leads the NL with a .178 mark.

Since July 8, is 22nd among National League starting pitchers (min. 40.0 ip) with a 2.95 ERA (42.2/14). Has allowed a total of 35 hits in that span, tied with Rich Hill for eighth-fewest (min. 40.0 ip).

Despite allowing five runs in his last road start to Atlanta on August 14, he has gone is 1-1 with a 3.51 ERA (25.2/10) in his last five road starts overall. Has limited opponents to one run three times and two runs once.

From June 23 to August 8, allowed 15 total runs over 48.0 innings pitched in nine starts for a 2.81 ERA. Has allowed seven runs over his last two starts covering 9.2 innings.

In first eight starts with Miami, posted 1-4 record with 5.45 ERA (38.0 ip/23 er). Over last 11 starts, is 2-3 with a 3.43 ERA (57.2/22). In that time, has limited opponents to three-or-less runs nine times, and two-or-fewer seven times.

Tonight will mark the second start of his rookie campaign against Boston. He made his Major League debut on April 2 against Boston at Marlins Park. He took the loss, giving up five runs on eight hits and a walk, with five strikeouts, over 4.1 innings.

In five Interleague starts this season, has 0-2, 6.57 (24.2/18) marks. In two Interleague road starts, is 0-1 with a 6.30 ERA. His last road Interleague start was on July 22 at Tampa Bay, when he allowed one run on three hits and a walk, while striking out six, over 6.2 innings.

In last start, August 22 vs. the Yankees, did not receive a decision despite allowing just two runs on three hits and three walks, with nine strikeouts, over 5.1 innings. The nine strikeouts are the second-most he has struck out in a Major League game, behind a 10-strikeout performance against the Dodgers on April 25.

On August 14 at Atlanta, surrendered five runs on a season high 10 hits and two walks, with three strikeouts, over 4.1 innings. Prior to that start, had made six consecutive starts with four-or-fewer hits allowed (22 total).

Went 2-0 with 0.75 ERA (12.0 ip/1 er) in four Spring appearances (two starts) with Miami. Had contract selected on April 2 and made his Major League debut that night against Boston.

Is making his fourth career start and fifth appearance against Toronto, his first since a 1.2-inning relief appearance on September 8, 2014. In his three starts against the Jays, has gone 0-1 with a 2.00 ERA (18.0/4).

Friday night will mark his 15th career Interleague appearance and 16 appearance, posting a 7-5 record and 3.87 ERA. In seven career Interleague starts at home, is a perfect 5-0 with a 1.28 ERA.
